BILL SHOEMAKER DIES

Racing legend Bill Shoemaker passed away Sunday at his home in San Marino, California. He was 72. During his 41-year riding career, Shoemaker won 8,822 races and the respect of racing fans and fellow riders. He

held the all-time wins record until surpassed by Laffit Pincay Jr. in 1999. "This is a very sad time for me," Pincay said yesterday. "We were good friends for many, many years. He was my idol when I came to this country and he was always a Class-A guy." Shoemaker, elected to the Hall of Fame in 1958, won the Kentucky Derby four times, the Preakness twice and the Belmont S. five times. In 1986, he became the oldest jockey to win the Derby when he guided Ferdinand to victory at age 54.

He also rode Derby winners Swaps, *Tomy Lee and Lucky Debonair. Following a nationwide tour, the Shoe rode his final race at Santa Anita on Feb. 3, 1990. After his retirement from the saddle, he began training horses. He conditioned stakes winners Fire the Groom, Glen Kate, Diazo and Shirkee. In 1991, Shoemaker was paralyzed in an auto accident, but continued training until 1997. "We were friends for 25-odd years," said fellow Hall of Fame rider Eddie Delahoussaye. "Shoe had his ups and downs, and to be paralyzed for the last 12 years of his life, well, sometimes life isn't fair, but he was one of the toughest guys you'll ever meet. I'll miss him." Chris McCarron is another Hall of Famer to count Shoemaker among his friends. "He was one of the greatest human beings I have ever had the pleasure of knowing in my life," McCarron said. "Forget about his ability to communicate with horses. His compassion for people was second to none." Shoemaker is survived by his daughter Amanda. Funeral arrangements are pending.

ANOTHER STAR FOR JUDDMONTE

Etoile Montante (Miswaki) continued the incredible run of form for Juddmonte Farms and justified 4-5 favoritism to win yesterday's G1 Prix de la Foret at Longchamp. Swooping late to deny **Royal Millennium (Ire)** (Royal Academy) by 1½ lengths, she took the Group and Grade I tally of Khalid Abdullah's organization to 17 for the season. The homebred also provided conditioner Criquelette Head-Maarek with her fifth renewal of this contest. Settled in fifth by Olivier Peslier off the generous early tempo, she traveled with ease in the testing conditions, but was denied first run as Royal Millennium quickened to hit the front with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining. The chestnut filly was switched around that rival and quickened to lead with 100 yards remaining before asserting for a comfortable score. "She is really brave and has never run a bad race," her conditioner said. "She fully deserved this after being placed in two Group 1s this year. She has plenty of speed and loves the track and my only moment of concern came when Royal Millennium took her ground slightly. In fact, Olivier said that gave her the chance to get a breather and she took off soon after." **Prix de la Foret cont. p2**

FUNNY CIDE TO RUN IN BREEDERS' CUP

This year's roller coaster ride to the Oct. 25 GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita, replete with a steady stream of defections and additions, received another loop yesterday when it was announced that Kentucky Derby and Preakness S. hero **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) would participate in the event. The announcement, made by trainer Barclay Tagg, followed a sharp work by Funny Cide over Belmont's fast training track Sunday morning. The Sackatoga Stables colorbearer zipped a mile in 1:38 3/5 with regular exercise rider Robin Smullen aboard. It had previously been announced that the three-year-old chestnut would compete in the Oct. 18 Empire Classic at Belmont, a race for New York-breds age three and up. "We had discussed the Breeders' Cup and if we were going to do it, I wanted to get him a work around two turns," said Tagg. "I wasn't real keen on him going a one-turn mile and an eighth back off a long layoff. If he got beat in a restricted race for New York-breds, it would be very hard for him to get the championship for three-year-olds. I'd rather run for \$4 million than \$250,000." Tagg said that Funny Cide would have one more work next weekend at Belmont before shipping to California on Oct. 22 for the Breeders' Cup. **Breeders' Cup News cont. p7**

Knocking on the Door...

The runner-up to Six Perfections (Fr) in the G1 Prix Marcel Boussac at this track last October, **Etoile Montante** was one of the leading lights entering the G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches (French 1000 Guineas) May 11 and finished a solid third behind Musical Chimes. She dealt with very soft ground when beating the ill-fated State of Art (Fr) in the Listed Prix des Lilas at Compiègne May 26 before being dropped to six-and-a-half furlongs in the G1 Prix Maurice de Gheest at Deauville on her return Aug. 10. She showed she possessed the necessary speed for the trip, finishing runner-up to Porlezza (Fr), before recording a smooth success over course and distance in the Listed Prix du Pin last time Sept. 20. As for what's next, Maarek-Head said, "I will have to discuss her future with Prince Khalid and Teddy Grimthorpe, but her season is finished in France. Le Vie dei Colori reestablished himself as Italy's darling as he ended the 15-year drought of Italian-trained horses in this contest. The colt stamped himself as the country's leading juvenile in 2002 with successes in the G3 Premio Primi Passi and G3 Prix la Rochette. He found only Hold That Tiger a half length too strong when runner-up in the G1 Grand Criterium. Confined to just two prior runs this season, the British-bred colt beat Prince Kirk (Fr) (Selkirk) by 2 1/2 lengths in the G2 Premio Parioli (Italian 2000 Guineas) at Rome Apr. 27, but a series of setbacks kept him off the track until the Listed Premio del Piazzale at this track Sept. 21. The slow early tempo was against him there and he lost his unbeaten record in Italy when only second, but he had the strong pace he requires in this contest. Settled in mid-division early by Dario Vargiu, he made smooth progress to challenge as Frankie Dettori took Blatant to the front at the quarter-mile marker. After a prolonged duel, it was Le Vie dei Colori who came out on top, asserting in the final 100 yards for the hard-fought success. "I'm delighted by that effort, as I'm not sure this track is his favorite," commented winning trainer Roberto Brogi. "He could now go for the G1 Hong Kong Mile [at Sha Tin Dec. 14] if he is invited." Trainer Saeed bin Suroor was delighted with the performance of the runner-up. "Blatant was beaten by a better horse on the day, but he has run a big race," he commented. Spectacular Moon was claimed for \$25,000 from her debut win at Laurel Aug. 30 and was claimed for \$40,000 from her second start, a 4 1/2-length victory Aug. 21. Not in for a tag for the first time, the dark bay filly won her third straight over a sloppy Pimlico track in a Sept. 13 optional claimer. Jumping up to graded stakes company, the 28-1 longshot ducked in and was bumped at the start before settling well off the pace. It looked like a battle between Feline Story and Smokey Glacken to the wire, but Spectacular Moon charged from the clouds to overtake Feline Story in the final strides. "My assistant trainer told me she acted up on the van ride up there today and almost flipped in the paddock," Maryland-based trainer John Alecci said via telephone after Spectacular Moon's win. "I didn't want her on the lead, but when I saw her so far back, I thought the van and the paddock might have taken a toll on her. We wanted to see how much class she had, so we tried this. She'll come back to Maryland tonight and we'll let her tell us when she wants to run next. I would like to gradually stretch her out." Winning rider Jorge Chavez added, "I thought I'd be sitting two or three lengths off the lead early, but they were going fast and she couldn't keep up. I had a lot of horse at the top of the stretch, but I wasn't sure if she was going to get there. She ran a big race." His Highness the Aga Khan's Azamour gamely outbattled Relaxed Gesture to provide his owner/breeder and trainer John Oxx with back-to-back renewals of this contest. Like last year's hero and distinguished stable companion Alamshar (Ire), he entered this race off a single maiden score and showed promise in taking that seven-furlong contest at The Curragh Sept. 14. Settled in a stalking second by Johnny Murtagh throughout the early stages, he always had the leader Relaxed Gesture and Pat Smullen in his sights. As the pair quickened from the front in the straight, it took until the final 50 yards for Azamour to get on top of his determined rival, but he dug deep for Murtagh where it mattered. "He did a good job and they really ran for home inside the final three furlongs," Oxx commented. "He's promising and he should develop well from two to three, but he could have stamina limitations and a mile might be as far as he wants to go. I haven't run too many two year olds, but I don't have a nicer one at the moment. That's it for the year."
