HARMONY IN AUSTRALIA

Jockey Damien Oliver, who dominated the Thousand Guineas meeting at Caulfield winning five from eight races, combined with trainer Lee Freedman to score the Group 1 feature aboard **Special Harmony** (Spinning World). The filly settled in midfield before sprinting at the top of the straight when a gap opened, winning easily by 2 1/4 lengths. "She is lovely to ride," Oliver said. "She was always travelling well and when the field started to gather around the corner, she just needed a break. Once the gap came, I knew she would quicken and sprint well." The filly won the G2 Edward Manifold S. at Flemington last start for jockey Luke Currie, as Oliver stood down to attend the birth of his daughter. One start back, Special Harmony was runner-up in the G2 Bill Stutt S. at Moonee Valley. The \$95,000 Magic Millions graduate, sent out 15-4 favourite, will target the VRC Oaks after providing Freedman with his 95th Group 1 trophy. "She showed a bit of tenacity the way she hit the line, and she'll be suited in the Oaks," Freedman said.

Gygistar Catches BC Jinx Again...

Edward Evans' **Gygistar** (Prospector's Gamble--Starr County, by Ogygian) will miss the GI Sprint for the second year in a row after coming down with a 104-degree temperature, reports the *Thoroughbred Times*. The four-year-old was knocked out of last year's Sprint after sustaining a deep cut to his left front hoof in a stall accident just weeks prior to the Breeders' Cup at Arlington. "He's got the curse of the Bambino, only it's the curse of the Breeders' Cup," trainer Mark Hennig told the *Daily Racing Form*. "He worked great Saturday, but left all his dinner, and on Sunday he had a 104 temperature. We treated him and he snapped right out of it, but he's going to miss four or five days of training." Fourth in the Sept. 27 GI Vosburgh S. at Belmont in his most recent, the gelding could reappear next in the GI Frank J. De Francis Memorial Dash at Laurel Nov. 15.

Baze to Ride Toccet in Turf...

The Northern California institution known as Russell Baze has been named to ride GI Turf prospect **Toccet** (Awesome Again), according to *The Blood-Horse*. "I have admired him for years and I want a strong, fearless rider who tries hard," said owner Daniel Borislow, who previously had considered both the Classic and the Seabiscuit S., on the Breeders' Cup undercard, as possibilities for Toccet. "I have always thought I would like to use him in a big race if I could. I figured I would be the underdog and what better rider to have on him, but the ultimate underdog who rides the best." While the three-year-old Toccet has been pre-entered in both the Turf and the Classic, Borislow indicated that he is committed to the Turf.

Private Horde's Camp Reconsider; Will go to Sprint...

Reversing their stance on the Sprint, the connections of GII Alferd G. Vanderbilt H. hero **Private Horde** (Brunswick) will ship the four-year-old to Santa Anita to contest the six-furlong event, reports the *Thoroughbred Times*. Owner/breeder Billy Tucker and his wife, Carol, who previously had decided against the Breeders' Cup because Private Horde would have to be supplemented at a cost of \$90,000, changed their minds just prior to Tuesday's pre-entries. "I think they reconsidered it and decided the horse has a good shot and he deserves the chance to run in the race," said trainer Joe Cain. "I encouraged it because I think he has a good shot, too."

Clock Stopper, Ethan Man Possibles for Sprint...

Two more horses were added as possibles to the Sprint lineup as **Clock Stopper** (Gilded Time) and **Ethan Man** (Glitterman) were pre-entered for the race. Trained by Dallas Stewart, the fast-developing three-year-old Clock Stopper is coming off a sharp victory in the Oct. 9 Perryville S. at Keeneland. Ethan Man, winner of the GIII Swale S. as a sophomore, returned from a 16-month absence to win an Arlington Park optional claimer in late August before running 1 1/2 lengths adrift of Najran when second in the GIII Phoenix Breeders' Cup S. at Keeneland Oct. 3.

Congaree Looks Good in Gallop...

Stonerside's **Congaree** (Arazi), who has been cross-entered in the GI Classic and the Sprint, galloped Wednesday for trainer Bob Baffert, a day after it was announced that the five-year-old had suffered a minor quarter crack. The chestnut showed no apparent ill effect from the injury. "There's no good quarter crack," said Baffert, "but this wasn't a bad one. His chances of running in the Sprint are slim to none. But if his foot's not right, he's not going to run at all."

Tiger in the Hunt for Juvenile...

After considering the Juvenile too tough a test for two-year-olds just a few week ago, Team Valor has changed its tune and will now aim Cradle S. winner **Tiger Hunt** (Kris S.) towards the GI Juvenile, the *Thoroughbred Times* reports. "Things change," said Team Valor president Barry Irwin. "Normally, it's too tough a race if you want to have a horse the next spring. But there are so many horses skipping the race this year that it's not going to be that tough. If all the real horses would show up, then we wouldn't even think about it."

Works...Trainer John Sherriffs' **Yankee Gentleman** (Storm Cat) prepped for the Sprint with a five-furlong work in :58 1/5, the second fastest of 39 at the distance. "It sounds too fast," said Sherriffs when advised of the time. "I was looking for 1:01. But in a sense, it's a good sign. That's what they say. He did it so easily, I'm not worried."...**Dimitrova** (Swain {Ire}), recent winner of the GI Flower Bowl Invitational against her elders, breezed six furlongs over Santa Anita's firm turf in 1:16 4/5 around the dogs. The Dermot Weld trainee is being aimed towards a tilt in GI Filly and Mare Turf...Turf contender **Irish Warrior** (Irish River {Fr}) worked six panels over Hollywood's main track in :1:13 3/5. "It was perfect," said conditioner Wally Dollase. "He looked real good and I'm very pleased. He went the last eighth in :11 2/5, and that's the main thing."

NO STORY IN DEWHURST Mark Johnston yesterday announced that **Lucky Story** (Kris S.) will skip Saturday's G1 Darley Dewhurst S. at Newmarket. Abdulla Buhaleeba's G2 Vintage S. and G2 Champagne S. winner disappointed connections in a gallop on Tuesday and will be put away for the season. Meanwhile, jockey Martin Dwyer was in confident mood concerning the chance of the Marcus Tregoning-trained G2 Royal Lodge S. winner **Snow Ridge (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) in Saturday's contest. "Snow Ridge is a really nice horse," Dwyer said yesterday of the unbeaten Weinstock Family colorbearer. "He's been very impressive and he's improving, so we'll find out just how good he is on Saturday. He's a raw talent and plenty of speed. He quickened from the turn and he broke the track record at Ascot, and you need plenty of speed to do that there. Newmarket is a straight track, so if I can get him going a bit earlier, I'm not worried about the drop back. It looks like it's going to be a great race." Conditioner Jeremy Nosedo also confirmed G2 Gimcrack S. winner and G1 Middle Park S. runner-up **Balmont** (Stravinsky) on course to reoppose Three Valleys in Saturday's race. "I was very happy with the way Balmont worked this morning and we've made the decision to run in the Dewhurst," Nosedo said of Sanford Robertson's colt. "He worked five furlongs up the Al Bahathri under his work-rider Dave Goodwin. It was an easy piece of work for him, but he appears to be in great shape, so we've decided to take the bold approach and give the Dewhurst a spin. Pat Eddery will ride him."

TALE OF THE CAT TOPS OBS A filly by Tale of the Cat topped Tuesday's second Consignor Preferred session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Fall Mixed Sale in Ocala, Florida. Selling as [hip 534](#), the weanling was consigned by Celebrity Farm, agent, and was purchased by bloodstock agent Buzz Chace for \$145,000. Out of On With the Music (Play On), she is a half sister to multiple stakes winner and graded stakes placed Musical Gambler. [Hip 361](#), a weanling filly by Yes It's True, brought a final bid of \$110,000 from Take One Bloodstock. Consigned by Summerfield, agent, the bay is out of Fleta Kalem (Siyah Kalem), a half sister to stakes winner Bright Lady. **Lori's Luck** (Ogygian), [hip 501](#), was the session's top-priced mare. The eight-year-old, in foal to Hennessy, was purchased by Marion Montanari for \$125,000. Also consigned by Celebrity Farm, agent, the bay is a half sister to stakes winner Dynameaux. OBS recorded increases across the board during the two-day Consignor Preferred portion of its Fall Mixed Sale. A total of 307 horses brought \$5,130,000. The average, \$16,710, was up 23.3 percent from 2002, while the median rose 17.6 percent to \$10,000. The buyback rate was 27.2 percent, compared with 30 percent a year ago. The sale continues with open sessions Wednesday and Thursday. Results from Wednesday's session will appear in tomorrow's *TDN*.

MILWAUKEE BREW TO ADENA SPRINGS KENTUCKY Adena Springs Kentucky announced yesterday that **Milwaukee Brew** (Wild Again--Ask Anita, by Wolf Power {SAf}), two-time winner of the GI Santa Anita H., will begin stud duties at their Midway, Kentucky facility for a live foal fee of \$15,000. The Bobby Frankel trainee was victorious in eight of 24 starts, including five graded wins, and recently concluded his career with lifetime earnings of over \$2.8 million. "He compliments our Kentucky roster," said Adena Springs owner Frank Stronach. The recently retired Sky Mesa will enter stud next season at Three Chimneys for \$30,000.
