BREEDERS' CUP 101

A total of 101 horses have been pre-entered for Breeders' Cup XX, to be run Oct. 25 at Santa Anita. Seventeen runners could ship in from Europe to compete in eight races offering \$14 million in purses, including returning Turf champ

High Chaparral (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). Also back to defend her title is 2002 Distaff heroine **Azeri** (Jade Hunter), but, in an unexpected move, trainer Laura De Seroux cross-entered the reigning Horse of the Year in the Classic. However, De Seroux said yesterday that the mare was

highly unlikely to take on the boys. She threw Azeri's name into the Classic ring only because there was a slight chance that owner Michael Paulson might want to take a chance in the \$4-million event. "Michael was on a cruise and not available on his cell phone," she said. "My husband [Emmanuel] finally spoke to him, but the reception was not very good. But entering the Classic was just a formality. If you ask me, I have never had the door open to the Classic. Going against males never entered my mind." For De Seroux, it was not the Classic pre-entry that was a surprise, but the fact that the five-year-old will make the Breeders' Cup at all. Azeri is looking to avenge her loss to **Got Koko** (Signal Tap) in the GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H. "I'm an optimistic person, but I thought I was going to be up against it to make the Breeders' Cup," the horsewoman said. "She had an off day [for the Lady's Secret], she had a high white [cell] count. We've had her on a series of antibiotics and it has cleared up day by day. It has been absolutely remarkable the way she has rebounded." She added, "We definitely have a mission--she has a loss to avenge. But it seems like she is 100 percent, and when she is, she is very, very difficult to catch." **Breeders' Cup XX cont. p2**

Desormeaux to Ride Clock Stopper...

Trainer Dallas Stewart announced yesterday that Kent Desormeaux will ride Overbrook Farm's **Clock Stopper** (Gilded Time) in next Saturday's Sprint, that is if the three-year-old makes it into the field. Limited to 14 starters, the Sprint has drawn 15 pre-entries to date. Clock Stopper, the only horse not selected by the Breeders' Cup Racing Directors Panel, would draw into the field if one of the original 14 drops out. "His last four races have been very impressive. He hasn't regressed at all," said Stewart. "He acting good, eating good and acts like he's training good. He hasn't shown us anything negative." Stewart booked the Oct. 9 Perryville S. winner on the last flight out of Louisville Oct. 23, in case the gelding gains a berth in the event.

Private Horde Primed for Sprint...

Private Horde (Brunswick), winner of the GII Alfred G. Vanderbilt at Saratoga Aug. 10, zipped four furlongs Thursday at Churchill Downs in preparation for his next start in the Sprint. Billy and Carol Tucker's hombra covered the distance in :46.20, the fastest of 37 works on the day. Jockey Terry Thompson, who partnered the colt to victory in his most recent start in Turfway Park's Marfa H. last time out Sept. 20, was in the irons. "I had a really long hold on him and you just kind of sit on him like that for the morning works," said Thompson. According to trainer Joe Cain, who will ship the four-year-old to California Thursday, "He did it in hand. I was expecting a pretty good time because good horses are supposed to work pretty fast." Obviously pleased with his charges' lively disposition after the work, Cain added, "That's what I was looking for. I never look at the clock. I always pay attention to what the horse does and what I've got left when I get back to the barn."

Get My Drift?

Trainer Murray Johnson said yesterday that he did not decide to enter **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer) in the Classic just because Mineshaft was out of the race. "He'd be the one horse we wouldn't worry about, because I thought we beat him fair and square [in the June 14 GI Stephen Foster H.]," Johnson said. So why did he wait until the last minute to confirm the gelding's Breeders' Cup participation? "We didn't want to announce that we were running until we were certain," he explained. "The Classic was always on our radar, if the horse was in good shape and we thought it was the right move." The four-year-old finished last, beaten 31 lengths by Volponi, in the 10-furlong Classic at three, but his Australian-born conditioner is expecting a far different result Oct. 25. "He's for real," Johnson said. "I just hope he shows everybody." Perfect Drift is a perfect five-for-five on the dirt this season.

Ballydoyle Enters Seven

Trainer Aidan O'Brien, who has two winners from 21 previous Breeders' Cup starters, holds seven entries for this year's edition of the Breeders' Cup. Heading the septet is 2002 Turf winner **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who once again comes off a third-place finish in the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. But O'Brien feels the four-year-old can redeem himself once again on Breeders' Cup Day. "He has only been beaten three times, and all three times have been on right-handed courses," he said. "It's very possible he is just better going left-handed. He changes legs quicker and quickens much better." O'Brien, who took the 2001 Juvenile with Johannesburg, has two pre-entered for that race this year, but said yesterday that **Grand Reward** (Storm Cat) is more likely to run than Ballydoyle stablemate **Old Deuteronomy** (Storm Cat). Also representing the stable in the pre-entries are Mile also-eligible **Statue Of Liberty** (Storm Cat), F/M Turf runners **L'Ancrese (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) and **Yesterday (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), and Classic possible **Hold That Tiger** (Storm Cat). What can O'Brien do to improve his Breeders' Cup percentage? "The bottom line is just you have to have a very good horse," he said.

MEEHAN TARGETS CHAMPIONS' DAY

Brian Meehan yesterday gave an upbeat bulletin on his challengers for the two feature events on tomorrow's Champions' Day card at Newmarket. **Kaieteur** (Marlin), who heads for the G1 Emirates Airline Champion S., was reported "in good shape" by the Lambourn conditioner. The four-year-old dead-heated for third before being promoted to second in the G1 Arlington Million Aug. 16, but disappointed when only third in the G3 Select S. at Goodwood last time Sept. 13. "He got hammered in the Arlington Million and his runs have been spaced out so, although he's done a bit of traveling, he seems in good shape," said Meehan. "It was a pretty good race last time, but we all felt he didn't really enjoy the track at Goodwood." Meehan is hopeful that he can reverse the form of the G1 Eclipse S. at Sandown July 6, in which he was third and **Nayef** (Gulch) second behind Falbrav (Ire). "Probably his best run of all this year was in the Eclipse. He deserves his shot and he's got a great chance." Marcus Tregoning, who will be saddling Nayef for his final race on Saturday, commented, "It's just a question of whether he's as good as he was, but we'll find out on Saturday. He's been all over the world and started his preparation for the Dubai World Cup in January, so has been on the go a long time. It's very difficult asking him to go from the beginning right to the end, but he seems in good form."

Juveniles Match Up in Dewhurst

In addition to Kaieteur in the Champion S., trainer Brian Meehan will also saddle Kennett Valley Thoroughbreds' **Cape Fear (GB)** (Cape Cross {Ire}) in Saturday's G1 Darley Dewhurst S. Having finished runner-up in the G2 July S. at Newmarket July 9, Cape Fear was fifth in the G2 Gimcrack S. at York Aug. 20 before winning the St Leger Yearling S. at Doncaster last time Sept. 10. "It was impressive to say the least the way he won that day," Meehan said. "He was just a bit short of pace at halfway and looked as if he would appreciate seven furlongs. I think he's one of the best two-year-old colts in the country, so he's where he should be." He will meet G1 Middle Park S. winner **Three Valleys** (Diesis {GB}) and G2 Royal Lodge S. winner **Snow Ridge (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) in that contest, as well as the Sheikh Mohammed bin Rashid al Maktoum color-bearer **Duke Of Venice** (Theatrical {Ire}), who was supplemented on Monday. Conditioner Marcus Tregoning believes that Snow Ridge has a bright future whatever the outcome of tomorrow's race. "He is a very exciting horse," Tregoning said yesterday. "Whatever he does here, he is going to be pretty decent next year. He's been showing us plenty of dash and I don't think the drop back to seven furlongs will hinder him too much. He's worked well and I'm happy with him." Trainer Mark Johnston is expecting a big run from Sandown maiden scorer Duke of Venice. "He did a half-speed with Attraction and showed us he was one of the few who could lay upsides with her, which is no mean feat...If he wins, it will not be a surprise, but it's a little bit of a shot in the dark."

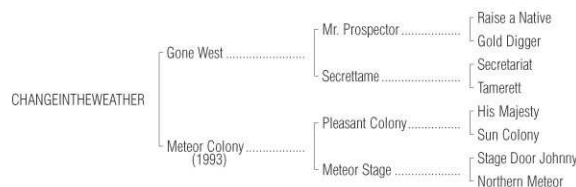

Jockey Club Releases 2003 Reports:

According to the Reports of Mares Bred (RMBs) received by The Jockey Club as of Oct. 9, 3,342 stallions covered 58,755 mares in North America during 2003. The statistics, which make up 90 percent of the mares bred in 2003, represents the number of mares bred to each stallion. Past trends indicate that The Jockey Club will likely receive an additional 800-1,000 RMBs for the current term. The number of stallions bred declined 0.7 percent from the 3,364 reported at this time last year, while the number of mares bred dipped 0.6 percent from the 59,090 reported in 2002. "The returns to date are nearly on par with those reported last year at this time and support our earlier projection of 37,200 North American registered foals of 2004," said Matt Iuliano, JC vice president of registration services. The number of stallions bred to 100 or more mares increased from 93 last year to 108 in 2003 while Ashford stallion Grand Slam (Gone West) again led all stallions with 197 mares bred, four more than Johannesburg (Hennessy).
