'PHOENIX' REACHES CANADIAN SUMMIT

The lightest raced horse in this 10-horse field, **Phoenix Reach (Ire)** belied his lack of racing experience and powered his way to his first Grade I victory in Sunday's Canadian International S. at Woodbine. With only four previous starts to his credit, including a nose win in the G3 Gordon S. at Goodwood last July and most recently a third-place finish behind **Brian Boru (GB)**, beaten only 2 3/4 lengths, in the G1 St. Leger S. at Doncaster Sept. 13, the improving colt was let go at generous 5-1 odds for his stateside debut. Equipped with blinkers for the first time here, the bay proved a handful early as he tracked a lazy early pace over the race-softened turf. Eased back to fifth two-furlongs out, Phoenix Reach mounted his challenge along the rail, took over at the eighth pole and carried his momentum late for the score. Defending Canadian International winner Ballingarry, who arrived Wednesday morning from California, was scratched Sunday after developing an infection in his right front hock. Azeri's Distaff Start in Limbo

A sharp six-furlong work at her San Luis Rey Downs base Friday appeared to have defending champion **Azeri** (Jade Hunter) on course for Saturday's Distaff, how-

ever, trainer Laura de Seroux later admitted that she was concerned with the five-year-old's obstinate behavior. "I'm thinking about it very seriously," de Seroux told the *Blood-Horse*. "She worked fast. It was effortless, but I've given a lot of thought to her behavior because it's such a departure from the norm. She's done it the last three works. That can't be ignored."

According to de Seroux, she will discuss Azeri's future with Michael Paulson, who manages the Allen Paulson Living Trust, when he returns from a weekend cruise.

Cactus Ridge out of Juvenile

Trainer Bret Calhoun announced yesterday that undefeated **Cactus Ridge** (Hennessy) will not start in Saturday's Juvenile because of a knee injury. "He came back from Saturday's work [5f, 1:00 1/5] in good order, but this morning when we walked him he was off in his right front," explained Calhoun. "We took some X-rays and discovered the injury in his right knee. It's not career threatening, but he'll be laid up for a couple of months. We'll have to look forward to a three-year-old campaign." Owned by Dream Walkin' Farm, the juvenile recorded his biggest win last time out in the GIII Arlington Washington Futurity Sept. 27. Cactus Ridge would have been the first Breeders' Cup starter for Calhoun. "I'm still a little shocked and I haven't had a chance to digest the news yet," Calhoun added. "This is a terrible blow to have one this close to the Breeders' Cup. That's part of the game. The highs are high, and the lows can be really low."

With only three starts under her belt this term, Volga kicked off 2003 with a rousing 1 3/4-length score in the GIII Matchmaker H. at Monmouth Park Aug. 17 before finding herself behind by that same margin next time in the GII Canadian H. over this track and distance Sept. 14. Sent south for the 9.5-furlong GII Winstar Galaxy S. at Keeneland Oct. 5, the dark bay faded to fifth, beaten 10 3/4 lengths, after being asked to lay closer than usual to the early pace. Returning to the running style that had yielded results in the past, Volga successfully avenged last year's neck loss to Choc Ice with the score here. Bumped at the start, the five-year-old settled near the back of the pack as local hope Inish Gloria (Regal Classic) cut out modest early fractions. Racing four wide as she zeroed in on the leaders a furlong out, Volga powered to the front midstretch and refused to yield late as Tigertail took her shot, but still came up short.

Pearl of Love made virtually all under a positive ride from Darryll Holland to provide Mark Johnston with his second renewal of this contest after the exploits of Lend a Hand (GB) in 1997. After breaking his maiden over six furlongs May 24, he comfortably beat Tycoon (Ire) by 1 ½ lengths when stepped up to seven furlongs for the Listed Chesham S. at Royal Ascot June 18. He demonstrated his power from the front when winning the G2 Futurity S. at The Curragh Aug. 23, then returned to that track to finish third behind One Cool Cat in the G1 National S. Sept. 14. Unhappy with this sedate early tempo, he was asked to dispute the lead with Mister Strong (Ire) (Alhaarth {Ire}) before taking command entering the straight. Attacked on all sides, he responded to strong driving to hold the persistent challenge of Spirit of Desert and Maurizio Pasquale in the drive to the line as Barbajuan stayed on for third under Kieren Fallon. "I've always thought he was a Guineas horse and that's his next race," Mark Johnston commented. "Looking at yesterday's race [the Dewhurst] at Newmarket, I thought this was a high-quality race, too." Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid al Maktoum's Ekraar finally delivered Group 1 success after a career marked by consistency and durability. Following a juvenile campaign that saw him win the G3 Vintage S. and finish third in the G1 Racing Post Trophy, he trebled his stakes tally during a sophomore season, taking the G3 Rose of Lancaster S. and G3 Select S. Transferred to Godolphin from Marcus Tregoning's stable, he performed with credit for the Dubai-based operation, finishing third in the G1 Prix d'Ispahan and runner-up in the G1 Hong Kong Vase. The bay enjoyed a light five-year-old campaign that saw him finish runner-up to Falbrav (Ire) in the G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica in Rome before finishing third in this contest and fourth in the Hong Kong Vase at Sha Tin. He re-joined Tregoning at the start of this term and had since finished third in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic at Nad al Sheba Mar. 29 before winning a conditions race at Doncaster June 7. He dropped back to last after pace-setting for stable companion Nayef in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 18, then returned after a break to capture the Listed Fishpools Furnishings Godolphin S. at Newmarket Oct. 3. Vallee Enchantee looked a promising juvenile when winning the Listed Prix Isonomy at Saint-Cloud in November, but failed to make an impact in the spring and early summer. After returning to finish sixth in the G3 Prix Penelope at Saint-Cloud Apr. 8, she ran third in the G3 Prix Cleopatre at that track May 12 and could fare no better than seventh behind Nebraska Tornado in the G1 Prix de Diane Hermes June 8. But she returned from a break to win the G2 Prix de Pomone at Deauville Aug. 10 and was not disgraced when fourth behind Mezzo Soprano in the G1 Prix Vermeille at this venue last time Sept. 14. Settled towards the rear off the suicidal fractions carved out by Narrative (Sadler's Wells) here, she needed gentle encouragement to keep tabs on the field, but steadily responded to pressure to close at the top of the straight. Taken wide into the centre of the track for her run as Vangelis and Kalabar wore down the long-time leader, she reeled in that duo to capture the prize in the final strides. "She got the strong, even pace she needs here," said conditioner Elie Lellouche. "In these conditions she can quicken very nicely. She is entered in the G1 Hong Kong Vase [at Sha Tin Dec. 14]. She will probably go there and might stay in training next season." Classic entrant **Medaglia d'Oro**, who was partnered by regular exercise rider Marco Ramirez, breezed six furlongs in 1:12 1/5, the fastest of six moves at the distance. Marco Ramirez was also the pilot on Distaff hope **Sightseek** (Distant View), the winner of four straight Grade I races since May. The Juddmonte homebred negotiated five panels in :59 1/5, the fastest time of 26 on the day, and galloped out six furlongs in 1:12 1/5. Rounding out the quartet was **Heat Haze (GB)** (Green Desert) and **Tates Creek** (Rahy), who both remain on course for the Filly/Mare Turf. Working in tandem, the fillies breezed five furlongs, with Heat Haze covering the distance in 1:01 3/5 and **Tates Creek** going 1:01 2/5.

L'Anresse Added to Ballydoyle Team

Trainer Aidan O'Brien yesterday confirmed that he will have five runners for the Breeders' Cup at Santa Anita Saturday. O'Brien is shipping **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) for the Turf, **Hold That Tiger** (Storm Cat) for the Classic, **Statue Of Liberty** (Storm Cat) for the Mile and both **Yesterday (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **L'Anresse (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) for the Filly and Mare Turf. The decision was made to add L'Anresse to that contest after she gave the right signals following her success in the Listed Finale S. at The Curragh Oct. 12. It was also revealed that Ballydoyle will be without a runner in the Juvenile, as both **Old Deuteronomy** (Storm Cat) and **Grand Reward** (Storm Cat) will skip the race.

Clock Stopper Out of Sprint

Clock Stopper (Gilded Time), winner of the Oct. 9 Perryville S. at Keeneland, will be forced to miss the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint due to an ankle injury. Trainer Dallas Stewart discovered Saturday afternoon that the three-year-old had wrenched his left front ankle. "We need to pass on the race," Stewart said. "You've got to be realistic about it. It's going to be the toughest race of his life and you have to be 110 percent. We'll give him some time off and bring him back next year."

Funny Cide Breezes

Sackatoga Stable's **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) breezed six furlongs over Belmont's fast training track Sunday in what will be his final preparatory move before being sent to Santa Anita Park Wednesday for a tilt at the Classic. Covering the distance in 1:13 3/5, with Robin Smullen aboard, the gelding galloped out seven panels in 1:26 and a mile in 1:40. "It was perfect," Smullen said. "I knew it was an awesome work, one of the best I've ever had on him." Looking ahead to Saturday, Smullen added, "He's as ready to run as he's ever been without having a race in him. Is it good enough to win the Breeders' Cup Classic? I don't know."

Ethan Man Sharp at Churchill

Ethan Man (Glitterman), runner-up in the Oct. 3 GIII Phoenix Breeders' Cup S. at Keeneland last time out, prepped for the Sprint at Churchill Downs yesterday, going five furlongs in a bullet 1:00. "I thought the work was exceptionally good because of where he was positioned [on the deepest part of the track] and because he was just going easy," trainer Pat Byrne said. "He's coming up to a tough race with a really fast bunch of horses, so I was happy with it." The four-year-old ships west Thursday. As for his chances in what will be his Grade I debut, Byrne said, "I think he belongs," and added, "The best horse doesn't necessarily have to win the Sprint. As everybody knows, it's a certain amount of luck there with the way you're drawn and how you're placed early in the race. I think this horse's running style really could set it up good for him out there."
