THE SUN SHINES ON SANTA ANITA

The Breeders' Cup returns to Santa Anita for the first time since 1993, just in time to celebrate the 20th anniversary of the championships. Once again, Eclipse Awards are on the line in every division as the favorites in each race have question marks about their chances. "We're just delighted with both the quality and the depth and breadth [of our entries]," said Breeders' Cup President D.G. Van Clief, Jr. "It sets up some very interesting contests." Distaff favorite **Sightseek** (Distant View) has come up second best in each of her three starts at Santa Anita. Top juveniles **Halfbridled** (Unbridled) and **Cuvee** (Carson City) have drawn the outside post in their respective races. The Mile, with 13 runners, places a premium on racing luck, as usual, while the Filly & Mare Turf features a glittering array of talent from the U.S. and Europe. And the recently retired Mineshaft and Empire Maker will have to trust that their regular season records can stand up to the results of a very competitive Classic.

From Across the Sea...

While the number of European shippers is not as great as recent years, who can argue with the quality of the representatives? **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) is back to defend his title in the Turf and faces a rematch with **Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King), the most accomplished older horse in England this season. **Islington (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who held her own against both of the aforementioned runners, returns for another tilt at the Filly/Mare Turf, where she spearheads a five-strong European challenge. The Mile features a trio of top three-year-olds in **Oasis Dream (GB)** (Green Desert), **Refuse to Bend (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and **Six Perfections (Fr)** (Celtic Swing {GB}), while **Relaxed Gesture (Ire)** (Indian Ridge {Ire}) will try the dirt in the Juvenile. And who should return but **Hold That Tiger** (Storm Cat), Europe's champion two-year-old who made a brilliant run in last year's Juvenile. He will take his chance in the Classic this time around.

THE RECIPE FOR TROPHY SUCCESS

Recent evidence suggests a simple formula is required to win today's G1 Racing Post Trophy at Doncaster. Simply put, it involves being trained by Aidan O'Brien, who has won four of the last six renewals. And it doesn't hurt to be sired by Sadler's Wells. However, O'Brien's last three winners scored on rain-softened ground, and the prolonged dry spell that has continued into the fall could hurt his chances this year. The Ballydoyle duo is headed by Susan Magnier's **Magritte (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who may find the fast surface against him. The colt, described as a "beauty" by his trainer after a facile debut score in a Tipperary maiden July 20, has not been out since. But it is the presence of Juddmonte Farms' **American Post (GB)** (Bering {GB}) that is most likely to deny O'Brien another Trophy. American Post was supplemented after he massacred weak opposition in the Oct. 5 G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp. That four-length victory came on soft ground and it remains to be seen whether he can reproduce his finish on this livelier surface. **Fantastic View** (Distant View), runner-up to the smart Punctilious (GB) in a Salisbury conditions event Sept. 4, defied penalties to win the Listed Stardom S. at Goodwood eight days later and G3 Autumn S. at Ascot Oct. 11.

THE BREEDERS' CUP JUVENILE SENSATION



SARAFAN OUT OF MILE... Six-year-old veteran **Sarafan** (Lear Fan) was not vanned over from Hollywood Park Friday afternoon, and trainer Neil Drysdale informed Breeders' Cup officials that the gelding would not run in the Mile. "It looks as if he might be coming down with something, so we won't run," Drysdale explained. "He's dull and his blood count is poor." Drysdale had intended to point the Gary Tanaka colorbearer to big races in the Far East, but those plans may be put on hold. "We'll back off him for now and see how he does in the coming days," Drysdale added.

A DECADE LATER...Ten years ago, the Breeders' Cup witnessed its biggest upset when Arcangues triumphed at 133-1 in the Classic with Jerry Bailey in the irons. Bailey has since risen to the top of the jockey ranks and has the mount on no less than four morning-line favorites on this Breeders' Cup Card....Trainer Richard Mandella had a pair of Eclipse champions win a decade ago, including Horse of the Year Kotashaan (Fr), and hopes that this year's Juvenile Fillies favorite **Halfbridled** (Unbridled) can duplicate Phone Chatter's feat in 1993.

BACK TO THE BEGINNING...Three of the first four Breeders' Cups were contested in California, but in the past 10 years, the championships have been ensconced in more autumnal settings, except for an appearance at Hollywood in 1997 and a Gulfstream sojourn in 1999. "I can't help but remark on the appropriateness of being here in southern California for the 20th renewal of the Breeders' Cup World Thoroughbred Championships," said D.G. Van Clief, Jr. "If the Blue Grass of Kentucky was where the program was born, the tracks of southern California is where it was weaned and took its first successful steps."

The lone three-year-old in the field, King Robyn gave jockey Alex Solis career victory 4,000 with this front-running effort. Bred in Florida, the bay was runner-up in the GIII Baldwin S. over course and distance Feb. 23, and added stakes wins on both turf and dirt in the spring before heading back to the Sunshine State for the GIII Carry Back S. July 12. He ran fourth that day to Breeders' Cup Sprint hopeful Valid Video, but returned to Del Mar to take the Green Flash H. on the turf Aug. 20, then added the Foothill H. at Fairplex for good measure Sept. 12. Breaking alertly, the crowd's choice cut out a respectable pace (:21.91, :43.82) heading down the hill. Medecis took a run at him late, but King Robyn kept his head in front all the way to the wire. "That's how he likes to run," said Solis, who became the 42nd North American jockey to win 4,000 races. "This is a major accomplishment." By far the longest shot on the board, Runaway Dancer came flying late to deny Swedish shipper Labirinto in a thrilling finish. Previously a denizen of northern California for former trainer Art Sherman, the grey ran fifth in the GIII Bay Meadows Derby last November and was sidelined following a third in a Golden Gate optional claimer later that month. He resurfaced with a fifth at Hollywood June 29, then paired up optional claiming victories going 11 furlongs at Del Mar July 24 and Aug. 25, both with Mike Smith in the irons. He went north up Rt. 5 and wound up sixth in the GIII Bay Meadows Breeders' Cup H. Sept. 27, an effort which gave him no respect on the board in this spot. With Mike Smith back aboard, Runaway Dancer settled at the back of the pack as the field made their way down the hill and maintained that position until the top of the stretch. Smith tipped his mount to the outside and the iron grey accelerated smartly, getting up in the final strides to prevail in a blanket finish. "This is a true mile-and-a-half horse, he really is," said Smith. "I was surprised to see him at that price, to tell you the truth." Runaway Dancer now resides in the barn of Dan Hendricks, who feels he has figured out his charge's metier. "We found out at Del Mar he likes to run a mile and three-eighths or further, and I don't think there's a limit," he said. "He's about halfway to his potential. We're just going to have a lot of fun." Senor Swinger, stretching out to 12 furlongs for the first time, led late before winding up a close third.

Connections of Peak to Creek must be ruing the imminent close of the flat turf season as he proved again here that he is improving in leaps and bounds. Always traveling supremely easily towards the rear under Pat Eddery, he cruised to the front with a furlong remaining before opening up for an impressive score. Peak to Creek was tackling seven furlongs for the first time in this contest, having won six of his 11 previous starts over six. Those included the valuable Redcar Two-Year-Old Trophy Oct. 4 and Listed Rockingham S. at York Oct. 11 on his last two starts. "He is due to go to the sales next Thursday, but I think we'll now have to sit down and seriously discuss it," winning conditioner Jeremy Nosedo told *PA Sport*. "Pat [Eddery] was very bullish about him and he thinks he could be a 2000 Guineas horse. He relaxes so well that a mile should not be a problem for him."

Sixth to the recently retired Northerly (Aus) in this event last year, **Lonhro** has won 10 of 11 starts since then and goes in search of his ninth Group 1 victory today. Put away following a win in the G1 Queen Elizabeth S. in May, the five-year-old beat **Clangalang** by a neck in the Aug. 23 G2 Warwick S. before adding a score in the G2 Chelmsford S. Sept. 6. Winner of the G1 George Main S. Sept. 27, Lonhro successfully defended his title in the Oct. 11 G1 Yalumba S. over today's distance. The winner last season of the G1 AJC Australian Derby, Clangalang found Lonhro too tough when second in the G2 Warwick S. and fourth in the Chelmsford, but bounced back to take the Oct. 4 G1 Epsom H. by a long neck.

Dome driver Wins '02 Mile Horsephotos

IS TIME ON HIS SIDE?

Last year, **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}) came into the GI Breeders' Cup Classic off a nine-week layoff. Sent off the 5-2 favorite, he grabbed the lead after a mile, but couldn't keep up with longshot **Volponi** (Cryptoclearance) down the lane and had to settle for second. Undeterred, trainer Bobby Frankel gave the colt a nine-week break before this year's Classic. He doesn't believe it was the time off that got to Medaglia d'Oro in 2002. "I don't think it was the layoff that got him beat," Frankel

said. "I think it was the racetrack. He just doesn't like a drying-out racetrack. The two worst races he's run were [the 2002 Classic] and the Preakness. Both were drying-out racetracks. It doesn't look like he'll be dealing with that Saturday, and he loves it at Santa Anita." The colt is undefeated in two starts in Arcadia, taking the 2002 GII San Felipe S. and the 2003 GII Strub S. He followed his Strub victory with wins in the GII Oaklawn H. and in the GI Whitney H., where he beat Volponi by a length. Last time out, he finished second to Candy Ride (Arg) in the Aug. 24 GI Pacific Classic. Kentucky Derby hero **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor) has an even longer layoff to overcome. The New York-bred has not been out since running third in the Aug. 3 GI Haskell Invitational H. at Monmouth Park. He will attempt to become the third Derby winner to double up in the Classic in the same season. "Everything worked like clockwork going into the Kentucky Derby and everything has worked like clockwork going into this race," said Robin Smullen, assistant to trainer Barclay Tagg. "Sure, you'd like to have a race in him, but we didn't have that luxury. If he relaxes off the pace, he's going to be fit enough to be right there." Medaglia d'Oro and Funny Cide are likely to be out there contesting the pace with **Congaree** (Arazi), who is four-for-five at Santa Anita, but has been battling a quarter crack in a hind foot. A speed duel would set things up perfectly for **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer). Undefeated on the dirt this year, the gelding does his best running from just off the pace.

TURF...Team Europe carries a four-race winning streak into the John Deere Turf and has a strong chance to make it five straight today. The four entrants based overseas have amassed a total of 18 Group/Grade I's from Dubai to Nakayama to New York, while horses stabled in this country have registered nine wins at the

highest level. After much deliberation, **Falbrav (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) has landed in the Turf and not the Classic. The five-year-old, winner last season of the G1 Japan Cup, has put together a strong 2003 campaign under the tutelage of trainer Luca Cumani, with four Group 1 successes

to his credit this year alone. After defeating **Bright Sky (Ire)** (Wolfhound) by 1 1/2 lengths in the Prix d'Isphahan in May, the Irish-bred was a troubled fifth in the G1 Prince of Wales's S. at Royal Ascot June 18, but bounced back to annex the G1 Eclipse S. by 3/4 of a length July 5. Fifth over unsuitably soft ground in the G1 King George and Queen Elizabeth S. back at Ascot three weeks later, Falbrav took the G1 Juddmonte International S. Aug. 19, was a disputed second to **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) in the G1 Irish Champion S. Sept. 6 and most recently showed his versatility with a two-length score over the ultra-talented Russian Rhythm in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. over a flat mile Sept. 27. The 12-furlong journey this afternoon is something of a question mark, but with the opening three-eighths of a mile down the hill, the trip should be well within his capabilities. Said jockey Darryl Holland, "[Falbrav] will love the turf because it is rock hard. I'm not at all worried about the mile and a half."

Storming Home (GB) (Machia-vellian), the impressive winner of the Jim Murray H. over this distance in May, overcame a wide trip to win the 10-furlong GI Charles Whittingham H. June 14. Disqualified from the win in the GI Arlington Million when he ducked out in deep stretch Aug. 16, the five-year-old made amends with a 1/2-length defeat of GI Hollywood Derby hero **Johar** (Gone West) in the GI Clement L. Hirsch Memorial Sept. 28. Fifteenth behind Falbrav in the Japan Cup last year, the dark bay must prove he can defeat top-shelf horses at this distance.

He may be better suited by an outside trip this afternoon.

Awarded the victory in the GI Arlington Million, the showed his athleticism when overcoming a bad stumble en route to a 2 3/4-length win, with **Balto Star** (Glitterman) third, in the GI Turf Classic Sept. 27. A victory here would give Godolphin its third Turf in five years, following Daylami (Ire) in 1999 and Fantastic Light in 2001.

JUVENILE... Like the Classic, the luster of this event was tempered by a spate of defections, but its quality remains deep and several of the youngsters have Classic-type pedigrees who might offer a glimpse of what's to come next spring. Though lacking a true distance pedigree, Ron Winchell's **Cuvee** (Carson City) enters the race as the morning-line favorite, and deservedly so. Cuvee's shortest margin of victory in three

graded wins is 7 1/2 lengths and the chestnut blew away the GI Futurity S. field by 8 1/4 lengths in his most recent Sept. 14. Add regular jockey Jerry Bailey to the mix and you've got a formidable threat. While legitimate pedigree concerns and a wide post will leave handicappers skeptical, sheer talent might pave the way to the winner's circle. Trainer D.

Wayne Lukas will saddle his 35th Juvenile starter with **Race for Glory** (Cape Town). The handsome dark bay opened his account the right way at Arlington in mid-July, shaking loose of a three-way battle for the lead to win by six lengths. He came out of his next effort, a mediocre fourth in the James C. Ellis Juvenile, with a temperature, but got back on track against statebreds in the Cavonnier S. at Santa Anita Oct. 1. He took back professionally when a rival shot through to his inside, then sprinted clear when asked to win by seven lengths. Familiarity with the track is always a plus and his tractability will help in his initial route try. A pair of youngsters who should have no problems with the distance are **Tiger Hunt** and **Action This Day**, both by the late Kris S. The former won the MGD Cradle S. on Labor Day with a nice late run and, after making up a ton of ground and maneuvering through a crowded field, finished runner-up to Eurosilver in the GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland Oct. 4. Action This Day is coming off a maiden win, but trainer Richard Mandella--who will also start contenders **Siphonizer** (Siphon {Brz}) and **Minister Eric** (Old Trieste)--is high on the colt's chances. However, Tiger Hunt and Action This Day both come from the clouds and will be fighting for a minor prize if left with too much to do. **Chapel Royal** (Montbrook), whose future may well lie in sprinting, has never been worse than second and should be able to stalk just off the pacesetters. Keep in mind his facile GII Sanford victory. Trainer Bob Baffert's **Consecrate** (Silver Charm), beaten by double-digit lengths in his route and stakes debut in the Oct. 5 GII Norfolk S. over trip and track, has been working lights-out of late.

F/M Turf victress and 2002 second-place finisher Banks Hill (GB) (Danehill) is two-for-two over the Santa Anita grass, including a victory in the GIII Las Ciengas H. in April. Since shipping to the U.S. last December, she has never run worse than third in six starts. Her closing kick is extremely powerful and she seeks redemption after finishing third to **Dimitrova** (Swain {Ire}) as the 4-5 chalk in the 1 1/4-mile GI Flower Bowl Invitational H. at Belmont Sept. 27. MGISW **Tates Creek** (Rahy) boasts three wins out of four starts over the Santa Anita lawn, including the GI Yellow Ribbon at today's distance which earned her a 107 Beyer Speed Figure last out Sept. 28. Off since her victory in the GI John C. Mabee H. at Del Mar July 26, the two-time winner at the F/M Turf distance **Megahertz (GB)**

(Pivotal {GB}) rounds out the Frankel cavalry. "Quality-wise, you've got to like **Tates Creek** and **Heat Haze**," said Frankel, who ran one-two in the F/M Turf last year with **Starine (Fr)** and **Banks Hill**. "Distance-wise [1 1/4 miles], you've got to

Carry Back S. at Calder and still managed a 2 1/2-length victory. Stretching out to seven furlongs for his latest, the Florida-bred came from just off a hot pace to take the Aug. 23 GI King's Bishop S. by a neck over **Great Notion** (Elusive Quality). The dark bay is handy enough to keep tabs on the leaders early, but

will rate off suicidal fractions, and his versatility should stand him in good stead here. Valid Video has won at five different racetracks. He makes his first trip to the West Coast, but trainer Dennis Manning is not concerned about the trek. "He's shipped from Gulfstream to Ocala and won, he's shipped from New Jersey to Florida and won and he shipped up to Saratoga and won," Manning said. "I don't worry at all about the surface he's going to run on--just look at his race record." But if you're looking for a horse for the course, you have to go with morning-line chalk **Aldebaran** (Mr. Prospector). While the bay has yet to try the Sprint distance, he is a perfect two-for-two at Santa Anita, taking an optional claimer at seven furlongs in March of 2002 and the GI San Carlos H. at seven-eighths in March of this year. He has won five of seven starts in 2003, including the GII Tom Fool H. July 4 and, in his latest, the GI Forego H. Aug. 31. "I'd rather have this year's Sprint be seven-eighths of a mile, but I can't write the race," trainer Bobby Frankel said. "Coming off these longer races, though, I've got him good and fresh to run short. He'll run his race." Aldebaran would become the third son of Mr. Prospector to win the Sprint, following Eillo, who took the inaugural running in 1984, and Gulch, who succeeded in 1988. The upset possibility looks to be **Ethan Man** (Glitterman), who makes his third start after a 16-month layoff. The four-year-old, winner of the GIII Swale S. at three, was second in the Oct. 3 GIII Phoenix Breeders' Cup S. in his second outing after the extended absence. "I think three-quarters at Santa Anita will be perfect for him," said three-time Breeders' Cup winning trainer Pat Byrne.

Speed to Spare...Shake You Down (Montbrook) and **Great Notion** look most likely to fight for the lead, and front-running tactics work almost as often as not in the Sprint. Smile led nearly every step when taking the 1986 edition at Santa Anita. Shake You Down, claimed for \$65,000 at Aqueduct in March, has won six of seven starts under new colors. He dueled through a half in :43 4/5 before posting an 8 1/4-length score over **Private Horde** (Brunswick) in the July 12 GIII Smile Sprint H. at Calder. Fourth behind that rival in the Aug. 10 GII A. G. Vanderbilt H. on a sloppy Saratoga strip, he wired the field in a Belmont allowance Sept. 11. Great Notion lost all chance when squeezed at the start in the GIII Phoenix Breeders' Cup S., running sixth, but could rebound with a clean trip.

MILE...The Niarchos Family has won four renewals of the Breeders' Cup Mile, beginning with Miesque in 1987 and most recently last year, when Domedriver (Ire) surprised Rock of Gibraltar (Ire). Now, the French-based operation returns with another three-year-old filly, **Six Perfections (Fr)** (Celtic Swing {GB}), who hails from Miesque's female family. Classic glory eluded the black filly when she endured a pair of tough trips as the runner-up in both the English and Irish versions of the G1 1000 Guineas, but she rebounded with a victory over Domedriver in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois Aug. 17.

Now, however, she must overcome post 12 with a host of serious challengers to her inside. "This filly has a lot of class but she has things against her...the heat, the track is very fast, and her post position," said trainer Pascal Bary. "But I think she has enough class to run very well. She has a lot of speed so she should break well, and after that the jockey [Jerry Bailey] will decide where to go. He knows the track better than I do." Domedriver's win last year snapped a three-year streak in which the winner of the GII Oak Tree BC Mile doubled up in the Breeders' Cup Mile. **Designed for Luck** (Rahy) continued his unlikely comeback from injury by surprising an Oak Tree field that included **Century City (Ire)** (Danzig) and **Special Ring** (Nureyev). The latter is trained by Julio Canani, who sent out two of the Oak Tree/Breeders' Cup winners, **Silic (Fr)** in 1999 and **Val Royal (Fr)** in 2001. "I've won the Shoemaker Mile three times," said Canani. "It would be nice to win this three times, too." **Special Ring** defeated **Decarchy** (Distant View) by five lengths when setting a course record in the GI Eddie Read H. in July, but found himself uncustomarily well off the pace en route to a fourth in the Oak Tree race.

Overseas Invaders...
Six Perfections is one of just three foreign-based Mile entrants. Accompanying her in the starting gate will be fellow three-year-olds **Oasis Dream (GB)** (Green Desert), who ranks as Europe's top sprinter; and **Refuse to Bend (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), the G1 2000 Guineas hero who will be looking to rebound from a poor effort in the G1 Prix du Moulin Sept. 7. "We got things wrong in France," admitted trainer Dermot Weld. "The race just fell apart for us." **Oasis Dream** will be seeking to emulate '86 Mile hero **Last Tycoon (Ire)** as a sprinter stretching out. He is trained by John Gosden, who saddled **Royal Heroine (Ire)** to win the inaugural Mile.

ace in the undefeated filly **Halfbridled** (Unbridled). A five-length winner of the seven-furlong GI Del Mar Debutante Aug. 30, the bay proved that the added mileage was no problem when she galloped home a 4 1/2-length winner last time out in the GII Oak Leaf S. over track and distance

Sept. 28. According to Mandella, the filly's success to date comes as no surprise. "From the first day we saw her, I said that she was pretty special," explained Mandella. These are big words from the man who threw the bridle on a long list of stalwarts, including Gentlemen (Arg), Siphon (Brz) and Phone Chatter, who won this event in 1993. Widely proclaimed the horse to beat on class and talent alone, the filly also appears to receive an added edge with the race being contested in her own backyard. But Mandella is reluctant to concede her the victory. "It's nice to be at your home, but I've always believed that wherever you run, you better bring the horse with you," he said. The other unbeaten Grade I winner in the field is **Society Selection** (Coronado's Quest). The daughter of '96 Juvenile Fillies runner-up Love That Jazz captured the Oct. 4 GI Frizette S. at Belmont at this distance. Jockey Ray Ganpath, who was aboard for both lifetime victories, will be making his first Breeders' Cup appearance this year. "I thought Ray rode the filly very well, so why shouldn't he ride her in the Breeders' Cup?" commented Hall of Fame trainer H. Allen Jerkens. Rounding out the Grade I brigade is the Todd Pletcher-trained **Ashado** (Saint Ballado). Undefeated in her first three starts, including the seven-furlong GI Spinaway S. at Saratoga Aug. 29, the Starlight Stable filly came home a respectable third in the Frizette and looks to prove that she is not just a one-turn wonder. D. Wayne Lukas and Bob Baffert will send out a pair of fillies each. Lukas' best hope rests with **Be Gentle** (Tale of the Cat), 5 1/2-length winner of Keeneland's GII Alcibiades S., while Baffert looks for repeat glory in this race with undefeated **Class Above** (Quiet American), a 16-length winner of the mile Kentucky Cup Juvenile Fillies at Turfway Sept. 13, and Frizette runner-up **Victory U.S.A.**

The Bobby Frankel-trained four-year-old began her win streak with the GI Humana Distaff H. at Churchill Downs in May. She added the GI Ogden Phipps H. at Belmont in June and the GI Go For Wand H. at Saratoga in July before a dominant victory in the Oct. 4 GI Beldame S. in

her most recent start. "She looked fantastic breezing the other day," Frankel said of Sightseek. "She really hasn't taken a bad step all year--100 percent all year. Knock on wood, I hope she stays the same on Saturday." Standing in Sightseek's way is **Got Koko** (Signal Tap). A winner of five of seven starts at the Santa Anita oval, Got Koko defeated Sightseek in the GII La Canada and bested Azeri to win the Sept. 28 GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H. in her last start. "She acts great and looks great," trainer Bruce Headley said of the filly, adding, "Everybody has been pointing for this race. It's never easy. There are some great horses and great trainers in the field. I would just like some luck."

Also among the Distaff hopefuls is **Take Charge Lady** (Dehere). The four-year-old, trained by Ken McPeek, was a game runner-up to Azeri in the GI Apple Blossom H. in April and second to Sightseek in the Ogden Phipps. She earned her first win of the season with an 11-length romp in the Sept. 1 GIII Arlington Matron and added a second straight victory in the GI Overbrook Spinster S. Oct. 5 at Keeneland. "As good as she's doing, I wish Azeri and Wild Spirit were in the race," a confident McPeek said. "I think they would have made Sightseek the favorite anyway. But we have every intention of beating her."

The Sophomore Challengers...Three-year-old fillies ran second and third in last year's Distaff. This year's sophomore challengers are led by **Elloluv** (Gilded Time). Off the track for nearly five months after running fourth in the Kentucky Oaks, the bay filly returned to finish a game second in the Lady's Secret before being disqualified and placed fourth. Asked if she'd have to improve off that effort to win the Distaff, trainer Craig Dollase said, "Oh, yes, she sure has to." But Dollase, the youngest trainer to win a Breeders' Cup race, did see some positives in the race. "She was able to rate off of horses and that's going to be key on Saturday, with the extra distance," he explained. "With Azeri out, that should open the door a little more. She's very versatile and, going a mile and an eighth, you have to be able to rate a little." Of Elloluv's draw, Dollase said, "It's a perfect spot. It's just what we wanted; outside, with the speed on the inside of us." Also representing the sophomore class in the Distaff are **Lady Tak** (Mutakddim) and **Buy the Sport** (Devil's Bag). Lady Tak was an impressive winner of the GI Test S. at seven furlongs, but has had limited success stretching out. The filly just held on for second after setting the pace in the nine-furlong Sept. 6 GI Gazelle H. Buy the Sport won that race in her American debut and was a distant third behind Sightseek in the Beldame.
