THE RICHARD MANDELLA SHOW

Trainer Richard Mandella was still basking in the glory of his record-breaking four Breeders' Cup wins Sunday. After saddling Juvenile Fillies winner **Halfbridled** (Unbridled), Juvenile victor **Action This Day** (Kris S.), Turf

dead-heat winner **Johar** (Gone West) and Classic hero **Pleasantly Perfect** (Pleasant Colony), Mandella celebrated with dinner at a Santa Monica restaurant. "I can't remember the name of the restaurant, but it was the best I ever had," the conditioner said yesterday morning. "We were home by

10 o'clock. When you party with me, you don't get in any trouble. I came home, I went to bed and went right to sleep. Then I woke up at 2 o'clock and was re-running all the races in my mind. The best part is they all won again." Halfbridled cemented two-year-old filly championship honors with her impressive win Saturday. "I'm just going to take her shoes off and let her hack around the barn for about a week," Mandella said of the unbeaten filly. "She will not race again this year. I'll start thinking about something for her next year in January or February." Mandella said Action This Day and **Minister Eric** (Old Trieste) returned from their one-two finish in the Juvenile in fine shape and one of the pair could start in the GI Hollywood Futurity in December. Praising the Juvenile winner, Mandella commented, "In April, we laughed at Action This Day. He was the ugly duckling. But during Del Mar, he started looking like a different horse. He looked like he could run all day. Like [jockey] John Murtagh once said, "He'll stay as long as your mother-in-law." Mandella's 10th-place Juvenile finisher **Siphonizer** (Siphon {Brz}) required stitches for a superficial cut on a leg and will undergo throat surgery at a later date. Plans for Johar, who closed furiously to earn a dead-heat victory, are still pending. Pleasantly Perfect's late-running win in the Classic capped the day for Mandella, who said of the five-year-old, "He's a big horse with a big stride and when he leveled out at the three-eighths pole, I thought he was going to get it." Pleasantly Perfect will now be rested for a 2004 campaign. **More from the Breeders' Cup p. 4-5**

LEGER GOES WEST

He sports a pair of "earplugs" but it was the rivals of Alec Wildenstein's **Westerner** (GB) (Danehill) who needed them when he started firing in yesterday's G1 Prix Royal-Oak (French St Leger) at Longchamp. Always traveling easily in a stalking fifth under Dominique Boeuf, he swooped to the front at the quarter-mile marker as **Vinnie Roe** (Ire) (Definite Article {GB}) loomed alongside. As Boeuf pulled the plugs, Westerner sprinted away from that rival and was never in danger, pulling further clear as **Alcazar** (Ire) (Alzao) closed to within 2 1/2 lengths at the line. Westerner was twice runner-up to **Darasim** (Ire) (Kahyasi {Ire}) in the G2 Prix Kergolay and G3 Prix Gladiateur, but he was transformed by the encounter with an extreme trip over soft going, turning the G1 Prix du Cadran into a procession last time Oct. 5. "After the Cadran he showed me all the signs that he had not had a hard race," trainer Elie Lellouche explained. "I decided to bring him back and he proved what a good stayer he is here, winning easily. He will be kept in training with the G1 Ascot Gold Cup a possibility." **Click for the racingpost.co.uk chart or the free brisnet.com catalogue-style [pedigree](#).**

She gained the stakes success she deserved in the G3 Prix Minerve at Deauville Aug. 26 and was unlucky to finish second in the G2 Prix de Royallieu back at Longchamp last time Oct. 4. On that occasion jockey Thierry Jarnet mistook the winning post and stopped riding, only to be beaten a nose by Moon Search (GB). Here, she was settled in mid-pack by Franck Blondel before attacking the long-time leader Templerin with quarter of a mile remaining. Cappuccino showed little in three of his first four starts of the year, all at sprint distances. The lone exception was a respectable third-place finish in the seven-furlong Gil Churchill Downs H. over this track May 3, when he was beaten only 2 3/4 lengths by multiple Grade I winner Aldebaran. A dominant five-length winner when asked to stretch out in the 8 1/2-furlong Joseph T. Grace H. at Santa Rosa Aug. 2, the bay gave way grudgingly two back in the nine-furlong Governor's H. at Sacramento Aug. 23. Most recently a flat third to Crafty Shaw in the Turfway Park Fall Championship over a mile Sept. 27, Cappuccino went off an overlooked 8-1 shot this time. Off to a good start, the four-year-old pressed early pacesetter Pass Rush through the opening half mile, took over at the quarter pole and drew clear late to score by a comfortable two-length margin.

BREEDERS' CUP BULLETIN

FRUSTRATION FOR FRANKEL

Bobby Frankel appeared poised for a big day at Santa Anita Saturday, but the nation's leading trainer walked away empty handed. His day included four beaten favorites: **Sightseek** (Distant View), fourth in the Distaff, **Peace Rules** (Jules), last in the Mile, **Aldebaran** (Mr. Prospector), sixth in the Sprint and **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}), second in the Classic. "It was a rough day yesterday, but that's racing," admitted Frankel assistant Humberto Ascanio. "The good news is that all of the horses came back fine. They got back to the [Hollywood Park] barn at nine o'clock last night. It was one of those days." Ascanio added that **Tates Creek** (Rahy), vanned off the track after running eighth in the F/M Turf, suffered from heat stroke, but was recovering. The day was not a complete loss for Frankel. Even without a winner, his runners earned \$1,006,220.

CLASSIC

After battling Medaglia d'Oro through fast early fractions, **Congaree** (Arazi) held on to finish fourth in the Classic. "Those were really good horses going toe to toe," said Congaree's trainer Bob Baffert. "It just goes to show you that pace was wicked. Laffit Pincay was sitting next to us and he saw those horses going down the backside, he said, 'Man, those two horses are cooked.' He said, 'I can't believe they still hung on.'" Baffert added that Congaree will likely make his next start in the Nov. 29 G1 Cigar Mile at Aqueduct.

Perfect Drift (Dynaformer) was last in the 2002 Breeders' Cup Classic and improved slightly this year with a sixth-place effort. "At least we beat a few this time," trainer Murray Johnson said. "He fought real hard." Johnson added that Perfect Drift would likely get the remainder of the year off. "I will probably get him back in January or February and the first goal next year would be the [G1] Stephen Foster with maybe one or two starts before."

"He is a great horse and he ran a great race," trainer Christophe Clement said of **Dynever** (Dynaformer) and his third-place finish in the Classic. "He had a lot of trouble and still kept coming and only got beat by two older horses by about two lengths. We will put this horse away for now, and bring him back next year. I am looking forward to that."

TURF

Storming Home (GB) (Machiavellian), the 2-1 Turf favorite, finished a disappointing seventh after being bumped on the first turn. "Storming Home got run into on the first turn by **Sulamani (Ire)** (Hernando {Fr}) and it took a chunk out of his right hind foot," explained John O'Donoghue, assistant to trainer Neil Drysdale. "Sulamani was jostled back and moving around in the first turn and got him." Sulamani, fifth in the Turf, will ship to Dubai for the winter. **High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), likely retired after successfully defending his Turf title with a dead-heat victory, was expected to return to Ireland on a charter flight scheduled for Sunday night, along with fellow Coolmore runners **L'Ancrese (Ire)** (Darshaan {GB}) and **Yesterday (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), second and third in the F/M Turf.

JUVENILE

Juvenile favorite **Cuvee** (Carson City), four wide on the first turn, chased the fast early fractions and tired to last. "You've got to be one heck of a horse to overcome that," Scott Blasi, assistant to trainer Steve Asmussen, said yesterday. "The poor guy was hanging his head after that one. Cuvee is a nice horse, though." Also bemoaning the fast early fractions was trainer Bob Baffert, whose **Consecrate** (Silver Charm) ran fifth. "He is just learning how to run," Baffert said of Consecrate. "I made a mistake. I told [jockey Pat Valenzuela] to put him in the race and he wasn't very focused, so we were chasing behind a ridiculous pace. Down the backside, I thought, man I made the wrong move. I'll tell you what, when Adoration won the first one on the lead like that, that screwed the whole day up. Everybody came back like, oh, we've got to go."

SPRINT

Cajun Beat (Grand Slam) returned home to Churchill Downs early Sunday morning and trainer Steve Margolis said the three-year-old came out of his Sprint victory in great shape. Of Cajun Beat's next start, Margolis said, "We're going to wait and see how it goes. We have no plans for now." Margolis did say the speedster needs a month to six weeks between starts. "He's light-framed and runs hard," the trainer explained. Trainer Ted West was "thrilled" with **Bluesthstandard** (American Standard)'s runner-up finish in the Sprint. "We knew going in that we were going to have to improve off of any of our past races, but the horse was showing us that he was improving in the morning so much that it was a big reason why we took a shot," West commented. "It's nice that he ran like he did and validated our suspicions."

F/M TURF

F/M Turf winner **Islington (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) was expected to fly home to England Sunday night. Peter Reynolds, speaking for Ballymacoll Stud Farm, reported the filly was, "naturally tired, but looks superb. She goes home tonight before a decision is made on whether she'll run in another race this year before being retired to be bred next year."

MILE

Six Perfections (Fr) (Celtic Swing) gave the Niarchos Family its fifth win in the Mile, but the victory was not without some anxious moments when the filly began acting up behind the gate. "I didn't really know the rules over here," the family's racing manager Alan Cooper said. "In Europe after a time [attempting to load], they give up [and scratch the horse], but the handlers did a great job." Cooper added, "She returns to France on Monday and will be kept in training next year, hopefully to finish the season at Lone Star [in next year's Breeders' Cup Mile]." Trainer Beau Greely was happy with **Century City (Ire)** (Danzig)'s third-place finish as a 39-1 longshot. "With a little bit of luck, I think he would have won," Greely said. "But, with the exception of winning, I couldn't have been happier." Century City may start next in the GI Citation H. at Hollywood on Nov. 29, where he could meet Mile seventh-place finisher **Designed for Luck** (Rahy).

JUVENILE FILLIES

Ashado (Saint Ballado), sent off at 13-1 despite owning a Grade I victory, ran second Saturday. "I was very happy with the way she ran," said trainer Todd Pletcher. "The winner [Halfbridled] was very strong, but Ashado turned in a big effort." The filly was expected back at Belmont Park Monday morning. Third-place finisher **Victory U.S.A.** (Victory Gallop) may start next in the GI Hollywood Starlet, according to trainer Bob Baffert.

Other smart two-year-olds on offer include **Gwaihir (Ire)** (Cape Cross {Ire}), the winner of a Deauville Listed event in August, who appears as [Lot 429](#) from John Gosden's Manton stable. [Lot 1039](#), **Disospyros Blue (Ire)** (Bluebird), has finished second in Group 3 company for trainer Jamie Osborne, while [Lot 998](#), Antediluvian (GB) (Air Express {Ire}), made a sparkling debut earlier this month for trainer James Given when winning a Redcar maiden by six lengths. Among the older horses, the Aidan O'Brien-trained **Middlemarch (Ire)** (Grand Lodge), [Lot 70](#), won a Curragh conditions race on Saturday, although [Lot 492](#), **Princely Venture (Ire)** (Entrepreneur {GB}) is the highest-rated horse for sale, having won the G2 Scottish Derby at Ayr this year. The Aga Khan's offerings are always popular and these include [Lot 470](#), **Akshar (Ire)** (Danehill), who has performed well in top handicap and Group 3 company this year.
