### DURING'S DISCOVERY

James McIngvale's **During** (Cherokee Run) determinedly held off a prolonged challenge from **Unforgettable Max** (Northern Afleet) for his third graded stakes victory this year in the GIII Discovery H. at Aqueduct yesterday.

After defeating Ten Most Wanted in the GII Swaps S., the dark bay lost a pair of stakes at Saratoga, but rebounded in his latest, winning the GII Jerome H. in game fashion Sept. 13. "I thought I ran out of horse at the quarter-pole," said rider Jose Santos. "I hit him left-handed

and he just kept giving me more." The dark bay stalked the pace before joining battle with Unforgettable Max at the top of the stretch. Favored **Congrats** (A.P. Indy) spun his wheels en route to finishing fourth. "We just ran even," said trainer Shug McGaughey.

### A NEW MARKET FOR BLOODSTOCK

The launch of EquineCommerce.com will be announced at a press conference Nov. 7 at Thoroughbred Club of America in Lexington, Kentucky. Structured like a stock market, the new venture will use the Internet to facilitate trading of bloodstock of various ages as well as certain breeding interests. EquineCommerce.com is spearheaded by Barry Weisbord, who also founded Matchmaker Breeders' Exchange in 1983. "This will enable equine professionals to conduct trades in Thoroughbred interests utilizing the Internet, while promoting commercial integrity and competitive practices in this industry," said Weisbord.

### JOHAR TO JAPAN CUP

The Thoroughbred Corp.'s **Johar** (Gone West), who deadheaded for the win in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Santa Anita last weekend, will head across the Pacific for his next outing in the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 30 at Tokyo Racecourse. "For sure he's going," said trainer Richard Mandella. "We plan to ship around the middle of next month." The Japan Cup, contested at 2400 meters on turf at Tokyo Racecourse, carries a purse of over the equivalent of \$4.3 million.

### TWINING BACK TO JAPAN

Vinery Kentucky has announced that Shadai Corporation has purchased a 50 percent interest in **Twining** (Forty Niner), and the 12-year-old stallion will not return to the U.S. at the end of the Southern Hemisphere breeding season. Instead, he will stand the Northern Hemisphere season at Shadai Stallion Station in Japan. Twining, a son of Broodmare of the Year Courtly Dee (Never Bend), had previously stood at Japan's East Stud; his first foals from his sojourn there are now two-year-olds. He is among the leading first season sires there with 21 individual winners to date. From his four Kentucky crops to race, Twining has sired six graded stakes winners, including millionaire Two Item Limit. Shadai had stood the successful Forty Niner stallion End Sweep until his untimely demise last year.

Halfbridled had been flawless in capturing her first three starts, including the GI Del Mar Debutante S. and GII Oak Leaf S., by a combined margin of 14 lengths. On Breeders' Cup Day, she faced the task of breaking from the widest spot in the 14-horse field, but she overcame that potential hazard with great aplomb to score by 2 1/2 lengths in a time considerably quicker than the two-year-old colts put up the same afternoon.

Halfbridled is from the penultimate crop sired by the GI Kentucky Derby and GI Breeders' Cup Classic winner [Unbridled](#). The son of Fappiano wasn't always the most consistent sire, but his best were very good. His other stars include this year's GI Belmont S. victor Empire Maker, champion three-year-old filly Banshee Breeze, champion two-year-old colt Anees, GI Kentucky Derby victor [Grindstone](#), Preakness hero Red Bullet, GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile winner and major sire Unbridled's Song and GISWs Manistique, Unshaded and Exogenous.

Halfbridled is a member of a family which has excelled in producing quality females. She is the first foal of her dam, the Deputy Minister mare Half Queen. Half Queen is half-sister to [A.P. Indy](#)'s daughter Lu Ravi, a multiple graded stakes winner of over \$1.8 million. She is out of the [Seeking the Gold](#) mare At the Half, who became a graded stakes winner with a victory in the GIII Golden Rod S. Halfbridled's third dam Knitted Gloves earned graded stakes honors in the GIII Magnolia S. and also produced the Grade I-winning colt Spruce Needles.

All horses in the *TDN* are bred in North America, unless otherwise indicated

Halfbridled is bred on the emerging Fappiano/Vice Regent cross, and is set to join champion older horse Victory Gallop (sire of Victory U.S.A., who was third to Halfbridled here, in his first crop) as an Eclipse Award winner with this pattern. Halfbridled's pedigree also shows 3x4 inbreeding to Mr. Prospector through Fappiano and Seeking the Gold, which conforms to the trend of doubling Mr. Prospector through sons doing particularly well when one of the agents is Fappiano (a very untypical Mr. Prospector).

We can also note that Unbridled is inbred to the mare Aspidistra, a daughter of Better Self, and that Halfbridled has Buckpasser (dam Busanda a close genetic relative to Better Self) 5x5.

**PROUD CITIZEN TO AIRDRIE** The 2002 Kentucky Derby runner-up **Proud Citizen** (Gone West--Drums of Freedom, by Green Forest) has been retired from racing and will enter stud next year at Airdrie Stud for a fee of \$12,500, live foal. "We've never had a better-looking stallion at Airdrie," said Brereton C. Jones, owner of the Midway, Kentucky farm. "He's a super star. He had a ton of speed and certainly proved he could carry it the classic distances against the very best." A \$425,000 Keeneland September yearling, the bay colt broke his maiden by 9 1/4 lengths in his second career start for trainer D. Wayne Lukas. At three, he won the GII Lexington S. prior to finishing second in the GI Kentucky Derby and third in the GI Preakness S., but sustained a condylar fracture in the GI Belmont S. and never recaptured his form. He posted one win in seven starts this year, a Churchill allowance victory, and concluded his career with a sixth in the GI Ancient Title Breeders' Cup H. at Santa Anita. Racing in the colors of Baker, Cornstein and Mack, Proud Citizen finished up with a record of 16-3-2-1 and earnings of \$638,822. By Gone West, whose sons at stud include Elusive Quality, Grand Slam and Mr. Greeley, Proud Citizen hails from the female family of Northern Dancer. **DOLLAR BILL TO STAND IN FLORIDA** Millionaire **Dollar Bill** (Peaks and Valleys--Saratoga Dame, by Saratoga Six) has run his last race and will enter the breeding shed in 2004 at William Schettino's Signature Stallions in Reddick, Florida. Acquired by Gary and Mary West as a yearling for \$145,000 at Keeneland September in 1999, he captured the GII Brown & Williamson Kentucky Jockey Club S. at two and added a victory in the Risen Star S. as a three-year-old. Though he didn't win another stakes, the bay was a solid competitor, posting seconds in the GI Stephen Foster H. and the GII Hawthorne Gold Cup and thirds in the GI Travers S., the GI Oaklawn H. and the GI Toyota Blue Grass S. He made one start this for trainer Bobby Frankel, finishing third to Mineshaft and Volponi in the GI Suburban H. July 5. His career record stands at 22-4-5-5 with a bankroll of \$1,225,546. Dollar Bill will stand for a fee of \$3,500, live foal, stands and nurses.

**SLEW O' GOLD MARE TOPS BARRETT'S FINALE** The second and final session of the Barretts October Mixed Sale at Fairplex Park in Pomona, California, was topped by Hip [749](#), the seven-year-old Slew o' Gold mare **Got the Votes**. Out of Katambera (Flag Officer), the Harris Farms, agent, consignee was purchased for \$55,000 by Blooming Hills, Inc. Got the Votes is a half sister to MGSW Work the Crowd (Political Ambition). She is believed to be in foal to Cee's Tizzy. Figures continued to disappoint during the second session, as the average plummeted 28.7 percent, from \$7,485 in 2002 to \$5,339 this year. The sale's two-day average witnessed a similar decline, falling 25.8 percent, from \$7,510 in 2002 to \$5,576 this year. The RNA rate for the sale rose 8.8 percent, with 23.8 percent of those on offer being bought back. *Stats, p7*

Three-year-old **Eugene's Third Son** (Indian Charlie) returns to the races for the first time since April in today's eighth race at Churchill Downs, a seven-furlong allowance for non-winners of three lifetime. A winner first time out over this surface last year, the bay made two starts at Gulfstream over the winter, finishing second to Cajun Beat--recent winner of the GI Breeders' Cup Sprint--prior to posting a two-turn allowance score. He then hit the Triple Crown trail, finishing second in both the GII Lane's End S. and the GII Arkansas Derby. The discovery of a fractured splint bone shortly thereafter forced him to the sidelines, but he has been training steadily for his comeback.
