**TATES CREEK RETIRED**

Juddmonte's top turf mare **Tates Creek** (Rahy--Viviana, by Nureyev) has been retired from racing following a poor performance in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf in which she was believed to have suffered from heat exhaustion, according to *Thoroughbred Times*.

Breeding plans have not yet been finalized. The five-year-old, a half sister to MGISW Sightseek, captured the GI Yellow Ribbon S. and the GI Gamely Breeders' Cup H. prior to her Breeders' Cup appearance. After winning three of four starts at three for trainer Bobby Frankel, Tates Creek captured three graded stakes in 2002 and remained in training for this year. In 2003, the chestnut won three of her five outings, capturing the GII San Gorgonio H. in addition to her pair of Grade I victories and also

deadheaded for second in the GI John C. Mabee H. at Del Mar this summer. Tates Creek heads to the breeding shed with a record of 17-11-3-0 and earnings of \$1,471,674. This family has been live for Juddmonte this year, with Viviana's full sister Willstar being the dam of French Group 1 winner Etoile Montante. A half sister, Hometown Queen (Pleasant Colony), produced GSW Bowman's Band.

**IRISH RACES UPGRADED**

Irish racing has received a boost with the announcement that two races, both for three-year-old and upwards fillies and mares, have been upgraded to Group 1 status for next season. The Pretty Polly S., over a mile at the Curragh in June, and the Matron S., over 10 furlongs at Leopardstown in September, are the relevant contests and head a number of other upgrades which have yet to be announced. "The promotion of the Pretty Polly S. is particularly exciting, as it will become the first Group 1 opportunity for older fillies in Europe," Curragh track manager Paul Hensey told *Irish Times*.

**VOODOO DANCER TO BREEDING SHED**

Green Hills Farm's **Voodoo Dancer** (Kingmambo--Zuri, by Danzig) has concluded her cross-country career and will be bred next spring to A.P. Indy. "She is a remarkable mare and has done enough," trainer Christophe Clement told *Daily Racing Form*. Clement trained the blaze-faced bay to victory in the GI Garden City Breeders' Cup H. at three in 2001. At four, Voodoo Dancer added wins in Del Mar's GII Palomar H., the GIII Locust Grove H. at Churchill and the GIII Beaugay H. at Aqueduct. This year, the bay travelled to Hollywood to annex the GII Beverly Hills H. before returning to Saratoga to capture the GI Diana H. over Heat Haze (GB). Sidelined by sickness after that July 26 start, she made one final career outing, running seventh in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf Oct. 25. In all, she earned \$1,427,952, while compiling a record of 21-11-4-2.

**SHINE AGAIN RETIRED**

One of the most consistent runners in New York, **Shine Again** (Wild Again--Shiner, by Two Punch) has been retired to owner Allaire duPont's farm in Maryland, according to *Daily Racing Form*. The six-year-old mare opened 2003 with a pair of victories, including the GII Genuine Risk H., before going on to post five straight runner-up efforts. A winner at two, the Maryland-bred didn't win her first stakes until age four, when she captured the GI Ballerina H. and the GII First Flight H. Under the tutelage of Allen Jerkens, she successfully defended her title in both the Ballerina and First Flight in 2002, but came up a nose short in the Ballerina this year, and closed out her career with a neck loss in the First Flight. A half sister to graded stakes winner Shiny Band, Shine Again heads into retirement with a record of 34-14-10-7 and earnings of \$1,271,840.

**CAREER OVER FOR CACTUS RIDGE** Unbeaten two-year-old **Cactus Ridge** (Hennessy--Double Park {Fr}, by Lycius), forced to miss the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile with a knee fracture, has been retired from racing, according to *Daily Racing Form*. "It's a fracture to the third carpal bone," trainer Bret Calhoun told *DRF*. "If he was a claiming horse, you'd give him four to six months and bring him back, but I think the odds of him coming back to where he was aren't good. He's undefeated and he's got some pedigree." After making a victorious debut at Arlington in June, the bay colt won the Canterbury Park Juvenile S. by 15 lengths and followed that up with a 6 1/2-length win in the James C. Ellis S. Aug. 17. In what would be his final career start, Cactus Ridge was a professional victor of the Gill Arlington-Washington Futurity Sept. 27, taking his bankroll to \$187,850. He has been shipped to Walmac Farm in Lexington, Kentucky and will be available for inspection during the Keeneland November Sale.

**RESTRUCTURED THOROUGHBRED CORP IN '04**

The Thoroughbred Corporation will take on a new look in 2004 after a business-restructuring plan put into place following the death of the company's founder Prince Ahmed bin Salman last summer. Nearly all of the corporation's breeding and young stock, including 42 mares and 16 weanlings, will be offered at Keeneland's upcoming November sale, while the majority of its yearlings were sold this fall. The Thoroughbred Corporation will still have 95 horses in training for 2004. "Changes were inevitable after Prince Ahmed bin Salman died in 2002," said company spokesman Terence Collier. "He was the chairman and the inspiration for The Thoroughbred Corporation. Without his hand on the helm, there had to be major changes in its day-to-day operations. Racing was his passion and his principal interest. As with most major racing stables, the broodmare band grew rapidly when many of the fillies he raced became stakes winners and were retired to stud. A significant reduction was already in the plans, but Prince Ahmed's untimely death hastened those plans." The Thoroughbred Corporation will retain majority shares in Horse of the Year Point Given and substantial parts of Dr Fong, Military and K.O. Punch, as well as primary ownership of Royal Anthem, David Copperfield and Performing Magic. Currently, The Thoroughbred Corporation has more than 100 horses-in-training, including Breeders' Cup Turf winner Johar, under the management of company president Richard Mulhall.

**Whipper** created something of an upset when denying Much Faster (Ire) and subsequent G1 Prix Marcel Bousac winner Denebola to secure the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 31, and was running on strongly last time out when fifth to Three Valleys in the G1 Middle Park S. **Ximb** maintained his undefeated record when successful in the Listed Prix du Haras de la Huderie at Deauville Aug. 26 and lost no honor in defeat as a promoted third behind dual Group 1 winner American Post (GB) in the G1 Prix Jean-Luc Lagardere on Arc day. **Chineur** has only raced at stakes level and followed a runner-up finish in the Listed Prix Yacowlef at Deauville Aug. 9 with a third-placed effort in the G3 Prix Eclipse Oct. 1. He broke his maiden in the Listed Criterium de Vitesse at the same track Oct. 13. **Villadolide**, second in the G3 Prix Eclipse, won the G3 Prix d'Arenberg at Sept. 10 and merits strong consideration.

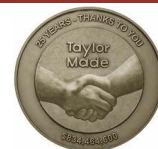

**14 GRADED EVENTS AT HOLLY PARK MEET**

Hollywood Park's Autumn Meet stakes schedule features 14 graded stakes, five of them Grade Is and will be worth \$3.6-million. The 30-day meet runs from Nov. 11 through Dec. 21. The 13th annual Turf Festival concludes Nov. 30 with the \$600,000 GI Hollywood Derby and the \$500,000 GI Matriarch. The Derby has been lengthened to 1 1/4 miles, while the Matriarch has been shortened to one mile. The \$250,000 GI Hollywood Turf Cup will be run Nov. 22. Closing weekend will feature a pair of Grade I events: the \$200,000 GI Hollywood Futurity, which has produced five Kentucky Derby winners since its inception in 1981, will be run Dec. 20; and the \$200,000 GI Hollywood Starlet will be contested on Dec. 21.

**Ethan Man Gets R&R:**

**Ethan Man** (Glitterman) suffered a leg injury in his 10th-place finish in the Breeders Cup Sprint and will be given farm rest to recuperate. The four-year-old gelding strained a suspensory ligament in his left front leg during the race. "He got checked down the backside and maybe that had something to do with it," explained trainer Pat Byrne. "The jock [Rene Douglas] said he felt really good prior to the race. He was a little off on his left front cooling out and we took some precautionary x-rays." Ethan Man returned from a layoff of more than a year to race three times this season, including a runner-up finish in the GIII Phoenix Breeders' Cup at Keeneland.

### FIELDS OF OMAGH FACES HONG KONG BAN

Hong Kong Jockey Club Executive Director of Racing Winfried Engelbrecht-Bresges has suggested that G1 Cox Plate winner **Fields of Omagh (Aus)** (Rubiton {Aus}) may not be allowed to race at the International meeting Dec. 14 should he contest the Nov. 30 G1 Japan Cup in Tokyo. Engelbrecht-Bresges told AAP Racing Online that the HKJC "cannot guarantee" the connections of Fields of Omagh an invitation, citing well-documented soundness issues with the six-year-old gelding as well as concerns over travel sickness. Two horses, Nayyir (GB) and Ulundi (GB) were forced to withdraw from last year's International Races due to travel sickness and a third, Malhub, was severely dehydrated and withdrawn from his race. While the HKJC has made it a habit of inviting Japan Cup participants to their races, the Club will apparently scrutinize those entries this year, as the Japan Cup falls just two weeks ahead of the International meeting, instead of the normal three.
