**TOUGH ACT TO FOLLOW FOR BAGO**

In its short two-year history, the G1 Criterium International has showcased the celebrities Act One (GB) and Dalakhani (Ire). Both brought unbeaten records into the race and emerged with them intact, and the Niarchos Family's **Bago (Fr)** (Nashwan) bids to emulate them at Saint-Cloud today. That organisation's famous colors have twice been carried to success in this race, formerly known as the G1 Grand Criterium and run at Longchamp before being renamed in 2001 and switched to this venue. In 1990 the exceptional juvenile Hector Protector took his record to a perfect six-for-six, having already captured the G1 Prix Morny and G1 Prix de la Salamandre, while 1998 hero Way of Light was stepping up off a second placing in the G3 Prix des Chenes. This year's renewal of that Longchamp contest marked the arrival of Bago, who showed smart acceleration to brush aside Valixir (Ire) by 1 1/2 lengths Sept. 20. He had previously beaten **Joursanvault (Fr)** (Verglas {Ire}) by two lengths in a conditions event at that track Sept. 2 and holds all the aces here. Since his defeat by Bago, Joursanvault has taken the Listed Criterium de Lyon at Lyon Parilly Oct. 16 and bids to provide conditioner Alain de Royer-Dupre with back-to-back renewals. Aidan O'Brien captured the old Grand Criterium in 1997 with Second Empire (Ire) and in 1999 with Ciro, and has saddled the runner-up in both renewals of the Criterium International. He relies solely on Galway maiden scorer **Acropolis (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells), who ran greenly when last of six behind American Post (GB) in the G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp last time Oct. 5. He needs to find major improvement to figure here, but will be helped by the step up to a mile.

Whipper quickened smartly to gain the advantage at the quarter-mile marker of this contest, allowing rider Christophe Soumillon the luxury of looking behind to find no dangers in the final 50 yards. The striking colt had entered the G1 Prix Morny as an outsider at Deauville Aug. 31, having failed to make an impact at that track in two previous stakes attempts. Nevertheless, he confounded the skeptics with a two-length defeat of Much Faster (Ire) in desperate conditions in the Morny. Taken to Newmarket to contest the intensely competitive G1 Middle Park S. Oct. 3, he stayed on to finish fifth despite having chased the furious early pace. "When you have a horse on the go for so long you can't always be sure they are at the top of their game at the end of the season," conditioner Robert Collet said. "Nevertheless, he was working well and looked well so on his best form I was confident. He's a very good horse and I wish I had more like him. He will come back here in April for the Listed Prix Djebel and then got back to Newmarket for the G1 2000 Guineas in May." Soave proved he was capable of winning a big sprint when taking the G3 Grosser Buchmacher Springer Sprint Preis at Munich last October but had taken time to revive his fortunes this term. He shaped with promise when he was beaten 1 1/2 lengths by Stormont (Ire) in the G2 Goldene Peitsche at Baden-Baden Sept. 3 before winning the Listed Dortmunder Fliegerpreis Oct. 5. Settled in mid-divison by Andreas Boschert off the fast early fractions set by Welsh Emperor and Dale Gibson, he lengthened to wear down that rival with 100 yards remaining before holding his game rally. "He got a good start and was always in a good position," Boschert explained. "He was in top form coming here and gave me a great feel, but we thought we had a place chance against such good horses. He loved the ground and everything went perfectly." Connections announced that Soave will return to this track for the Listed Prix Contessina Nov. 19.

**Kempinsky**, who defeated **Elvstroem** by a short head in the G2 AAMI Vase at Moonee Valley last Saturday, will have to overcome a wide draw to win this Classic. **HIGH CHAPARRAL HEADS TO COOLMORE**  
**High Chaparral (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells--Kasora {Ire}, by Darshaan {GB}), who capped his brilliant career with a deadheat victory in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf last weekend, will enter stud as expected at Coolmore next season for a fee of €35,000. Winner of the G1 Racing Post Trophy at two, the 270,000gns Tattersalls Houghton yearling won the G1 Vodafone Derby and the G1 Budweiser Irish Derby prior to posting a third-place finish in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe. The bay rebounded to take the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Arlington, a performance which earned him an Eclipse Award as champion turf horse. High Chaparral missed the first half of 2003 with a shoulder problem, but returned to win a vintage renewal of the GI Irish Champion S. prior to repeating his third at Longchamp in the Arc. He proved his class by persevering to share the victory in the Breeders' Cup Turf, becoming the first horse to win two renewals of that event and vaulting Sadler's Wells to the top of the sires of Breeders' Cup winners with six. High Chaparral enters the breeding shed with the enviable record of 13-10-1-2 and earnings of over \$5.3 million. **Full Coolmore roster, ATW p6**

**SANTA ANITA CUTS PURSES** Overnight purses for the remainder of the Oak Tree meeting at Santa Anita have been cut 10 percent and the GIII Las Palmas H., which had been scheduled for closing day, Nov. 9, was canceled, because handle at the meet has not met expectations. "Del Mar had a sensational meet and Pomona was up 10 percent and we thought we would be on the same trajectory," Santa Anita's Executive Vice President Sherwood Chillingsworth told *The Blood-Horse*. "But it didn't materialize as we thought it would. A number of factors conspired to hurt our handle. First, it was 95 degrees here every day. The Indian summer weather has been terrible the entire meeting. Then we had the bus strike, so people couldn't get here. We've had short fields and I'm not sure why that is, but that keeps people from betting. And then the fires started and three simulcast locations had to shut down...there are things happening now that are more important to people than horse racing."

**BOYS IN BLUE STRENGTHEN RANKS** Godolphin have announced a series of new acquisitions for the 2004 season, including **Doyen (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) and G1 Cheveley Park S. winner **Carry On Katie** (Fasliyev). Doyen, who chased home Dalakhani (Ire) when runner-up in the G2 Prix Niel at Longchamp Sept. 14 and again when fourth in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 5, will be transferred to the Dubai-based operation from the Andre Fabre stable, the *Racing Post* revealed yesterday. "Doyen is a late-maturing horse who has had a fantastic season with Andre Fabre," racing manager Simon Crisford told the *Post*. "He's got lots of potential and is one of the obvious stars joining Godolphin." Carry On Katie, who followed success in the G2 Lowther S. at York Aug. 21 with a hard-fought victory in Newmarket's fall showpiece for juvenile fillies, will strengthen the operation's filly division. Commenting on the former Jeremy Noseda-trained filly, Crisford said, "With Carry On Katie it depends on what trip she wants, and we've spoken with Jeremy who has given us some very good advice about what he believes is the filly's potential for next year. We've still got the Guineas very much in mind, and if her owner Mohammed Rashid decides to point her at the Guineas then that's what we'll do." **See ATW p6 for more.**

**MARWELL DIES** The brilliantly fast **Marwell (Ire)** (Habitat {Ire}--Lady Seymour {GB}, by \*Tudor Melody) was euthanized last week from the complications of old age. The 25-year-old mare had resided at owner Sir Edmund Loder's Eyrefield Lodge Stud. Marwell was named England's champion two-year-old filly after winning all five of her starts in 1980, including the G1 Cheveley Park S., the G1 Flying Childers S. and the G3 Molecomb S. She added the G3 Fred Darling S. in her first start at three before finishing fourth in the G1 1000 Guineas. But the bay rebounded to annex the G1 King's Stand S. and the G1 July Cup before concluding her career with a victory in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye de Longchamp. "I was lucky to ride so many top horses," her jockey Walter Swinburn told *Racing Post*, "but Marwell was up there with the very best." As a broodmare, Marwell produced Irish champion Caerwent (Ire) (Caerleon), winner of the G1 National S.; and Marling (Ire) (Lomond), England's highweight two-year-old filly of 1991. Marling went on to be the top filly miler at three with wins in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas, the G1 Coronation S. and the G1 Sussex S. in addition to her second in the G1 1000 Guineas. Marwell's final foal is Music Celebre (Ire) (Peintre Celebre), a three-year-old colt who has won each of his last three starts.

**NEW STALLIONS FOR COOLMORE** Coolmore announced the addition of **Catcher in the Rye (Ire)** (Danehill--Truly a Dream {Ire}, by Darshaan {GB}), **Spartacus (Ire)** (Danehill--Teslemi, by Ogygian) and **Statue of Liberty** (Storm Cat--Charming Lassie, by Seatle Slew) to its 2004 stallion roster yesterday. Catcher in the Rye suffered a career-ending injury while running second in this year's G1 French 2000 Guineas, while Spartacus won the G1 Phoenix S. and G1 Gran Criterium as a juvenile last season.
