SAVING THE BEST FOR LAST AT FASIG?

A total of 61 weanlings, 29 broodmares and 11 horses of racing age comprise tonight's Fasig-Tipton November Selected Sale, beginning at 7 p.m. Weanlings are available by such sires as Carson City, Distorted Humor, Elusive Quality, Gilded Time, Honour and Glory, Mr. Greeley, Mt. Livermore, Phone Trick and Smart Strike. Stallions represented by their first crop of foals include Albert the Great (Go for Gin), Aptitude (A.P.

Indy), Black Minnaloushe (Storm Cat), Brahms (Danzig), City Zip (Carson City), El Corredor (Mr. Greeley), Exchange Rate (Danzig) and Five Star Day (Carson City).

Broodmares on offer are in foal to such sires as GISWs and new sires Buddha (Storm Cat) and Came Home (Gone West), Cherokee Run, and Breeders' Cup winners Oriente

tate (Mt. Livermore) and War Chant. Sure to attract her fair share of attention is **Win Crafty Lady** (Crafty Prospector). Catalogued as [hip 78](#), the 13-year-old mare is the dam of GII Arkansas Derby hero Graeme Hall (Dehere), his stakes-winning full sister Win's Fair Lady and GI Ballerina H. victress Harmony Lodge (Hennessy). Consigned by Blackburn Farm, agent, she sells carrying a 3/4 sibling to Harmony Lodge by Giant's Causeway. Sophomore filly **Ruby's Reception** (Rubiano), winner this season of the GIII Fantasy S., sells as [hip 92](#), while [hip 101](#), **Freefourinternet** (Tabasco Cat) will be the last horse through the ring. The five-year-old, winner since the catalogue of the GII Kelso Breeders' Cup H. at Belmont Park, was last seen when a good sixth, beaten just over three lengths, in the Breeders' Cup Mile. Out of a full sister to MGSW Chimes Band, he is consigned by Meg Levy's Bluewater Sales LLC, agent. "Between the optimism created by the yearling sales which have taken place to date and the fact that there are bright spots in the economy, we are not just cautiously optimistic, but rather we have a strong sense of optimism as we head into the sale," commented Fasig-Tipton Director of Marketing Terence Collier. "We hope that rising tide will lift all boats." (F-T Outs, p4)

WINNER BAGO

They split across the width of the track attempting to block **Bago (Fr)** (Nashwan), but there was no stopping the Niarchos Family's imposing colt as he powered to an emphatic six-length success in yesterday's G1 Criterium International at Saint-Cloud. Held 10 lengths off a generous early tempo, he moved up on the final turn only to find the field spread out across the expanse of the straight. Undeterred by the manoeuvre, jockey Thierry Gillet tracked **Top Seed (Ire)** (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}) on the far side, then quickened to the lead with 1 1/2 furlongs remaining to settle matters instantly. "I went into the race very confident and was never worried," explained Gillet. "He was different class to the rest." Now undefeated, Bago had won two conditions races before adding the Sept. 20 G3 Prix des Chenes at Longchamp. "He is a horse from a tremendous family and he's won in great style," said racing manager Alan Cooper. "He travels easily and then quickens instantly. He is in all the top races next year and we'll probably start him off over a mile. We feel he'll stay further, but that can come later. Don't forget that Nashwan won the Guineas and Derby." Elvstroem, who was ruled out of Cox Plate contention by the Moonee Valley Race Club when he finished fifth in the G1 Caulfield Guineas, came back to run a short-head second to Kempinsky in the G2 AAMI Vase. But the colt turned the tables here to give jockey Damien Oliver his third Victoria Derby victory. Settled nine lengths off a solid early tempo, he was put to a drive as Kempinsky took control with 300 meters to race and swept past that rival late to win going away. "It was very important to get him to relax," Oliver said. "It was important to have the last crack at them--I wanted to be the last one out, instead of them having a go at me." Named after the four-time Olympic gold medal winner, Danish sailor Paul Elvstroem, the winner was knocked down for A\$330,000 when offered by Coolmore, as agent, at the 2002 Inglis Easter Sale, but was turned back because the buyer was unhappy with the X-ray results. He now races for the Arch of Gold Syndicate, which also campaigned his Group1-winning dam. Elvstroem, who does not actually turn three until Nov. 14, will likely be pointed for the G1 AJC Derby in the Southern Hemisphere autumn.

Looking to avoid a clash with fellow sophomores Elvstroem and Kempinsky, owner/breeder David Moodie skipped the Victoria Derby in favor of this event. His colorbearer went to the front at the barrier rise, set a moderate pace and held on with determination to best the fast-finishing Pentastic for his fourth straight victory. "I've never been so confident before a race as I was today," trainer Matt Ellerton said, adding that the winner would be pointed for the Australian Guineas and the Australian Cup. Fields Of Omagh, winner of the Oct. 25 G1 Cox Plate, could not match strides with the top two late, but is still on track for the G1 Japan Cup Nov. 30.

Pocus Hocus ran second behind the 9-5 favorite She's Got the Beat (Sultry Song) in a Saratoga allowance Aug. 21, then won an allowance at Belmont Sept. 19. Sent off as the 7-5 chalk in the Long Look S. at the Meadowlands last out Oct. 11, she set the pace and gamely stayed on for second. Overlooked by the public in this contest, the gray mare raced in second while under a strong hold by Jose Santos, took off when asked for run and was kept to task. "We've been able to run her with some regularity, which is what she needs," winning trainer Jimmy Jerkens said. "She'll most likely have the winter off. They wanted to get her a stakes win and now she's a graded stakes winner." She's Got the Beat was pulled up and vanned off. According to the Chief Examining Veterinarian Dr. Celeste Kunz, her injury could be career-threatening, but did not appear life threatening. X-rays will be taken to determine if there was a sesamoid fracture or a suspensory ligament tear in her left foreleg.

While those runners were based overseas, Silver Hawk had a number of top representatives on these shores, including multiple Grade I-winning millionaires Memories of Silver, Hawkster and Silver Ending, as well as additional Grade I winners Hawk Attack, Red Bishop, Wonder Again and Zoonagua. "We chose never to play the numbers game with the horse," Jones continued, "but from crops which averaged about 40 foals, he sired 14 Grade/Group 1 winners, and they did well all over the world. He's done so much for us and we're certainly going to make sure he enjoys his retirement here at Airdrie." In 2003, Silver Hawk has been represented by MGSW Mubtaker, runner-up in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe; and GSW Wonder Again.

Quick Tip Nearing Finale:

William S. Farish's **Quick Tip** (Unaccounted For), a one-length allowance winner at Churchill Downs Friday, could defend her title in the GIII Cardinal H. Nov. 22, a race which could mark the final career start for the five-year-old. Trainer Neil Howard indicated that he wanted to see how Quick Tip recovers from her effort before committing to the Cardinal, but said that a decision could hinge on the schedule of stablemate **Casual Look** (Red Ransom). The winner of the G1 Epsom Oaks in June, she could make her next start in the Cardinal or in the GIII Mrs. Revere S. versus fellow sophomore fillies Nov. 15.

Drift Done for the Year:

As expected, **Perfect Drift** (Dynaformer) has been removed from training for the balance of the year and will be sent to owner and breeder William Reed's farm near Kansas City, Missouri. Trainer Murray Johnson said that the four-year-old gelding suffered no long-lasting effects from his rough trip in the Breeders' Cup Classic, where he was carried out by Kentucky Derby winner Funny Cide on the first turn and finished sixth. Despite some initial misgivings about shipping out for the Classic, the conditioner thinks the right decision was made. "If you don't give it a try, you'll never do anything," Johnson commented. "I feel he was at his best and, from what [Classic rider] Gary [Stevens] said, he still ran a hell of a race to do as well as he did." Plans call for the bay to remain on the farm until mid-January before returning to Johnson's barn at Trackside Louisville. The early season goal is the GI Stephen Foster H. in June. "We'll probably run him once or twice before that," Johnson added. "It'll be a similar sort of campaign to this year's and then maybe we'll travel at the end of next year."
