LAISSEZ LES BON TEMPS ROULER

On the heels of a wildly successful yearling sales season, both at home and abroad, optimism runs rampant as the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale commences its 11-day run this morning in Lexington. So, let the good times roll. "We anticipate a strong sale," Keeneland Director of Sales Geoffrey Russell commented. "The quality of the catalogue is excellent." And that might just be the understatement of the century.

Among the 4,001 horses set to go under auctioneer Ryan Mahan's hammer are some top-shelf, Grade I-winning racemares from the past several years, including all-time leading female money winner **Spain** ([Thunder Gulch](#)) ([hip 157](#)), who sells in foal to [Storm Cat](#); multiple Canadian champion [Windsharp](#) (Lear Fan) ([hip 508](#)), the dam of Breeders' Cup Turf hero Johar (Gone West) and carrying a full sibling to the four-year-old; **Golden Apples (Ire)** (Pivotal {GB}) ([hip 309](#)), the champion turf mare in the U.S. in 2002, selling as a broodmare prospect; a top three-year-old filly of 2003, **Composure** (Touch Gold) ([hip 253](#)); and **Sharp Cat** (Storm Cat) ([hip 446](#)), who sells on a May 28 cover to Gone West. She will be followed into the ring by her weanling filly by first-year sire [Point Given](#) (Thunder Gulch). Her foal of 2002, a filly by [Fusaichi Pegasus](#) brought \$1.5 million at the September Sale. Bidding for each day of the sale commences at 10 a.m. (*Keeneland report cont. p2*)

Catalogue Gets a Bump...

The 4,001 head catalogued for the sale represents an increase of over 11 percent versus last year, when the weanling portion of the sale was adversely affected by Mare Reproductive Loss Syndrome, and is within three percent of the 2001 catalogue, which contained 4,116 horses. This year's books are comprised of 2,135 broodmares, 1,565 weanlings, 301 horses of other categories and one stallion prospect.

WELL-NOTED WIN

Taking advantage of a miscue by favored **Value Plus** (Unbridled's Song), whose dramatic stumble at the break unseated jockey John Velazquez, second choice **Read the Footnotes** (Smoke Glacken) notched a front-running victory in yesterday's GIII Nashua S. at Belmont Park. Sent to the front under jockey Jerry Bailey, Read the Footnotes set a measured pace with **Paddington** (Saint Ballado) glued to his flank, then outslugged that foe to the wire to win by 2 1/4 lengths. "That wasn't exactly what we had planned," said winning trainer Rick Violette, Jr. "Jerry and I talked before the race and thought that Paddington could be out there with Value Plus. If that happened, we wanted to track those two. Jerry is a good jockey to have on your side when you need to call an audible." Paddington was clearly second best, finishing 6 1/2 lengths ahead of the running-on **Who is Chris G.** (Numerous). Velazquez was uninjured in the fall. Value Plus recovered from the stumble and ran with the field up the backstretch, appearing uninjured. (*Nashua cont. p4*)

LADY TOPS AT FASIG-TIPTON NOVEMBER

GSW Win Crafty Lady (Crafty Prospector--Honeytab, by Al Hattab) brought a \$900,000 final bid to top Sunday's November Selected Sale hosted by Fasig-Tipton at the Newtown Paddocks in Lexington. The 15-year-old mare, who is the dam of MGSW Graeme Hall and GISW Harmony Lodge, was purchased by Classic Star Ltd from the Blackburn Farm consignment. "We were hoping for a little bit cheaper," said Classic Star's Nick Plumber. "We looked at the mare about a month ago down in Florida. They wanted \$1-million for her then and we actually turned them down. We thought she would go for \$800,000, but I had to pay for her. I thought she was the best mare in the sale." Owned and raced by Joe Greeley, who owns Sabine Stable, the chestnut is also the dam of stakes winner Win's Fair Lady (by Dehere), who is also owned by Greeley. The second highest price of the night at \$600,000 was handed out for MGSW **Santa Catalina** (Cure The Blues--Swept Off Her Feet, by Foreten). Consigned by Angus Glen Farm, agent, the dam of GISW Golden Missile was purchased by the partnership of Gainesway and Gorden Stollery. (*F/T report cont. p6*)

Thoroughbred Corp. Team Rich in Talent, Pedigree...

At the time of his death at just 43 in July 2002, Prince Ahmed Salman had accomplished more in the game than many do in a lifetime. He had just celebrated his first Kentucky Derby win with War Emblem, an Epsom Derby winner and a trio of Breeders' Cup champions. The Prince consistently pointed to one horse which put him on the map, a filly by Storm Cat out of In Neon (Ack Ack) he purchased for \$900,000 at the 1996 Barretts March Sale. **Sharp Cat** was a near instant dynamo at the races and retained that brilliance over her three years at the track, winning 14 of her 21 starts, including seven Grade 1s, for earnings of nearly \$2 million. She sells Tuesday at Keeneland followed by her weanling daughter by Point Given (hip 447). Sharp Cat's first foal, the three-year-old filly A.S. Cat ([A.P. Indy](#)), is offered this afternoon in foal to Point Given as hip 206. **Spain**, the winner of the Breeders' Cup Distaff in 2000 and runner-up in 2001, sells in foal to Storm Cat, and she will be followed in the ring by her foal of this year, a son of Storm Cat ([hip 157](#)). Spain's dam **Drina** (Regal and Royal) is catalogued as [hip 588](#) during tomorrow's session. Also the dam of GSW **Puerto Banus** (Supremo), Drina sells carrying a full sibling to Spain. Salman campaigned **Windsharp** (Lear Fan) in partnership and she has already proven herself as a broodmare. A millionaire at the races, the 12-year-old mare has produced Johar (Gone West), dead-heat winner of the Breeders' Cup Turf as well as GI Del Mar Oaks heroine Dessert (Storm Cat). The dark bay mare is pregnant on a Feb. 27 cover to Gone West. While would-be Triple Crown winner Point Given is tucked neatly away in the stallion barn at nearby Three Chimneys Farm, buyers will have ample opportunity to get to his family. The first chance comes this afternoon when **Point Gained**, a four-year-old [Hennessy](#) half sister to Point Given, sells in foal to the late Anees ([Unbridled](#)) as [hip 110](#). She should serve to whet the appetite for Tuesday, when **Turko's Turn** (Turkoman), the dam of the 2001 Horse of the Year, goes through the ring as [hip 485](#). She is carrying a full sibling to Point Given and will be followed by her foal of this year, a colt by Thunder Gulch ([hip 486](#)).

The Good Gets Even Better...

Saudi Poetry (Gone West), a \$1.7-million yearling purchase who won the GII Louisville Breeders' Cup H. for Salman, sells this afternoon as [hip 142](#) in foal to Silver Deputy. **Habibti** (Tabasco Cat) should spice up the late going on Tuesday. A two-time Grade I winner at two, the four-year-old filly is in foal on an Apr. 8 cover date to Point Given and sells as [hip 639](#). Her dam, Miss Sobriety, not part of this consignment, has been withdrawn from the sale. Overall, most of the Prince's breeding stock will be sold, including 42 broodmares and 16 weanlings. They are spread among the consignments of Mill Ridge Sales, Three Chimneys, Taylor Made, Lane's End and Hopewell Farm.

The Running of the Bulls...

If this sale progresses in the bullish way sales officials expect it will, buyers might just confuse Lexington with Pamplona. "Our September Sale was the second-strongest on record and yearling sales around the world have been strong as well," Geoffrey Russell said. There are other tangibles in place, according to the director of sales. "Keeneland's fall race meet set attendance and mutual handle records, the Breeders' Cup had record mutual handle and recent economic indicators point toward improvement," Russell explained. "One of these factors would be a boost. Add all of them together and we're very encouraged." Just last week it was announced that the gross domestic product for the third quarter had advanced by a stronger-than-expected 7.2 percent. Last year's sale saw 2,377 horses sold for gross receipts of \$187,230,000. The average was \$78,767 with a median price of \$28,000. Bless, a full sister to Fusaichi Pegasus in foal to Storm Cat, topped the sale at \$4 million.

Norfields Dispersal...

Taylor Made Sales Agency is handling a reduction of bloodstock of Joanne Nor's Norfields, which sell as hips 59-75 following Monday's opening session. The draft was originally scheduled to go through the ring Sunday night following the William Schettine dispersal, but was pushed back after Schettine decided against selling his horses. Chief among the 10 horses remaining in the catalogue for Nor following scratches are [hip 63](#), a weanling colt by Silver Charm out of Quiet Honestly (Believe It), a half sister to the dam of Behrens; and [hip 71](#), a weanling filly by Lemon Drop Kid out of Desert Stormette (Storm Cat), a full sister to Breeders' Cup Sprint winner Desert Stormer. She is the dam of GIII Gardenia H. runner-up Desert Gold (Seeking the Gold).

G1 Caulfield Cup hero **Mummify** could do no better than eighth in Saturday's G1 Mackinnon S., and stewards held an inquiry into the effort. Jockey Dan Nikolic said the horse had nothing left for the finish, but he is still rated as co-favourite with **Mamool** for the Melbourne Cup. Godolphin has placed in three of the last four Cups, and trainer Saeed bin Suroor believes Mamool is the stable's best chance to win the event. The four-year-old comes off back-to-back wins in the Sept. 7 G1 Grosse Bugatti Preis and the Sept. 28 G1 Preis Von Europa. Trainer Bart Cummings, who is going after his 12th victory in this race, schooled his 2003 entrant **Frightening** in the Flemington paddock Saturday. The four-year-old goes after his third straight after wins in a Group 3 stakes at Caulfield Oct. 18 and in a Group 2 event at Moonee Valley Oct. 25.

 Trainer Nick Zito, whose stable of two-year-olds includes such talented and proven performers as Eurosilver and Birdstone, saw another of his youngsters step forward as The Cliff's Edge put away an over-matched field to earn his first stakes success. Debuting a gate-to-wire winner at Saratoga Aug. 24, The Cliff's Edge ran third in the Sept. 13 GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile S. at Turfway Park before being promoted to second when Pomeroy was disqualified. Facing stablemate Eurosilver in his next, the Oct. 4 GII Lane's End Breeders' Futurity S. at Keeneland, the dark bay found himself last of 11 after a rough start, but rallied to finish a respectable sixth. Here, the crowd's pick was content to sit off the leaders, who set snappy fractions up the backstretch. Ranging into contention entering the turn, The Cliff's Edge confidently took command as they straightened for home and never looked back, pouring it on in deep stretch for the victory. "He's just a talented colt and definitely in the two-year-old picture," said Zito. "Hopefully, next year he'll get in the three-year-old picture. We thought he was one of our better two-year-olds. I really thought that he should have been second in the Lane's End Breeders' Futurity. He's a big horse and a horse with a future. If everything looks O.K., the [GII] Kentucky Jockey Club [at Churchill Downs, Nov. 29] looks like a good spot for him."

"Hold That Tiger and Van Nistelrooy are both superb-looking individuals with excellent American pedigrees and both displayed a very high level of ability as juveniles. They're two very exciting prospects." As a juvenile Hold That Tiger scored in The Curragh's G3 Railway S. and the G1 Grand Criterium at Longchamp before ending the year with a third-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Arlington Park. Following a trio of unplaced efforts in Europe this year, the Aidan O'Brien-trained colt finished second behind probable Horse of the Year Mineshaft in the GI Woodward H. Sept. 6 before coming home fifth in his most recent outing in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic at Santa Anita Oct. 25. He retires to stud with three wins from 10 starts and earnings of \$646,421. Van Nistelrooy, also conditioned by O'Brien, won three of six lifetime starts, including last year's G2 Futurity S. and placed, beaten only 3/4 of a length by dual Group 1 winner Refuse to Bend, in the G1 National S.

RACING MOURNS DEATH OF RIDER

Irish racing was mourning yesterday the second death of one of its jockeys in the last three months as apprentice jockey Sean Cleary failed to recover from severe head injuries sustained in a fall at Galway last Sunday. Cleary, who had ridden 14 winners while under the care of Jim Bolger and Pat Flynn, had been sent to the Beaumont Hospital in Dublin after the fall in opener on the card, caused by clipping heels with the horse in front. His condition deteriorated on Friday night before passing away the following evening, becoming the second casualty of his profession after the death of jumps jockey Kieran Kelly on Aug. 12. In a statement issued on Saturday night Walter Halley, the Irish Turf Club's medical officer, said, "It is with deep regret that I announce the death of Sean Cleary following severe head injuries sustained at Galway on Sunday last, October 26. His tragic death is deeply mourned by the Cleary family, the Turf Club and everyone in Irish racing." Trainer Flynn paid tribute to the 22-year-old, who had enjoyed his finest hour in the sport when partnering on Bubble N Squeak (Ire) to win the November H. at Leopardstown 12 months ago. "It's a terrible situation that Sean was cruelly mowed down in the prime of his life," he told *PA Sport* yesterday. "He was very dedicated, was enjoying his best season and had a real future as a strong lightweight. He was a credit to his family." Racing at Clonmel and Leopardstown, which was to feature the November H., was abandoned yesterday as a mark of respect.
