STAND BY YOUR MAN

Trainer David Smaga, who stood by Dominique Boeuf when the jockey was going through hard times in the mid '90s, was rewarded for his loyalty yesterday when Boeuf piloted 5-1 shot **Voix du Nord (Fr)** (Valanour {Ire}) to a 1 1/2-length win over 7-4 choice **Simplex (Fr)** (Rainbow Quest) in the G1 Criterium de Saint-Cloud. "I'm finding it hard to speak," Boeuf told *PA Sport* after the victory. "This is my first Group 1 for David." Boeuf became involved with drugs more than a decade ago and was arrested for his role in a drug ring in 1994. He was later convicted and sentenced to three years in prison, a sentence that was eventually suspended. But by 1998 he was back on top of jockey standings, and he led all French riders again in 2001 and 2002. Looking for only his second Group 1 win of 2003 yesterday, he rated Voix du Nord in mid-division early. Simplex took over inside the final eighth, but Voix du Nord proved strongest in the closing yards. For owner and breeder Baron Thierry Zuylen de Nyevelt, it was his first domestic Group 1 win since Ramsin (Fr) took the Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud in 1971. "It is great to end the season on this note," Smaga said. "I have known for a long time that the further he goes the better he will get. Third as the 9-5 favorite in a Keeneland allowance test Oct. 24, **Lead Story** (Editor's Note) was let go at 35-1 in the GII Churchill Downs Distaff H. yesterday, but belied her odds to post a rallying half-length score over **Awesome Humor** (Distorted Humor). The chestnut filly picked up her first stakes win in the HPBA H. at Ellis Park in July, but did not fare as well in graded company, running fourth in the Aug. 9 GIII Gardenia H. and fifth behind Take Charge Lady in the Sept. 1 GIII Arlington Matron H. She switched to the turf for the Sept. 20 Flawlessly S. at Arlington, but could do no better than ninth and was back on the dirt at Keeneland last time out. Ignored at the windows yesterday, Lead Story trailed the field for a half, but finished fastest of all on the outside to score the upset. Based at Philly Park, Caught in the Rain shipped into New York and closed from well off the pace to beat the hometown horses. The dark bay filly showed she could handle graded-stakes company a year ago, taking the GII Mrs. Revere S. at Churchill Downs at 32-1, but had finished off the board in five of her seven starts since. She romped to a 10 1/4-length victory in the off-the-turf Mrs. Penny S. in Philly Aug. 30, but was coming off a fifth-place finish in the Oct. 17 GIII Violet H. at the Meadowlands. The second-longest shot on the board here, the Pennsylvania-bred had just one horse beaten through six furlongs in 1:16.45, but came five-wide around the far turn and motored down the lane to catch Lojo and Coney Kitty at the wire. "That was close!" winning jockey Richie Migliore said. "I thought I had [Coney Kitty], but I wasn't sure about the horse along the fence [Lojo]. No Comprende took an allowance over this course June 7, then finished fourth in three consecutive graded contests, including the GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. Aug. 16 and the GII Hawthorne Gold Cup H. Sept. 28. Most recently second in a Woodbine allowance Oct. 19, the dark bay was sent off as third-choice in this graded affair. He raced in sixth early, advanced on the far turn, took the lead in upper stretch despite the fact that jockey Pat Husbands lost his whip and edged clear to notch his first graded-stakes victory. "He ran a very good race," Husbands said. "It was a pleasure to be back on him. Today he showed me he wanted to be the man. I dropped my stick, but I got lucky." Mobil, last seen winning the GIII Ontario Derby over this strip Oct. 13, gamely stayed on for second after stalking the early pace. A SALUTE TO OFFICER Widady (Gone West), carrying a foal from the first crop by Officer (Bertrando), was hammered down for \$340,000 to top yesterday's session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington. From the consignment of Mill Ridge Sales, agent, the six-year-old mare was bought by Hopewell Investments. Widady was purchased by The Thoroughbred Corporation for \$1.45 million from the 1998 Keeneland September Sale, where she was also consigned by Mill Ridge. She went on to win one of her five career starts before heading to the breeding shed. The bay's second dam is the blue-hen mare Too Bald, dam of millionaire Exceller, champion Capote, graded winner Vaguely Hidden and stakes winners American Standard and Baldski. She is also a half-sister to GSW Minister's Melody (Deputy Minister). "She's a beautiful mare," said Rick Trontz of Hopewell Farm. "Her yearling [a colt by Hopewell stallion Royal Anthem] sold for \$210,000. I know [The Thoroughbred Corporation] have him in training and I heard that they really like him. I bought her weanling by Royal Anthem [for \$32,000] as well. She's a great addition to the broodmare band. This is one of the top broodmares we have. It's very exciting." Trontz added that Hopewell is likely to resell the foal, either as a yearling or as a two-year-old. As for Hopewell's results as a seller, he said, "Everything we've had in has sold well. It's very tough to buy. The sale is very strong."

Claim of the Year...

Stakes winner **Theresa's Year** (Half a Year) was claimed for \$25,000 after finishing fourth in her final career start at Santa Anita Mar. 15. Shipped east right after that race, she was bred to Three Chimneys' stallion War Chant (Danzig) Mar. 30 and realized a significant profit for her connections at Keeneland yesterday. Consigned by James B. Keogh/Grovendale, agent, the four-year-old filly brought a final bid of \$215,000 from Randy Gammill of Diamond G Ranch in Edmond, Oklahoma. Said Keogh, "She's a lovely mare and we're delighted to see her sell so well. It's a real California speed pedigree and I thought it was a great mating. I thought she was the best mare in the sale today." The California-bred is a half sister to Theresa's Tizzy (Cee's Tizzy), winner of the GIII Rancho Bernardo H.; and MSWs Lesters Boy (Cee's Tizzy) and Excessive Theresa (In Excess {Ire}). "I liked everything about her," Gammill said. "She's beautiful." He added, "The number of my broodmare band has been growing since I've been here. This is the fourth one I've bought." Gammill boards his mares at Russell Springs Farm near Lexington.

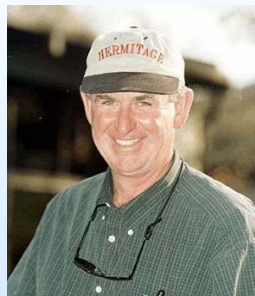
