VICTORY GALLOP COLT TOPS KEENELAND

A weanling colt by champion Victory Gallop topped yesterday's session of the Keeneland November Breeding Stock Sale in Lexington, Kentucky. Consigned by Taylor Made Sales Agency, the bay attracted a final bid of \$200,000 from Rick Borth. He is out of the Slew o' Gold mare Sugar is Gold and is a half brother to stakes winner Shot of Gold (Jolie's Halo). From his first crop to race, 1998 Belmont S. winner Victory Gallop has been represented this year by stakes winner Galloping Gal and Grade I placed Notorious Rouge, as well as Victory U.S.A., second in the GI Frizette and third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies and the GI Del Mar Debutante. Two mares shared the top price of \$135,000. **Song 'n Silk** (Unbridled's Song), an unraced

three-year-old selling as a broodmare prospect, was purchased by Amanda Pope's Whisper Hill Farm from the consignment of Margaux Farm. **Your Sweetness** (Deputy Minister), in foal to Anees, also brought \$135,000. She was purchased by Denali Stud, agent, from the consignment of Taylor Made Sales Agency. Through seven sessions, Keeneland has sold 1,661 horses for \$222,629,500. The cumulative average, \$134,033, is up 24.5 percent from a year ago, while the median of \$55,000 is up 31 percent from 2002.

UPWARDLY MOBILE AT KEENELAND

By all accounts, it has been a banner year inside the Keeneland sales pavilion. While its April sale of two-year-olds in training failed to advance on the results of 2002, the auction house "overcame" the cancellation of its boutique July sale by achieving new heights in an expanded September catalogue. Gross sales of over \$274 million represented the second highest in the

history of the sale, were 30 percent better than the 2002 September sale and 8.2 percent ahead of the combined 2002 July and September sales. The average of \$92,329 was the best in the history of the sale. The momentum has continued right into the November sale, which, prior to the midway point of Friday's activity, had already surpassed the

gross receipts of last year's event. Were the sale to match the results of last year from here on, this year's gross would reach about \$225 million, which would be a 20-percent bump up from 2002. While the impact of the 58-strong consignment from The Thoroughbred Corporation at the sale cannot be underestimated, trade this week in Lexington has been brisk and the sales grounds and pavilion have teemed with activity throughout. With this in mind, the *TDN* sat down for a brief "Q and A" with Keeneland President and Chief Executive Officer Nick Nicholson.

TDN: What are your thoughts so far about the sale?

Nick Nicholson: Well, I'm going to go out on a limb and predict that the second half of the sale might not gross what the first half did. *(laughs)* It's been a wonderful sale. It is a wonderful sale. As we're talking, we're approaching the halfway mark and there's still a lot of excitement, a lot of buzz. I've seen a lot of new faces come in this morning and [Friday] night. It's good to see people that have not been here yet that are just starting. We're hopeful that the momentum carries through.

TDN: It seems like there is good activity at all levels. Obviously the first two days with the quality of the catalogue and the numbers that were achieved. Even the middle market and the median figures are well ahead of last year. What does that say to you about the mindset of the shopper?

NN: I think it's a tribute to the catalogue and to the consignors that brought the horses here. It's also, I think, a good statement about the state of the industry. The industry is on an uptick, racing is on an uptick, we've had a very good year [as an industry]. There is some true value in these horses and I think the market is saying that. It's expressing optimism about what they think the market is going to be next year and we're excited about that. The other good news here is that it's not a blind, across-the-board increase. Horses that should be selling for a lot are and mares that have a lot of shots and haven't had anything are not as enthusiastically sought after. That's logical. I feel good about the intelligence of the market, so it's a sensible increase.

TDN: Do you think there are carry-over effects from the September sale to this? What other forces are out there that might be spurring optimism?

NN: I think the answer to that is 'yes.' September also was an intelligent market. It was a good solid increase, but if you analyze it, it was also sensible. Days four through nine of the September sale were the best day four through day nine in the history of the September sale. That was a strong statement as to how the middle of the market was and its depth. We haven't seen that in a while, so that was good. There is undoubtedly some connection between that and I think people expect it to carry to next year and so you're seeing that. You're seeing a connection to last year's September sale and next year's September sale.

TDN: Has there been any further discussion about the fate of the July sale?

NN: No. We wanted to get through this [sales] cycle and see and I'm glad we did. I know it's been an emotional roller coaster for me as well as the other people that work here. None of us felt good that week in July. We were all just sort of moping around here. We would much rather be selling horses. We'll do what Keeneland always does. We'll do what's best for the industry, we'll do what the marketplace wants us to do. We're a tool of the industry and we'll listen to what the people who buy and sell yearlings want us to do and that's what we'll do.

TDN: Statistics are nice, but what is the most important development to come out of this sale?

NN: One of the most positive aspects of this sale is that a lot of these people have had a very rough two years. MRLS, the economy...it seemed like for a long time, the breaks just weren't going their way. Among the best things to come out of this is that people that have had a rough two years, some in September and then again in November, are having a good September/November market. We're happiest for them.
