A SHAKE DOWN

Shake You Down (Montbrook), a game third in the Breeders' Cup Sprint, heads a field of 10 sprinters in today's GI Frank DeFrancis Memorial Dash at Laurel Park. In the Sprint, Shake You Down broke slowly, rushed up to press a torrid pace and held on for third.

The chestnut gelding, claimed for \$65,000 in March, has already won this year's GIII Bold Ruler H., GII True North Breeders' Cup H. and GIII Smile Sprint H. "My horse is ready to run," trainer Scott Lake said of Shake You Down. "He came out of the race absolutely perfect." Shake You Down is winless in eight starts at Laurel, but Lake isn't concerned. "He's run over the track and going in not handling the surface is not a big worry.

[Jockey Mike] Luzzi obviously knows Laurel, so it gives us an edge," the trainer said.

Aggadan (Carnivalay), seeking his first graded stakes score, has been off since running second behind the impressive Ghostzapper in the Sept. 27 GI Vosburgh H. Edgar Prado has the mount for trainer Richard Dutrow. The lightly raced **A Huevo** (Cool Joe) opened his career in 1999 with four first-place finishes. After being disqualified from a 7 3/4-length triumph in the West Virginia Classic, the seven-year-old was away from the races for nearly four years. He returned to run a dull seventh in a Mountaineer stakes in August, but he returned to the winner's circle with a strong performance in a Sept. 21 allowance at Delaware Park. "He's an extremely talented horse," jockey Ramon Dominguez said of the Michael Dickinson trainee. "Last time out I didn't think he was at his best and he still ran an amazing race. There looks to be a lot of speed in the race which will benefit him. He is a big versatile horse who likes to come from behind. I really like this horse."

TOUCH OF THE BLUES RETIRED

Touch of the Blues (Fr) (Cadeaux Geneveux {GB}--Silabteni, by Nureyev), coming off a runner-up finish to Six Perfections (Fr) in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, has been retired from racing and will begin his stud career next season in Ireland. "He leaves Monday for the Irish National Stud," confirmed trainer Neil Drysdale. A group winner in France, the six-year-old captured this year's GI Atto Mile S. before ending his career with seconds in the GI Shadwell Keeneland Turf Mile S. and in the Breeders' Cup. On the board in 19 of 35 starts, Touch of the Blues won eight races and earned \$1,654,932.

KRONE IN A NEW YORK STATE OF MIND

It's been five years since she last rode a race in New York, but that all changes when Julie Krone gets a leg up aboard **Banyu Dewi** (Ger) (Poliglote {GB}) in today's GII Long Island H. at Aqueduct. "We think we've got a good shot to win this race and we wanted the best rider we could find," said Barry Irwin, whose Team Valor owns the four-year-old filly. "We envisioned Julie because she's not big and neither is the horse. She's a great horsewoman and we have tremendous confidence in her getting the filly to relax." A winner over a yielding Saratoga turf in August, Banyu Dewi was most recently a nose runner-up when entered above her conditions over the Belmont turf Oct. 1. **Ittab** (GB) (Green Desert) defeated a group of males in a July 26 handicap event at Ascot and returned to that track to annex the G3 Princess Royal S. over this trip Oct. 11. Regular rider Richard Hills flies in for the mount.

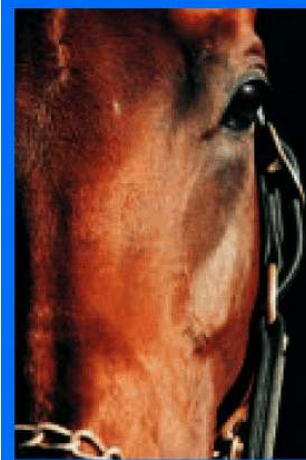

Film Maker, never off the board in nine career starts, nosed out Maiden Tower to win the Oct. 11 GI Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup at Keeneland in her last start. The dark bay filly also won the GII Lake George at this distance at Saratoga in July. "We hadn't necessarily planned on running her in this race," admitted trainer Graham Motion. "We toyed with the idea of stopping on her, but she was doing so well that we decided to point for this race to end the year, and then give her some time off over the winter and start her up in the spring. She's just a very uncomplicated filly, she's such a pleasure to train. She just does everything so professionally in every way, and when it comes to race day she's just very tough." A perfect three-for-three at this distance, **Dyna Da Wyna** won a \$100,000 claimer at Saratoga in August before victories in the DeBartolo Oaks at Louisiana Downs Sept. 20 and in Keeneland's GIII Valley View S. Oct. 18. G1 Epsom Oaks winner **Casual Look** was third in the G1 Irish Oaks and ended her European campaign with an eighth-place effort in the G1 Prix Vermeille at Longchamp Sept. 14. That race was her fourth straight at 1 1/2 miles and she cut back to nine furlongs for her U.S. bow, a late-charging third-place effort in the Queen Elizabeth II Challenge Cup. Shortening up again here, the bay filly drilled a bullet four furlongs in :48 3/5 over the Churchill turf Nov. 11.

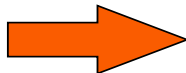

TRACK CANCELLATIONS CONTINUE Continuing high winds once again forced the cancellation of live racing at several eastern tracks. Aqueduct, Philadelphia Park and Finger Lakes were among the tracks affected Friday, but all are expected to resume racing Saturday. Also in the dark, Turf Paradise lost its Friday program due to unsafe track conditions arising from inclement weather. Live racing will return to the Arizona track Saturday.

VOTING CHANGES FOR ECLIPSE AWARDS The National Thoroughbred Racing Association, *Daily Racing Form* and the National Turf Writers Association have announced new voting procedures for the Eclipse Awards, effective this year. Under the new system, individual voters will rank their top three selections in each of the 16 voting categories. The rankings will be scored on a 10-5-1 basis for first, second and third place, respectively. Points will be used to determine the top three finalists in each category. Winners in each category will be determined by the number of first-place votes cast for an individual horse or person. The three organizations have also agreed to eliminate the previous electoral college-style voting in favor of the popular vote method. "The Eclipse Awards steering committee reviewed a number of different voting methods and modeled previous years' voting using both bloc and popular vote systems before deciding to make procedural changes," said Keith Chamblin, NTRA senior vice president of marketing and industry relations. "We believe the new system will be a more reliable method for determining finalists and will be easier for fans to follow." Ballots for the 2003 awards will be mailed to voters on Nov. 26. All votes must be received by Dec. 29 at 5 p.m. (ET). Eclipse Award winners will be announced Jan. 26 at the Westin Diplomat Resort and Spa in Hollywood, Florida.

Churchill Withdraws Signals from Southern Racing Co-Op:

Churchill Downs Simulcast Network (CDSN) has ceased sending its signal to the Southern Racing Cooperative (SRC) tracks because of an ongoing conflict over simulcast rates involving Hollywood Park. According to a statement released on behalf of the SRC, "[We] believe CDSN is attempting to force member tracks of the SRC to accept a revision to the current multi-year agreement by not allowing SRC member tracks to wager on any of the CDSN signals. SRC member tracks have always been willing to operate under the provisions of the current agreement, which extends through 2004, but cannot accept a unilaterally forced change to the rates defined in that agreement." Included among members of the SRC are Oaklawn Park, Lone Star Park, Delta Downs, Sam Houston Race Park, Fair Grounds, Beulah Park, Retama Park and Manor Downs. According to CDSN officials, negotiations with the cooperative are ongoing. The CDSN member tracks currently running, in addition to Hollywood, are Churchill Downs, Calder Race Course in Miami and Hoosier Park in Indiana.
