A FAIRY TALE ENDING

All the king's horses and all the king's men couldn't put Humpty Dumpty together again, but the tale might have ended differently if trainer Michael Dickinson had been on the scene. Dickinson, a master at putting horses back together, was at it again yesterday, saddling **A Huevo** (Cool Joe) to a 1 3/4-length triumph in the GI Frank J. DeFrancis Memorial Dash. For the seven-year-old gelding, it was just his third outing in 46 months. "This might just be Michael Dickinson's greatest achievement," said owner Mark Hopkins. "It is mind-boggling what we went through with this horse." Purchased after winning a Delaware allowance in August of 1999, A Huevo set a track record in the West Virginia Breeders' Classic that October, but was disqualified after testing positive for clenbuterol. He also came out of the race with knee chips and an injured suspensory. "We gave him two years off and brought him back and he was lame," Dickinson said. "We gave him another year off and he was still lame. This year, after his first breeze, he went lame." Hopkins wanted to find the horse a retirement home, but Dickinson persevered. "We stood him in the stall for three days and walked him for three days and he came right back," he said. "Since then, he's never looked back." ISLAND PARADISE

Spice Island (Tabasco Cat), who proved she could manage a mile and a half in the Oct. 19 Dowager S. at Keeneland, showed she could handle graded-stakes foes at the distance yesterday. Let go at 7-1, the dark bay rallied past 2-1 chalk **Volga (Ire)** (Caerleon) to capture the GI Long Island H. at Aqueduct by 1 1/4 lengths. It was the third straight win for the four-year-old, who has been first or second in seven of eight turf tries. "She's had a good year, but she has really picked up her game this fall," trainer John Pregman Jr. said. "It's a shame the turf season is coming to an end up here." Spice Island sat just off the pace as first **Banyu Dewi (Ger)** (Poliglote {GB}) and then Volga took them along. She went after the favorite in the final furlong, striding to the front in deep stretch and edging clear. Elegant Fashion stamped herself as one of the top local hopes for the G1 Hong Kong Cup in three weeks' time with a professional victory. The winner of last year's Hong Kong Derby in March, the five-year-old was second to Eishin Preston in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Cup the following month prior to ending the season with a runner-up finish in the Hong Kong Champions and Chater Cup June 1. Rested after that effort, she returned to be third in the National Day H. Oct. 1. The chestnut was most recently second in the Sha Tin Trophy Oct. 19. Settled about four lengths off the early pace, Elegant Fashion was eased out three wide into the stretch, took command with a furlong to run and edged clear. "I'm very happy; there was still a lot left in the tank at the end," said winning trainer David Hayes. "She has been trained to peak on her fourth run of the season and that's what's coming up next."

Hoh Buzzard won just one of her first six trips to the races, but began to put it together late this summer, capping a three-race winning streak with a half-length victory in the Listed EBF Upavon S. at Salisbury Aug. 13. An excellent second when trying 10 furlongs for the first time in the Aug. 24 G3 Prix de la Nonette at Deauville, the dark bay was made the 7-5 favorite in the GIII Pucker Up S. at Arlington, but could do no better than fourth behind Aud. Prominent throughout beneath visiting rider Ryan Fogelsonger this time, the Irish-bred sophomore poked her head in front after five-sixteenths, opened daylight at the eighth pole and held off a determined bid from Aud for the win. "Once she gets in front, she's very hard to get by," winning trainer Ben Cecil said. "She's a real fighter." Fogelsonger, riding at Churchill for the first time, added, "She just dug in harder every time they came to her." Looking like he might be worth every penny of his \$1.4 million price tag, Lion Heart drifted into the five path as they raced into the stretch, but still drew off to an eye-catching victory in his first stakes attempt. "I think this horse spoke for himself out there," winning jockey Mike Smith said. "What I like about him just as much as his ability is his attitude. Man, he acts like he's five years old. He went out there like he owned the place. This is really an impressive colt." The chestnut made his debut at Santa Anita on Breeders' Cup Eve and, after dueling through a half in :44 flat, went on to break his maiden by a length. Odds-on in his second try, he set a solid pace while hounded by Voladero before drawing off to win as much the best while setting a new stakes standard. "He's just naturally quick, so he puts you where he wants to be," Smith said. "Then he waits for your call. I never got to all his gears." Added trainer Patrick Biancone, "Today was a big step for this horse. I was a little concerned because he was wide coming out of the turn, but Mike said he did that on purpose because the track was better. It was a jockey choice, nothing to do with the horse. He did exactly what Mike wanted." The final time of the race clipped .17 off the mark set by Afternoon Deelites in 1994. Lion Heart will go next in the Dec. 20 GI Hollywood Futurity. Tapit remained undefeated with another dominant score in his stakes debut. The gray colt kicked off his career with a 7 3/4-length maiden tally going a mile at Delaware Park Oct. 19. The even-money chalk stepping up to the graded ranks in his second appearance, he reared at the start and was bumped around as they raced into the first turn, then pulled his way up to fourth as 26-1 Acclimate (Forestry) led through moderate fractions. Ghost Mountain, looking for his third straight in his first stakes try, took over as they neared the eighth pole, but Tapit fought his way through traffic to grab the advantage in deep stretch before powering away to a decisive victory. "Going into the first turn I got bumped sideways," jockey Ramon Dominguez said. "He was very rank from then on. I was concerned all the way around the course. That usually takes too much out of them. I was fighting him and wouldn't have been surprised if he had flattened out. I was impressed with his acceleration once I got through. He had every excuse to get beat...there's no telling how good this horse is, honestly." Winning trainer Michael Dickinson said, "He was the last horse purchased by Verne Winchell before he passed away last year. I'd like to dedicate this win to him." He added, "[Winchell's son, Ron] and racing manager David Fisk have indicated this will be his last start of the year. He will winter in Florida. I think he's just as good a horse as [West Virginia Derby winner and Super Derby runner-up] Soto." [Click for the brisnet.com chart.](#)

The dark bay was stretched to two turns for her latest and suffered her first defeat, holding well for second after setting a pressured pace in the Oct. 25 Cordially S. at Delaware. Trying graded-stakes competition for the first time with a bullet work in tow, she was the second longest price on the tote. Sent immediately to the front beneath new rider Mario Pino, riding for his brother Michael, Smooth Maneuvers was allowed to set pedestrian fractions, began to shake clear after six furlongs in 1:14 3/5 and had plenty in reserve to register the upset. "It was a beautiful trip," the winning jockey commented. "I got away with soft fractions. My brother said, 'Even though this looks like a tough race, she has a shot here.' He did a good job."

A pair of French-based fillies, **Ana Marie** and **Tigertail**, have flown across the globe to take on some of the best distaffers in Japan. Ana Marie, who kicked off 2003 by defeating males in the G2 Prix d'Harcourt, ran second to Russian Rhythm in the G1 Nassau S. and most recently was fifth, beaten two lengths, in the G1 Prix de l'Opera Oct. 5. Heroine of last year's G3 Prix Minerve, Tigertail hasn't visited the winner's circle this year, but was the runner-up by a neck to subsequent G1 Champion S. hero Rakti (Ire) in the G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica in May and is coming off a head loss to Volga (Ire) in the GI E.P. Taylor S. Oct. 19. Spearheading the home defense is **Still in Love**, who wrapped up Japan's Filly Triple Crown with a win in the G1 Shuka Sho Oct. 19, where she beat **Admire Groove**.

Mill Borromeo's **Sunstrach** bids to follow in the hoof-prints of Elle Danzig (Ger), who won back-to-back renewals of this contest in 1999 and 2000. Last year's winner has the assistance of Frankie Dettori in the saddle once more and his chances will be improved if more rain gets into the current good going. He posted a disappointing effort when last of 14 in the G2 Prix Dollar Oct. 4, his most recent start, but is better judged on his third place in the G3 Prix Gontaut Biron Aug. 16. He also has form over course and distance this year, finishing fourth in the May 11 G1 Premio Presidente della Repubblica. **Altieri** won the G2 Premio Ribot on last year's undercard and finished ahead of Sunstrach when third to Rakti (GB) in the Premio Presidente della Repubblica. The pair may have most to fear from the still improving **Maktub**. He was successful in the G3 Premio Federico Tesio at Milan Oct. 4 and returned to the same track to post his best performance of the season when second to Ekraar in the G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club Oct. 19. **Imperial Dancer** is one of the most consistent horses in training. The British raider makes his 15th start of this campaign. He was fourth to Rakti in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 18 and followed that effort with a victory in the G3 St Simon S. at Newbury Oct. 25. G3 Prix Corrida winner **Trumbaka**, another Gallic raider, holds solid place claims based on her close fourth to Zee Zee Top (GB) in the G1 Prix de l'Opera Oct. 5.
