**IMPERIAL ROMAN**

**Imperial Dancer (GB)** (Primo Dominie {GB}) reached a career zenith with a smooth score in the G1 Premio Roma, the final Group 1 event of the European season. The result was never in doubt as soon as jockey Ted

Durcan shook the reins inside the final eighth. Held up in customary fashion in rear, Imperial Dancer made steady progress onto the heels of defending champion **Sunstrach (Ire)** (Polar Falcon) as that rival was committed by Frankie Dettori with three furlongs remaining. Quickening to cut him down with 300 yards remaining, he only needed hand riding to assert and stretch clear of the fast-finishing **Altieri (GB)** (Selkirk).

"He won it easily and was always in control," Durcan explained. "When I asked him to kick on there was never going to be a problem." In the

true tradition of trainer Mick Channon's hardest campaigners, Imperial Dancer has thrived on his 15 starts this season, going from strength to strength since finishing runner-up to High Chaparral (Ire) in the G2 Royal Whip S. at The Curragh Aug. 10. After running third to Ange Gabriel (Fr) in the G2 Prix Foy at Longchamp Sept. 14, he took the Listed Doonside Cup at Ayr six days later before finishing sixth behind Weightless (GB) in the G2 Prix Dollar back at Longchamp Oct. 4. He suffered a troubled trip when fourth to Rakti (GB) in the G1 Champion S. at Newmarket Oct. 18 before bouncing back to win the G3 St Simon S. at Newbury last time Oct. 25. Connections are planning to keep the five-year-old in training and take him to Dubai in the spring. **Chart, p2**

**THE BUCK STOPS HERE**

**Hard Buck (Brz)** (Spend a Buck) maintained a perfect record in the U.S. by posting a hard-fought victory over pacesetter **Warleigh** (Lord At War {Arg}) in the GIII River City H. at Churchill yesterday afternoon. A Group 1 winner in his native Brazil, the dark bay was a distant ninth in the G2 UAE Derby in March, and was given some time to acclimate upon his arrival in the States. He captured the TriState H. at Ellis in his U.S. bow Sept. 1 and added a game victory in the Kentucky Cup Mile three weeks later at Kentucky Downs. Jockey Brice Blanc tucked the four-year-old into a ground-saving third, then sent him up the rail in pursuit of Warleigh, who had posted five straight front-running victories. Hard Buck put his head in front with less than a sixteenth of a mile remaining and inched clear in the final strides. Two-time defending champion **Dr. Kashnikow** (El Gran Senor) was scratched with a fever, while **Better Talk Now** (Talkin Man) was withdrawn due to a sore foot.

Duca d'Atri sprang a major shock by swooping late to deny the game duo of Romaldo and Marbye while recording a career best. After failing to make an impact in stakes company last year, he was confined to conditions races and handicaps this term, winning four, including a competitive event at this track Oct. 26. Ridden with restraint by Dario Vargiu throughout the early stages of this contest, he allowed Marbye and Romaldo to duel in front before being asked to quicken inside the final quarter. Responding in game fashion, Duca d'Atri cut down those rivals in the final 50 yards before asserting for the score. Favorite Salselon (Salse) launched his effort in the middle of the track in the straight before fading out of contention. He was later found to be lame after losing two shoes during the race.

Winter Garden finally earned her first graded victory after going close in two previous attempts. Third in the GI Selene S. May 19, she missed by a half-length in the GIII Duchess S. Aug. 9 before posting two straight victories in lesser company. She narrowly won an allowance over track and trip Sept. 21 prior to her success in the Ontario Fashion H. Oct. 25, and went postward as the 121-pound highweight despite being the only three-year-old in the field. Never far from the front, the bay gained command after a half in :45.91 and turned back several challenges to prevail as the even-money chalk. "I'm very proud of her," enthused winning trainer Bob Tiller. "She's certainly the top three-year-old filly in Canada as far as I'm concerned. She's proved her point."

A progressive sort, Glad to be Fast confirmed he is still on the upgrade by wearing down the enterprisingly ridden Fairy Beauty to take this competitive event. Having won the Listed Dusseldorf-Cup July 27, he could fare no better than eighth in the G3 Preis von Berlin at Hoppegarten Aug. 10 before bouncing back to finish runner-up in the G3 Grosser Buchmacher Springer Sprint-Preis at Munich Oct. 12. He was beaten 3/4 of a length by Salselon (GB) in the G3 Premio Chiusura at Milan Nov. 2 over seven furlongs, but appreciated the drop back to six panels here, using his natural speed to stalk Fairy Beauty before pouncing with a furlong remaining and drawing clear under William Mongil.

**MEN'S EXCLUSIVE RETIRED** Ten-year-old **Men's Exclusive** (Exclusive Ribot--Men's Number, by Meneval), who won 11 races and \$1,447,928 during his nine years at the track, has been retired, the *Daily Racing Form* reports. "He ran so many great races," trainer Wesley Ward told *DRF*. "He was a fighter, tough as nails. Now he has a beautiful pace set up in Corona [California], where he'll live for the next 20 years." Bred and raced by Gene Reed, the dark bay earned his first graded victory at four, taking the GIII Los Angeles H. He finished off the board for the first time when sixth in the 1997 GI Breeders' Cup Sprint and traveled outside of California for the first time for his final start of the year, running 12th in the Sprinter S. at Nakayama. Winless at five and six, he finally returned to the winner's circle after taking the Bull Dog S. at Fresno in October of 2000. He also notched his second graded-stakes success that season, taking the GIII Vernon O. Underwood S. He started 2001 with a victory in the GI Palos Verdes H. and a second in the G3 Dubai Golden Shaheen, then was off the board in his next three outings before capturing a second Underwood to cap the campaign. The veteran was without a win last year, but proved he still had something left this year, earning his last victory in a Santa Anita allowance in March. The Cal-bred was kept in training after Reed died in September, running third in the California Sprint Championship S. before ending his career with a seventh in the Nov. 8 Cal Cup Sprint H. He retires as the 14th-leading Cal-bred earner.
