LADY GISELLE EUTHANIZED

Lady Giselle (Fr) (Nureyev--Valderna {Fr}, by *Val de Loir), the dam of champion sire Zabeel (NZ), was euthanized at Arrowfield Stud in Australia after suffering complications during the latter stages of her pregnancy, according to published reports. "She hasn't been having the best of time recently," Arrowfield's Byron Rogers told *racenet.com.au*. "She's always been such a fantastic broodmare, but the last month or so she's been uncomfortable, and things came to a head last Monday. In her own best interests, we decided to put her down." The 21-year-old mare had been carrying a colt by Redoute's Choice (Aus). "The colt did initially survive," Rogers continued, "But he was

2 1/2 weeks premature and had underdeveloped lungs, and unfortunately he died. Lady Giselle will be buried at the cemetery here, next to Denise's Joy." An unraced filly from the immediate family of Arc heroine Detroit (Fr), the bay was bred to *Sir Tristram and produced Zabeel (NZ) in 1986. He sold as a yearling for NZ\$650,000 to Sheikh Hamdan, for whom he captured the G1 Australian Guineas. Zabeel has become a new flagbearer for New Zealand's Cambridge Stud, where he has sired 25 Group 1 winners to date, including Australian Horse of the Year Octagonal (NZ) and Melbourne Cup winners Might and Power (NZ) and Jezabeel (NZ). He has won the Australian sire title twice, and the New Zealand title four times, and stands at Cambridge Stud for NZ\$85,000. Lady Giselle later produced Baryshnikov (Aus) (Kenmare {Fr}), another winner of the G1 Australian Guineas; and Charming Life (NZ) (*Sir Tristram), the dam of European MGSWs Kingfisher Mill (Riverman) and Wellbeing (GB) (Sadler's Wells). Her final foal is Break the Vault (Aus), an unraced two-year-old colt by Redoute's Choice.

TILLERMAN DISQUALIFIED

Tillerman (GB) (In the Wings {GB}) has been disqualified from his runner-up finish in the G1 Queen Anne S. at Royal Ascot June 17 by the Jockey Club. Juddmonte Farms' seven-year-old was found to have traces of the prohibited substance clenbuterol in his urine after his four-length second to Dubai Destination in the mile contest. The Jockey Club's disciplinary panel yesterday confirmed the findings, but were satisfied that the source of the substance was Ventipulmin, which connections had stopped giving to Tillerman nine days before the race. The Queen's **Right Approach (GB)** (Machiavellian) was promoted to second place and **Where or When (Ire)** (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) placed third.

Baze Passes 400-win Mark Again:

Jockey Russell Baze recorded his 400th win of the season when Hooked on Niners won the third race, a 1 1/16-mile turf contest at Golden Gate Wednesday. The 45-year-old, who is also the fourth winningest rider in racing history, is the only jockey in Thoroughbred racing history to win 400 races in a year more than three times. He has accomplished the feat for the 11th time in 12 years. "The only time I think about it [winning 400 races] is when I start getting close," said Baze. "At the beginning of the year I don't worry about it. It's nice to do, but you have to take it one race at a time." Baze, who had his first 400-win campaign in 1992 when he reached the winner's circle 433 times.

Early Flyer to Valor Farm:

Multiple graded stakes winner **Early Flyer** (Gilded Time--Bistra, by Classic Go Go) has been retired from racing and will take up stud duties at Clarence and Dorothy Scharbauer's Valor Farm in Pilot Point, Texas. He will stand for a fee of \$2,500. The five-year-old stallion won the 2001 GII San Vicente S. and GIII Laz Barrera Memorial S. and was second in that year's GI Frank J. De Francis Memorial Dash S. On the board in 11 of 15 starts, Early Flyer retires with four wins and earnings of \$371,140. "We were attracted to Early Flyer because he ran with and defeated some of the best horses in Southern California," said Ken Carson, general manager of Valor Farm. "He is from one of the most active families in the stud book. He had two close relatives run in the Breeders' Cup this year. Also, he is an absolute outcross to Northern Dancer, Mr. Prospector and Seattle Slew. And best of all, he is a grand-looking horse. Bob McCann, who handled the transaction, has always told us what a beautiful horse this is." Early Flyer's second dam Carols Christmas is also the second dam of 2003 Breeders' Cup runners Cuvee and Bien Nicole.

Roar of the Tiger on the Comeback Trail:

Choctaw Racing Stable's **Roar of the Tiger** (Storm Cat), a full brother to Giant's Causeway, breezed five furlongs beneath jockey Larry Melancon yesterday morning at Churchill Downs in 1:00 4/5. "It was just a nice move, the kind of work this horse is capable of," said trainer Lynn Whiting. "He worked right after the [renovation] break and the track was in optimum condition. But it wasn't anything that's going to knock him back." The son of Mariah's Storm (Rahy), a maiden winner in four European starts at two and three, finished an excellent third to Mineshaft in their respective U.S. debuts at Churchill Downs last Nov. 27. He was on his way to becoming a force in the handicap division last winter, with back-to-back allowance victories at the Fair Grounds, but was sidelined following a Jan. 11 allowance success with a strained suspensory in his left fore. "We thought it was in his best interest to back off," trainer Whiting explained. "We'd like to win a graded stakes with him this year. He's really filled out during the time off and we have high hopes for him." Roar of the Tiger, who was having his fourth workout since returning to the track, could make a start "around the first of the year," the conditioner indicated.

Race for Education to Host Horsemen of All Ages Sale:

The Race For Education, which raised \$45,000 during last year's inaugural Horsemen of All Ages Sale, is accepting nominations for the 2004 edition of the benefit auction. The event, which will feature an auction of bachelors and bachelorettes in the racing and equestrian industries, will be held Feb. 20 at Gulfstream Park in Hallandale, Florida. "This is a light-hearted spoof of a horse sale, so the only real requirement is a sense of humor," said Elisabeth Jensen, executive director of The Race For Education.
