ALL'S WELL THAT ENDS WELL FOR FRANKEL

Trainer Bobby Frankel eclipsed Charlie Whittingham's 859 career wins at Hollywood Park, as his pupil **Continuously** (Diesis {GB}) was awarded the victory upon the disqualification of Juddmonte Farms' and stablemate **Epicentre** (Kris S.), who was found to have interfered with **Bowman Mill** (Kris S.) in upper stretch. It made for an interesting situation in the winner's circle, as Dr. John Chandler, owner and breeder of Bowman Mill, also serves as American representative for Juddmonte Farms and Chandler's Mill Ridge Farm stands the sire of the winner. A maiden winner in five European starts, Continuously won two of his first three U.S. tries before finishing a close third in the GII Del Mar H. Aug. 31. Fourth in the GI C.L. Hirsch Sept. 28, the bay was eighth of nine in the GII C.F. Burke H. Oct. 24 at Santa Anita. Bowman Mill set dawdling fractions on the front end as Corey Nakatani and Epicentre raced in close attendance from third. The latter advanced into second at the quarter pole, but exchanged bumps with Bowman Mill, causing the chestnut to go off stride momentarily. Epicentre flew home to take the photo from a flying Continuously, but was subsequently demoted. "Those stewards must be blind," said an exasperated Nakatani. "I just don't understand it. IPI TOMBE RETIRED

South African champion **Ipi Tombe (Zim)** (Manshood {GB}--Carnet de Danse, by Dance In Time), winner of the G1 Dubai Duty Free S. this past March, has been retired after a training setback which would have prevented her from defending her title in the \$2-million event in March. Owned by a partnership including WinStar Farm, Team Valor and Sunmark Partners, the five-year-old won eight of her first 10 career starts in

Zimbabwe and South Africa, including the G1 South African Fillies Guineas and G1 July H., and was named the champion three-year-filly of her generation. Sent to the Middle East for the winter, the bay mare capped a three-for-three campaign with her three-length victory over Paolini (Ger) in the Duty

Free in her final start for trainer Mike de Kock. Shipped to the U.S. to continue her career under the tutelage of Elliott Walden, Ipi Tombe registered a half-length success in the June 28 GIII Locust Grove H. in what would become her final career appearance. She was preparing for a start in the GI Diana H. earlier this summer when she suffered a season-ending injury, but had recently returned to the track. Walden ordered a bone scan this past Tuesday, suspecting something was amiss with the mare. "She's got a little bit of an inflammation of the cannon bone from going back in training," Walden commented. "She was showing some heat in her ankles, all four ankles. She was moving pretty well. But we wanted to do the bone scan before we went to Florida and Dr. [Larry] Bramlage recommended we give her 30 days. So, at that point, if she wasn't going to make Dubai, [the owners] decided to retire her." Added WinStar President Doug Cauthen, "We weren't going to make our goal of running her in Dubai and she was too valuable not to go ahead and breed. She's a champion and had proved everything that she possibly could." Plans call for Ipi Tombe to be offered in foal at the 2004 Keeneland November Sale. She retires with a record of 14-12-2-0 and earnings of \$1,529,799.

Had the race been washed onto the main track, the competition could have included fellow GSW Snake Mountain and GISW Evening Attire, but there were no such monsters for Balto Star to deal with on the turf. The winner of the GI United Nations H. over this distance earlier in the summer, the gelding, third to Sulamani (Ire) in the GI Turf Classic Sept. 27, was most recently last of nine in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Oct. 25. Allowed to lope along through fractions of :49.77 and 1:15.10, Balto Star shook loose approaching the final turn, was clear by as many as eight in the stretch and won easily. "He's one of those in-and-out horses," winning trainer Todd Pletcher commented. "When things are right, he can fire huge and when things aren't right, he'll throw in a clunker. "He cleans up our best, now bring on the rest." Those were the words of race caller David Raphael as Silent Witness extended his winning streak to seven with a comprehensive success in this local prep for the Dec. 14 G1 Hong Kong Sprint. Named the champion griffin in a season capped by a win in the G2-HK Sha Tin Vase in June, the four-year-old had to work to maintain his unblemished record in his 2003-2004 bow, winning the G3-HK Sha Tin Sprint Trophy by a nose Oct. 11. Backed down to odds-on favoritism for this, the bay gelding hopped a bit at the start, but recovered quickly to set the pace along the inside as the field raced up the chute. Given his cue with 400 meters to come, Silent Witness quickened up nicely and was going away at the finish. Cheerful Fortune chased throughout and was a solid second while Firebolt, second to All Thrills Too (Aus) (St Covet {Aus}) in last year's Hong Kong Sprint, was a wide third.

Lucky Owners looked hopelessly beaten in upper stretch, but responded to a strong left-handed whip to give jockey and trainer a four-bagger on the afternoon and a sweep of the International Trials. Out of the top three just once in nine previous starts in Hong Kong, all at this track, the colt returned from a three-month summer vacation to take a Class 1 handicap over this distance Sept. 13 before finishing a short-head second in a similar event Oct. 11. The bay was coming into his group-stakes debut off a narrow Class 1 success Nov. 2, but was nonetheless favored to make the grade. Asked to keep in close contact with the frontrunners, Lucky Owners was fourth as they raced into the turn, had a clear run turning for home, drifted out noticeably at the 300-meter mark, but dug in determinedly to deny Ho Choi at the wire. 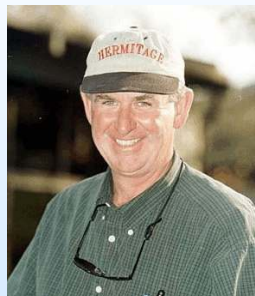

Riskaverse inched past the million-dollar mark in career earnings with a game victory, her first in graded company since winning the GI Queen Elizabeth II S. 13 months ago. The winner of her seasonal debut May 18, the homebred filly was a solid second in the GIII Just A Game BC H. June 7 and third in the GII New York H. July 4 before heading to Saratoga. Fourth in the GI Diana H. July 26, the dark bay was third in the GI Beverly D. S. Aug. 17 at Arlington, fifth in the Sept. 27 GI Flower Bowl Invitational at Belmont and most recently a midpack sixth, beaten five lengths, in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf. A turf-saving fourth behind pacesetter Bien Nicole for the opening six furlongs, Riskaverse eased out two deep for the drive, engaged the front-runner with a sixteenth of a mile to run and inched away. "I was confident I would catch [Bien Nicole]," winning rider Cornelio Velasquez said. "The trainer told me to put her in the clear and that she would go and she did." The way that **Durandal** came from well off the pace to win the G1 Sprinters' S. over 1200 meters Oct. 5 suggests that he can handle the extra two furlongs of today's event. Ninth in the G2 Nakayama Kinen in March, the four-year-old returned to be a solid third, beaten a little more than a length in the G3 Centaur S. at Hanshin Sept. 14 prior to his success in the Sprinters' S. **Special Kaldoun** took the G3 Prix Messidor at Deauville July 13 before finishing a good fourth to subsequent Breeders' Cup Mile winner Six Perfections (Fr) in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois Aug. 17. Eighth in the G1 Prix du Moulin Sept. 7, the Irish-bred comes into this off a four-length score in the G2 Prix Daniel Wildenstein Oct. 4. Jockey Dominique Boeuf is in for the ride.

Toccet (Awesome Again) will return to the site of his victory in the GII Remsen S. a year ago when he goes postward in the Cigar. The bay had also been under consideration for the Clark H. or the GI Hollywood Derby, but connections have decided to remain on the east coast. "He's never been beaten at Aqueduct and likes the cold weather," owner Dan Borislow told *Daily Racing Form*. "He's doing super--he's ready to explode. He's the same horse he was as a two-year-old." Toccet was most recently a tough-luck runner-up in the Nov. 15 Hail Emperor S. at Laurel Park, a race for which he earned a career-best 106 Beyer Speed Figure. Borislow told the *Form* that he is trying to secure the services of Ryan Fogelsonger, if Toccet receives a low weight.
