TATTERSALLS DECEMBER SALE BEGINS

Tattersalls' marathon December Sale begins in Newmarket at 10 a.m. today with 260 yearlings taking center stage. After an incredibly strong round of yearling sales, with several buyers still having orders to fill, and a good catalogue, there is every reason to think the buoyant trade will continue. Following the death of Lord Weinstock, his executors offered a draft of yearlings from Ballymacoll Stud at this sale last year and the same vendor, selling through Peter Kavanagh's Kildaragh Stud, consigns a team of six youngsters this year. These include [Lot 191](#), a Machiavellian colt out of Desert Beauty (Ire) (Green Desert), who is a half sister to dual G1 Yorkshire Oaks heroine Islington (Ire) (Sadler's Wells). David and Patricia Thompson's Cheveley Park Stud is another vendor to specifically target this event and the locally based farm offers five lots, including [Lot 123](#), an offering by Boundary and a granddaughter of American Grade II winner Lemhi Go (Lemhi Gold). But few vendors set out to sell specifically at this sale, the majority tend to sell horses who have either been withdrawn, sold or returned home from other yearling sales. Tattersalls has three lots by Sadler's Wells on offer, including [Lot 204](#), a colt out of Lydara (Alydar) bred by Sir Martyn Arbib and offered from Kirtlington Stud. The February 1st foal was withdrawn from the Houghton Sale earlier this year. [Lot 115](#), a Zafonic half brother to the useful three-year-old Tarjman (GB) (Cadeaux Genereux {GB}), missed his date at the Tattersalls October Sale and is re-offered from Kevin Mercer's Usk Valley Stud.

December Forecast

"Last year's December Yearling Sale was a record-breaker which will make it a hard act to follow, but on paper there's every reason to think that this year's sale should be as strong," commented Jimmy George, Tattersalls' marketing director. The sale begins at 10 a.m., with business resuming on Wednesday at 9:30 a.m. for the first of four days of foals. The Breeding Stock section starts a week today, carrying on through Thursday, December 4.

SPEEDY SMOKEY GLACKEN

Smokey Glacken (Forestry) suffered the first defeat of her career when third in the Oct. 12 GII Astarita S. at Belmont Park, but the speedy filly returned with a vengeance, taking the GIII Valley Stream S. by 3 3/4 lengths yesterday at Aqueduct. The bay filly, a five-

length maiden winner at Saratoga in August, added the Forward Gal S. at Monmouth Park Sept. 21, before making her graded stakes debut in the Astarita in just her third start. Yesterday, Smokey Glacken stumbled at the start, but rushed up to set the pace through quick fractions of :21.79, :45.04 and :57.55. She drew off when asked in the stretch and held off the late rush of **Baldomera** (Doneraile Court) for the win. "She was much the best," jockey Jose Santos said of the winner. "She ran beautiful." Trainer Terry Mills will no doubt be keeping an eye on [Lot 141](#), a Night Shift gelding consigned by Joe Hernon's Castletown Stud for Limehill Stud. The Epsom trainer won last season's G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. with the youngster's half brother Where Or When (Ire) (Danehill Dancer {Ire}) and also saddled another half brother, All The Way (Ire) (Shirley Heights {GB}), to finish fifth in the G1 Vodafone Derby. Ted Voute's draft includes [Lot 175](#), **Spinning Well** (Spinning World), a half brother to G3 Lancashire Oaks winner Fanjica (Ire) (Law Society). [Lot 176](#), a Selkirk colt out of Breadcrumb (GB) (Final Straw {GB}), is a half brother to seven winners, including G2 Challenge S. heroine Last Resort (GB) (Lahib), who was sold for 825,000gns as a broodmare at last year's December Sale. EPISTOLIERE TOPS BROODMARES AT GOFFS

[Epistolier \(Ire\)](#), a bay mare by Alzao out of stakes-placed Epistolienne (Law Society), realized a high bid of €210,000 at Goffs November Broodmare & Fillies Sale in Kildare, Ireland Sunday. Consigned by Ballymacoll Stud Farm Ltd., on behalf of the Societe Civile de L'Ecvrie de Meauty, the four-year-old mare is believed to be in foal to Indian Danehill (Ire) and was purchased by Iverk House Stud. "I bought her because of her pedigree and she is a fine mare," said the stud's John Dwane. "We are looking to upgrade our broodmare band." The bay is a full sister to multiple group winner Epistolaire (Ire) and group placed Epistole (Ire) and a half sister to Epitre (Fr) (Common Grounds {GB}), also a multiple group winner in France. The second leading mare on the day was a four-year-old daughter of Zafonic out of Group 2 winner Grecian Urn (GB) (El-Mana-Mou {Ire}). Purchased for €150,000 by Curragh Bloodstock Agency, winning [Grecian Glory \(Ire\)](#) was consigned by Tinnakill House. Believed to be in foal to Barathea (Ire), the chestnut is a half sister to a pair of Listed winners by Darshaan (GB); Grecian Dart (Ire) and Dark Shell (Ire).

CLARK H.-GII, \$500,000, 3yo/up, 1 1/8m

Edmund Gann's **Medaglia d'Oro** (El Prado {Ire}), most recently second in the Breeders' Cup Classic, has been assigned top weight of 125 pounds for the main event of the "Big 4" weekend at Churchill Downs. Should he start, the four-year-old would concede six pounds to **Tenpins** (Smart Strike), fourth in last year's Clark. **Medaglia d'Oro** and stablemate and GII Falls City contender **Sightseek** (Distant View) are expected to arrive in Louisville on a Tuesday flight from Southern California.

Aeneas (Capote, 114) will ship in from Florida for the race. Second or third in four graded stakes this year, the four-year-old was most recently third to Perfect Drift and Tenpins in the GII Hawthorne Gold Cup Sept. 28. Gary Boulanger flies in for trainer Marty Wolfson.

Trainer Peter Vestal yesterday revealed that **Crafty Shaw** (Crafty Prospector) will also start in the Clark. "We know he runs well on this racetrack and doesn't have to mess with the shipping issue," Vestal explained. "Also, I didn't want to run against [likely GI Cigar Mile favorite] Congaree going a mile--anywhere."

Durandal scored one for the home team when he closed from far off the pace to collect his first Group 1 victory in Sunday's Mile Championship at Kyoto Racecourse. Gallant Arrow jumped out of the stalls to take the early lead, but didn't have an easy time of it as Magnaten (Danzig) pressed matters. Durandal, winner of the Sprinters S. at Nakayama Oct. 5, was content to settle in 17th in the early stages and, when it came time to make his move a half mile from home, he had to make his run from the outside. With a head of steam, Durandal passed the hard-running Gallant Arrow in the stretch before taking over from Fine Motion in the final strides to gain the narrow win. The 4-5 favorite Sidewinder (Jpn) (Tony Bin {Ire}), who settled just behind the early pace, did not fire and came home a leg-weary eighth.

BIEN NICOLE INJURED *Bien Nicole* (Bien Bien) was injured in her runner-up finish in Saturday's GII Cardinal H. at Churchill Downs. The five-year-old mare came out of the race with a condylar fracture in her left hind leg. She underwent surgery to repair the fracture Sunday morning and connections are undecided if the multiple graded stakes winner will return to the track. "She may very well be retired, but the injury is such that she should return 100 percent," said trainer Donnie Von Hemel. "We're just happy that the injury wasn't any worse than it was and for all the good that she has done for us." *Bien Nicole* put together an impressive 2003 campaign, finishing second behind *Heat Haze* in the GI Beverly D and winning the GII WinStar Galaxy S. and the GIII Oaklawn Breeders' Cup S. On the board in 22 starts, the mare has won 12 times and earned \$1,074,620.

The four-year-old was haltered out of a \$40,000 optional claimer at Laurel last October--a 7 1/2-length winning performance--but went missing for the next 11 months. Sent off at 7-2 odds in an off-the-turfer at Pimlico Sept. 27 in his return, he rewarded connections' patience by going gate to wire and establishing a new five-furlong mark of :56 2/5 in the process. Here, the crowd's second choice was quickest into stride, was left alone rounding the turn and held on gamely despite getting a bit leg weary in the last sixteenth.

It didn't take long for Six Sexy Sisters, the baby sis of 2003 Canadian Triple Crown victor Wando, to add black type to her resume, winning easily as part of a small four-filly field. Making an auspicious debut as the 5-2 favorite, she won by eight lengths going a mile and 70 yards Oct. 4 and was odds-on to make it two straight. The Gustav Schickedanz homebred got off to a slow start, but recovered quickly and put herself within striking distance with an inside move under jockey Patrick Husbands--who was aboard for Wando's Triple Crown heroics. Six Sexy Sisters gained the lead nearing the half-mile pole, rebuffed a challenge from Duet on the turn and was kept to task through the lane.
