he has the five-year-old sitting on ready for this one. "Everything's fine and he's perfect," the conditioner assured. "I just hope he stays like he is right now and I hope everybody has a fair trip and we'll see what happens." Pat Day takes the reins for the injured Robby Albarado. The lone Grade I winner in the field, **Evening Attire** (Black Tie Affair {Ire}) ships in from New York for Pat Kelly, who won the Gill Cardinal H. last weekend with Riskaverse. The grey gelding was most recently seventh in the Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 25.

**HAVANA HORSE ACQUIRES BOSRA SHAM**

Andy Smith of Havana Horse (UK) Ltd has acquired **Bosra Sham** (Woodman--Korveya, by Riverman) in a "special arrangement" prior to her imminent sale at next week's Tattersalls December Sale. Captain Tim Bulwer-Long, racing manager of Addison Racing Ltd Inc, yesterday announced that the brilliant racemare, who took the 1996 G1 1000 Guineas and G1 Champion S., had been withdrawn from the sale "on recent expert advice." He explained, "It was considered that the tremendous interest and stress put on the mare over the next week could possibly be detrimental to her current well being." Smith, chairman of Havana Horse, commented that he had "acquired this mare and she will be sent to the U.S.A. to visit Storm Cat." Bosra Sham is already the dam of 1-million guineas purchase **Shami (GB)** (Rainbow Quest) and **Rosberg** (A.P. Indy), who made \$1.5 million at the 2002 Keeneland September sale and was a five-length maiden winner on his second start at Santa Anita Oct. 4. Her foal of this year, a colt by Singspiel (Ire), sells as lot number [1053](#) as part of the Addison dispersal tomorrow at Tattersalls.

**Take Charge Lady** returns to her Old Kentucky Home for what could be the final start of a stellar career. In 10 starts in the Bluegrass, the attractive bay filly has won seven times and finished second on three occasions, one of those coming in last year's Falls City. She has just one victory in the GIII Dogwood S. from four starts at Churchill, but is the obvious class of the field and is strictly the one to beat, despite her disappointing sixth-place finish in the Breeders' Cup Distaff. Tony D'Amico, who was aboard the four-year-old in nine of her first 10 starts, gets the mount this afternoon. **Awesome Lady** makes her final appearance before heading off to stud. Winner of the GI Spinaway S. at two, the WinStar colorbearer has amassed over a half million dollars this season, her most important victory coming in the GIII Indiana Breeders' Cup Oaks Oct. 3. The dark bay was most recently a rallying second, beaten a half length by **Lead Story** in the GII Churchill Downs Distaff H. Nov. 8.

Fifth to Sightseek in this event last year, **Willa On the Move** won her first two starts of this season, including a half-length score over Shine Again in the GIII Honorable Miss H. at Saratoga Aug. 1 with Edgar Prado up. Fifth in the Aug. 24 GI Ballerina H. at the Spa, the chestnut comes off a handy two-length score in the Maryland Million Distaff H. Oct. 11. **Zawzooth** won the restricted My Juliet S. at Belmont Park July 16 before finishing last of five in Saratoga allowance company Aug. 18. The grey filly closed gamely in her latest to finish third, 1 1/2 lengths adrift of **Randaroo**, in the GII First Flight H. over seven furlongs Oct. 25 and can improve with the added distance.

**GRADED STAKES TOTAL 480 FOR '04** The American Graded Stakes Committee of the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association has graded a total of 480 races for the 2004 racing season, down seven from this year. A total of 12 races received upgrades, including four new Grade I events and eight new Grade II events. Six previously ungraded races have been awarded Grade III status. The committee has decided to downgrade a total of 12 races; five Grade I events will be contested as Grade IIs in 2004, while an additional three races were lowered from Grade II to Grade III status. Four events were downgraded from Grade IIIs to ungraded races. (*Downgraded races, p5*)

**TATTS FOALS KICK OFF** Tattersalls' December Foal Sale began in Newmarket yesterday with the weakest of the four days but the 7,944gns average was still up 12 percent on last year's record, the 5,000gns median was up 25 percent and the 1,421,900gns aggregate for an expanded catalogue was virtually double the 2002 figure. The top price was just 40,000gns - a fraction of the sums that will be made later in the week - for an athletic son of Fraam (GB) (Lead On Time) offered for a partnership from West Moor Stud. Agent Gill Richardson outbid pinhooker Eddie O'Leary, owner of Lynn Lodge Stud in Co Westmeath, for the colt. "He was bought to race for a client and was a fabulous athletic colt," said Richard son. A Lujain (Seeking The Gold) colt out of the unraced Petardia (GB) mare Georgianna (Ire) was bought for 39,000gns by Oliver Gaisford St Lawrence from the Swinburn family's locally-based Genesis Green Stud. "He was a cracking colt who has been bought for an existing client, probably to race," said Gaisford St Lawrence. The sale continues today, beginning at 9:30 a.m.

**HONG KONG SET TO HOST THE WORLD** A total of 56 horses representing 12 racing jurisdictions from all over the world have received invitations to the Hong Kong International Races to be contested Dec. 14 at Sha Tin Racecourse. Among the invitees are 20 individual Grade/Group 1 winners, including **Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King), who will make his final racecourse appearance in the G1 Hong Kong Cup before heading off to stud duties in Japan. He leads an impressive list of 14 possibles for the 2000-meter test, which also includes G1 Champion S. hero **Rakti (GB)** (Polish Precedent), **Eishin Preston** (Green Dancer), the 2001 winner of the Hong Kong Mile, and defending race champion **Precision (Fr)** (Anabaa). Hong Kong-based horses won three of the four events last year and **Olympic Express (GB)** (Bishop of Cashel {GB}) and **All Thrills Too (Aus)** (St Covet {Aus}) could return to defend their respective titles in the G1 Mile and G1 Sprint. The latter event is also expected to attract undefeated **Silent Witness (Aus)** (El Moxie), representing Hong Kong, and South Africa's sprint sensation **National Currency (SAf)** (National Assembly), six-length winner in his native country of the G1 Mercury Sprint. **Johar** (Gone West), the dead-heat winner of the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf, is engaged in the G1 Hong Kong Vase, won last year by France's **Ange Gabriel (Fr)** (Kaldounevees {Fr}). Johar is scheduled to make his next appearance in Sunday's G1 Japan Cup in Tokyo. Seven countries are represented in a wide-open Mile. Among the invitees is Gary Tanaka's **Sarafan** (Lear Fan), who could drop back in distance following his try in the Japan Cup. The six-year-old gelding was a close fourth in the 2002 Hong Kong Cup. **DETTORI GETS FALBRAV CALL-UP** Connections of **Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King) announced that Frankie Dettori will replace Darryll Holland in the Hong Kong Cup at Sha Tin Dec. 14. The Scuderia Rencati and Teruya Yoshida-owned five-year-old was partnered by Dettori when winning last year's G1 Japan Cup and the two will be reunited for the 10-furlong contest. "He is a true champion and I'm proud to ride him again," Dettori told the *Thoroughbred Times*. "Last year he gave me an incredible win in the Japan Cup. For an Italian jockey, it is a very special feeling to ride an Italian horse in as big a race as the Hong Kong Cup." Conditioner Luca Cumani revealed that this year's G1 Eclipse S., G1 International S. and G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. winner will fly out to Hong Kong on Wednesday.

**SOVEREIGN AWARD FINALISTS ANNOUNCED**

The Jockey Club of Canada yesterday announced the finalists for the 29th Annual Sovereign Awards. Winners from 15 categories will be announced at the Sovereign Awards Gala on Saturday, Dec. 6, at the Fairmont Royal York Hotel in Toronto, Ontario. The star of the evening figures to be Gustav Shickedanz's homebred **Wando** (Langfuhr), who became just the seventh horse to sweep Canada's Triple Crown races. The handsome chestnut won in succession the Queen's Plate by nine lengths, the Prince of Wales S. by four lengths and the Breeders' S. by 1 1/2 lengths for trainer Mike Keogh, who was nominated for Outstanding Trainer. Shickedanz was nominated in both the Outstanding Breeder and Outstanding Owner categories. Canada's 2003 Horse of the Year will also be named.

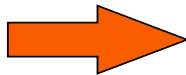
