FAST ON HIS FEET

Half of the 18-horse field had flown into Tokyo looking for Japan Cup glory, but it was the local longshot **Tap Dance City** (Pleasant Tap) that carried the day for the home team. The first five places in yesterday's G1 Japan Cup were filled by Japanese-based runners; G1 E.P. Taylor S. runner-up **Tigertail (Fr)** (Priolo), third in the G1 Queen Elizabeth II Commemorative Cup at Kyoto Nov. 16, did the best of the invaders, finishing sixth at 110-1. But she was no match for the winner, who broke sharply, set all the pace over a very wet Tokyo turf and coasted to the wire a nine-length winner over three-year-old **That's a Plenty (Jpn)** (Dance in the Dark {Jpn}) second, 3/4 of a length in front of 19-10 choice **Symboli Kris S.** (Kris S.). "I knew the horse was in great condition and that he would probably handle the slippery going," trainer Shozo Sazaki said. "I don't know when I knew he was going to win, but I know I was screaming my head off and I must have looked a sight." **Japan Cup cont. p2**

TURNING ON THE HEAT IN THE MATRIARCH

Heat Haze (Green Desert) staked her claim on champion turf mare honors with a last-to-first move in Sunday's G1 Matriarch S. at Hollywood Park. The 14-horse field packed plenty of star quality with no less than six Graded/Group 1 stakes winners in the line-up; 2002 and 2003 G1 Prix de la Foret winners **Dedication (Fr)** (Highest Honor {Fr}) and **Etoile Montante** (Miswaki); **Musical Chimes** (In Excess {Ire}), victorious in the 2003 G1 Poule d'Essai des Pouliches; G1 Alabama S. heroine **Island Fashion**

(Petionville) and defending

Matriarch champion **Dress to Thrill (Ire)** (Danehill).

Rounding out the sextet, Heat Haze, who recorded her biggest win in the G1 Beverly D. at Arlington Aug. 16, went off at fat 9-2 odds here to claim sole bragging rights as a dual Grade I stakes winner.

TATTS DECEMBER MARES STARTS TODAY

Two winners of the G1 Epsom Oaks and one G1 Irish Oaks heroine are among the highlights of a superb breeding stock catalogue at the Tattersalls December Sale, which resumes at 9:30 a.m. today. Although champion Bosra Sham (GB) was been sold privately prior to her intended date as the star member of Wafic Said's dispersal, the owner's draft is still full of gems, including the Epsom Oaks heroine Lady Carla (GB) (Caerleon), offered as Lot 2206 with a Mark Of Esteem (Ire) cover. The draft also features this season's G3 Fred Darling S. heroine Tante Rose (Ire) (Barathea {Ire}). Lady Carla scored at Epsom in 1996, three years before Ramruma (Diesis {GB}), Lot 1898, had her Epsom triumph. The mare is the highlight of the sale's other major dispersal, that of the late Prince Fahd Salman's Newgate Stud. Presented through agent Ted Voute, Ramruma is offered in foal to Machiavellian. Other jewels from Newgate Stud include Lot 1897, Midnight Line (Kris S.), the GII Long Island H. winner offered with a Rainbow Quest covering. **Tatts Preview cont. p3**

He's Not Getting Older...

It took him until the age of six to earn his first Group 1 win, but **Tap Dance City** did not surprise his connections with his Japan Cup success. The bay had shown serious improvement since last season. He ended 2002 with a second in the prestigious Arima Kinen and had won three of his last four starts, most recently returning from a 3 1/2-month break to win the Oct. 12 Kyoto Daishoten. "Tap Dance City was a great horse from the start, but he needed to mature," Shozo Sazaki said. "He used to tap dance into the paddock, and it was only before his previous race that he was able to walk calmly with only one person to lead him. Today he was 100 percent calm and I knew he would run a good race." The winner will be pointed for another tilt at the Arima Kinen later this month. "I just have to maintain his form until that race and perhaps he will be selected Horse of the Year," Sazaki said.

A Tough Day for the Invaders...

Once again, the Breeders' Cup champs were stymied in Japan. **Johar** (Gone West), who shared the win in the Turf with High Chaparral (Ire), had trouble handling the heavy going and finished 16th. "He slipped at the five-eighths pole," jockey Alex Solis said. "It happened three or four times and from then on, he was afraid [to extend himself]." F/M Turf heroine **Islington (Ire)** (Sadler's Wells) fared slightly better, running ninth after pressing the pace early. "She was in good condition, but the going was too soft," jockey Kieren Fallon said. "She doesn't pick up on soft going." **Sarafan** (Lear Fan), the runner-up in last year's Japan Cup, settled in midfield early, but faded badly to be 17th. Jockey Victor Espinoza also blamed the soft turf for the poor showing. **Ange Gabriel (Fr)** (Kaldounevees {Fr}), the best-backed of the overseas contingent, was the third choice at 12-1. He rated in fifth early, but couldn't mount a late challenge and finished seventh. "The going was too soft and the pace was too fast," jockey Thierry Jarnet said. **Denon** (Pleasant Colony) was a half-length behind that rival in eighth. "I was able to settle him in good position, but he got tired in the homestretch," jockey Corey Nakatani said. G1 Cox Plate winner **Fields of Omagh (Aus)** (Rubiton {Aus}) broke well and sat fourth through the opening fractions, but had nothing left in the drive and finished last. "It was a very disappointing race," jockey Steven King said. "The turf was not what I expected and he couldn't show his true ability."

Third in the 10-furlong GI Flower Bowl Invitational at Belmont Sept. 27, Heat Haze encountered plenty of trouble last time in the GI Breeders' Cup Filly and Mare Turf, but closed well in the stretch to finish fourth behind winner Islington, beaten only 2 3/4 lengths. Last of 14 in the early going this time, the four-year-old had a tremendous amount of ground to make up and appeared destined for a less-than-stellar performance. That is to everyone except to her jockey John Velazquez. "We had a perfect trip," said Velazquez. "We had to come from last, but I just wanted to wait and bide my time to find room. Once she got through, she really punched hard." With plenty of energy in reserve, Heat Haze closed steadily from the inside leaving the second turn, cut down the leaders in deep stretch and pushed past the game Musical Chimes. "An absolutely perfect ride," said trainer Bobby Frankel, who collected his 25th Grade I title with the win. "If we had got into any kind of trouble we were beat, and coming from 14th to win, you've got to get really lucky."

A winner in the handicap ranks and second in the G2 Solario S. in his native England last year, Sweet Return won his fifth American start, the restricted Oceanside S. going a mile at Del Mar July 23. Fifth in the GIII La Jolla H. Aug. 16 and third in the GII Del Mar Derby Sept. 6, the chestnut found himself only a head shy of the win last time in the nine-furlong GII Oak Tree Derby Oct. 4. Overlooked at 16-1 here, Sweet Return performed more like the race favorite. Out front early, the Ronald McAnally trainee maintained a narrow advantage through early splits of :25.35, :51.04 and three quarters in 1:17.49. Challenged by GI Secretariat S. winner Kickin Kris through the final half mile, Sweet Return opened a 1 1/2-length advantage with a furlong left to run and held on gamely to gain a 1/2-length decision over another McAnally pupil Fairly Ransom, with 3-1 favorite Kickin Kris further back in third. "I told Julie [Krone] the main thing was to try and get him to relax," said McAnally. "She did what she felt was right and she was right." Krone dominated this year's Turf Festival with three of six races in the series, including Saturday's GII Citation H. winner Redattore (Brz) and GIII Generous S. hero Castledale (Ire). Absent from the lineup, Sigint (Wekiva Springs) was scratched Sunday morning by trainer Vladmir Cerin after the sophomore spiked a temperature. **Click for the [free brisnet.com catalogue-style pedigree](#) or the [brisnet.com chart](#).**

Quantity and Quality...

Voute Sales has much the biggest draft with 80 lots catalogued. They are consigning for a variety of clients, including Alec Wildenstein, whose offerings are headed by Lot 1605, Peinture Rose (Storm Cat), a half-sister to G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe winner Peintre Celebre (Nureyev). The filly gained black type after the catalogue's publication with a win in the Listed Prix Ceres at Saint-Cloud Nov. 1. Today's first big highlight looks set to be Lot 1567, last season's G1 Irish Oaks heroine Margarula (Ire) (Doyoun {Ire}) and the only mare offered with a Sadler's Wells cover. She is another in the Voute Sales draft. Lord and Lady Lloyd-Webber's Kiltinan Stud in Co Tipperary, which is offering the Wafic Said dispersal, has a strong consignment for a number of other clients including Lot 1903, Royal Show (Sadler's Wells), a sister to G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. winner King's Theatre (Ire) and the only lot in foal to Danzig. She was bought three years ago for 700,000gns by Shane Ryan's Kilboy Estate. The Lloyd-Webbers' own Crystal Melody (GB) (Nureyev), Lot 1900, will have plenty of fanciers as a sister to G1 Fillies' Mile winner Crystal Music (Nureyev) while Cam Allard's Juliette (Ire) (Sadler's Wells), Lot 1907, is a three-year-old filly with some smart form including a Listed success. Lot 2186, the four-year-old Ballade Russe (Gone West), is a half-sister to this year's G1 Sagitta 1000 Guineas heroine Russian Rhythm (Kingmambo) covered by Green Desert, while Lot 1630, Nyramba (GB) (Night Shift), a Listed-winning two-year-old, will be in demand as a racing prospect. "We believe it to be a strong catalogue and everybody else seems to agree with us," said Jimmy George, Tattersalls' marketing director. "Combine that with the great year we have had so far and we should be in for a good finale." The sale runs today through Thursday, starting at 9:30 a.m. each day.
