## TATTERSALLS ENDS RECORD RUN

The best ever December Sale finished in Newmarket last night, ending a year in which Tattersalls saw a 163,098,250gns annual turnover, beating last year's record by 21 percent. Yesterday's top lot was **Daprika (Fr)** (Epervier Bleu {GB}), a five-year-old half-sister to National Hunt performer Geos (Fr), offered in foal to King's Theatre (Ire) and bought for 80,000gns by Richard Aston to join the broodmare band at his top jumping farm, Goldford Stud in Cheshire. A total of 4,280 head were sold at Tattersalls this year for an average of 38,107gns, compared to 3,842 sold for a 35,055gns average in 2002. The December Sale, incorporating foals, breeding stock and yearlings, turned over 63,196,150gns for 1,698 sold at an average of 37,217gns. The aggregate was up 16 percent, while the 17,000gns median rose by 13 percent. "After a year in which every sale at Park Paddocks has registered significant increases, often across the board, we could do little other than express our delight," said Tattersalls chairman Edmond Mahony. "The December Sale has brought the year to a wonderful conclusion with records for yearlings, foals and breeding stock. Obviously the two dispersals from Wafic Said's Addison Racing and the late Prince Fahd Salman's Newgate Stud will be remembered for a long time, and Ramruma's new European record for a mare of 2,100,000 guineas stands out, but from our perspective the unrelenting demand from lot one to lot 2681 has been the feature which has given the most satisfaction. Looking ahead, we felt that the sheer numbers in the foal catalogue placed a strain on the stabling, which impacted on the purchasers and vendors, and we will be looking at the format for next year's December Foal Sale to try to accommodate all parties as best as possible." Mahony was pleased with the overall year at Tattersalls. "The fact that the median has risen at every Tattersalls sale this year, except July which had a record average, illustrates the phenomenal depth to the market, not just at the more rarefied levels, but from top to bottom. Even the smallest rise in the median at our four yearling sales this year was 16 percent with the largest an extraordinary 56 percent, and no doubt these figures will prove to be influential when breeders come to make their plans for 2004." **Statistics, p2**

## MILLION-DOLLAR JACKPOT

Delta Downs has drawn a field of 10 two-year-olds for the second running of the \$1-million Delta Jackpot. The second choice on the morning line is the undefeated **Judiths Wild Rush** (Wild Rush), who ships in from Woodbine on the strength of a 10-length win in the Display S. Nov. 15, when he earned a 103 Beyer. "You never know what you're going to hook," said regular rider Dino Luciani, "but if he can handle the tighter turns, he'll run a really good race. He's a serious racehorse. He's still a little green, but every time I put a leg over him, I find something else that impresses me." The grey colt is a finalist for Canada's Sovereign Awards, which will be announced Saturday. Louisiana-based **Joe Six Pack** (Silver Deputy), another unbeaten youngster, dispensed of GIII Kentucky Cup Juvenile winner **Mr. Jester** (Silver Deputy) in winning the Jean Lafitte S. Nov. 8 going a mile over this surface. Breaking from the rail will be **America America** (Mister Baileys {GB}), who will make her 17th start of the year. The chestnut, multiple stakes-placed in England and Canada, earned her first stakes victory last out by defeating the boys in the Houston Texan Juvenile S. Nov. 15.

**ANGE GABRIEL TO HARAS DU MESNIL** The five-year-old **Ange Gabriel (Fr)** (Kaldounevees {Fr}--Mount Gable {GB}, by Head for Heights {GB}), who earned over \$2 million on the international stage while racing for owner/breeder Mme. Henri Devin, has been retired and will enter stud in 2004 at France's Haras du Mesnil for a fee of €6,000. In 2002, the grey captured the G1 Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud and concluded the year with a victory in the G1 Hong Kong Vase. After beginning 2003 with a runner-up finish Sulamani (Ire) in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic, he rattled off three straight wins, including a defeat of Sulamani when defending his title in the Grand Prix de Saint-Cloud. He concluded his career with seventh-place finish in testing conditions in the G1 Japan Cup last Sunday. Ange Gabriel earned \$2,160,671 while compiling a record of 21-12-3-2.

Plucked by current connections for that lofty tag in a fourth-place effort at the Spa Aug. 8, the chestnut set the pace after being bumped at the start in his next and wound up a game second sprinting seven panels in an open allowance test at Belmont Oct. 9. Sent off the 3-2 second pick against the classy Peeping Tom in a Meadowlands allowance event Nov. 1, he could do no better than fourth, beaten three lengths. Here, Kazoo was sent to the fore under jockey Richard Migliore and battled round the turn with Final Table (Allen's Prospect). Shaking loose of that foe turning for home, he ran on well in the latter stages and was never seriously threatened by the closing Super Fuse.
