BAYBERRY TOPS DEAUVILLE OPENER

Bayberry (UAE) (Bering {GB}--Baya, by Nureyev), a three-year-old filly from the family of the illustrious runners Trillion and Triptych and of blue hen mare Doff the Derby, brought a final bid of €230,000 to top the opening session of the L'Agence Francaise December Mixed Sale in Deauville yesterday. Consigned by Darley, the chestnut was purchased by Alexandra Scrope, agent for Brookdale owner Fred Seitz. Bayberry, once a winner in seven career starts, is a daughter of Group 3 winner Baya, who finished second in the G1 Prix de Diane in 1993. Her third dam is G1 Prix Ganay heroine Trillion, a seven-time Group winner who finished runner-up in the G1 Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe, G1 Prix de Diane, G1 Washington D.C. International, G1 Turf Classic and G1 Canadian International Championship S. She produced Classic and nine-time Group 1 winner Triptych, who beat the boys no less than five times at the highest level as a five-year-old. Attracting the second-highest bid on the day was the eight-year-old broodmare **Context (GB)** (Zafonic--Twixt {GB}, by Kings Lake), who sold for €140,000 to Mme. P. Menard, agent for SCEA des Bissons. Context's first two foals are both winners, including a two-year-old of 2003. Consigned by Haras du Hoguenet, she is in foal to the young stallion Enrique (GB) (Barathea {Ire}). The seven-year-old sire won the G3 Greenham S. and was second in both the G1 Sagitta 2000 Guineas and the G1 Irish 2000 Guineas. He entered stud at Haras d'Etreham in 2001; his first foals are yearlings. The December Mixed Sale continues with the second of three sessions today. ON THE ATTACK

Political Attack (Hawk Attack), winner of the Oct. 18 Sussex H. at Delaware Park last time out, made it two in a row with a decisive 1 1/2-length tally in the GIII Tropical Park H. at Calder yesterday. It was the third Calder stakes success for the four-year-old, who took the Mecke S. at two and the GIII Tropical Park Derby last season. Off the board in a trio of Grade II events following a win in the GIII Canadian Turf H. at Gulfstream Park in March, the bay got back on track as the even-money chalk against softer in the Sussex. A 6-1 chance after the return to Florida, he kept the leaders in his sights from the start, put a head in front at midstretch and edged clear late.

Danehill Filly Tops Weanlings...

A filly from the penultimate crop by the ill-fated supersire Danehill topped the weanlings at yesterday's opener in Deauville. Consigned by Haras d'Etream, the bay was purchased for €125,000 by Pegasus Farms. The first foal from the Sadler's Wells mare Embroider (Ire), she is from the family of champion Waya (Fr) and millionaire Luthier Fever. Her dam, also consigned by Haras d'Etream, sold for €55,000 later in the session. In foal to Anabaa Blue (Fr), she was bought by Mme. P Menard, agent for SCEA des Bissons. The top-selling colt yesterday was a son of Anabaa out of Streamlined (GB) (Priolo). Consigned by Haras de la Louviere, he sold for €50,000 to Peter Doyle Bloodstock. His family also produced the prolific broodmare Coup de Folie, dam of G1SW Coup de Genie and Group 1-winning sires Machiavellian and Exit to Nowhere.

 Olmodavor became A.P. Indy's latest graded-stakes winner with this last-to-first victory. The bay had shown signs of good things to come at the beginning of the year, running second to Medaglia d'Oro in the Feb. 1 GII Strub S. at Santa Anita and to Mineshaft in the Mar. 2 GII New Orleans H. at Fair Grounds. But the Wertheimer homebred disappeared after that effort, resurfacing to be fifth in an optional claimer going 6 1/2 furlongs at Santa Anita Oct. 26. Racing without blinkers for the first time here, he trailed the field as Total Impact (Chi) (Stuka) chased Nose The Trade through the opening fractions. Nose The Trade opened up daylight as they raced down the lane, but began to shorten stride in the final furlong and Olmodavor came at him, finally getting to the pacesetter in the closing yards to earn his first black-type score as the crowd's choice. "He had run second to two great horses and we expected a lot of him," jockey Alex Solis said. "He came out of the gate real relaxed...and everything worked out great. Next year, I think we are going to see good things out of him." **Click for the [brisnet.com chart](#).**

Fifth in this race last year, New Economy came back to take the Dec. 28 GII La Prevoyante H. as a 22-1 outsider. But the bay was off the board vs. Grade III foes at Gulfstream Park and Keeneland in her first two starts of 2003 and was given a five-month vacation. She returned to be third, 8 1/2 lengths behind Bien Nicole, in the Oct. 5 GII WinStar Galaxy S. in Lexington, but didn't fire over a rain-soaked Woodbine turf last out, finishing eighth in the Oct. 19 GI E.P. Taylor S. "I kind of rushed her to get to the race in Canada and then it came up soft, which she doesn't handle," explained trainer Graham Motion. Rated off an honest pace yesterday as Ivanavalot took them along in her turf debut, New Economy came three wide into the stretch, collared the front runner and outfinished favored Something Ventured for the narrow score. "She's actually quite consistent when she has a good pace in front of her and firm ground, which she had today," Motion said. As for what's next, he added, "We'll go on and try to win the [Dec. 27] La Prevoyante again. A decision will be made at some point after that whether to retire her in the spring or go on with her. [Owner Robert Evans] is a breeders and, obviously, she is a valuable broodmare."

First or second in all five previous tries, Mr. Jester took the Aug. 10 Pioneer S. going 5 1/2 furlongs at Louisiana Downs, then shipped to Turfway Park and was let go at 20-1 trying two turns for the first time in the Sept. 13 Gill Kentucky Cup Juvenile. Beaten a nose by Pomeroy in the race, with promising The Cliff's Edge another 1 1/4 lengths back in third, the dark bay was moved up to first by the stewards after being carried wide by the original winner during the stretch drive. He came back to be second in the Nov. 8 Jean Lafitte Futurity at this track. Let go at double-digit odds once again, Mr. Jester settled just off the pace set by Cooperation (Halo's Image). He took over as they raced into the lane and responded to urging to hold off Fire Slam for the victory. The 17-10 favorite, previously undefeated Canadian shipper Judiths Wild Rush (Wild Rush), was in the middle of the pack early, but shifted it into reverse on the far turn and finished ninth.

Shipping in from California, Salty Romance had no trouble living up to her favored status as she handled the rise to stakes company with aplomb. The bay debuted on the eve of the Breeders' Cup, finishing third as the even-money favorite at Santa Anita. She dispensed of her maiden with a facile, 4 1/2-length win at Hollywood Nov. 15, leading every step while stopping the clock in 1:09 2/5. The Delta crowd was not concerned that Salty Romance had never been two turns, sending her postward at even-money. Breaking alertly, the Flying Zee colorbearer went up to set the pace, leading by a measured length through three-quarters in 1:11.71. Jockey Mike Smith asked for a bit more in the stretch and Salty Romance responded, opening up to win by daylight under a vigorous hand ride. "She's got a great future ahead of her," said Smith. Texas shipper Questionable Past, riding a four-race winning streak, gave chase in the stretch before settling for second.

After breaking her maiden Oct. 18, she displayed good acceleration to take the G3 Fantasy S. Nov. 9. "She is eating up very well," said trainer Sakae Watanabe, who will retire in February. "I look forward to her race." **Fille de Reve** captured the G3 Hakodate Nisai S. in her second start back in August, but didn't race again until the Fantasy, finishing a close fifth to Sweet Tosho. "She is in good form," said trainer Kenji Yamauchi.

Adoration makes her first appearance since posting the 40-1 upset in the Oct. 25 GI Breeders' Cup Distaff. The four-year-old filly, a troubled fourth in the Sept. 28 GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H. in her prep for the World Thoroughbred Championships, won her only other start on the Hollywood Park main track, taking the GII Hollywood Breeders' Cup Oaks last season. "She is really doing well since the Breeders' Cup," trainer David Hofmans said. The bay worked sharply for the race, going six furlongs in 1:12 3/5 at Santa Anita Nov. 27. Adoration, who will remain in training next year, may not face Grade I company this afternoon, but the race is not an easy spot. Also in the field is the talented **Bare Necessities**, a winner in four of her last five starts. Two-for-four at Hollywood and four-for-six at the Bayakoa distance, the four-year-old had a winning streak halted at three when she faced champion Azeri in the June 21 GI Vanity H. at the Inglewood oval, finishing third. Freshened after that effort, she has started just once since, taking the Aug. 9 GIII Gardenia H. at Ellis Park. The original plan was to retire her after that race, but the gray has more racing ahead of her. "Her owner, George Middleton, who runs Iron County Farms, lives in Arcadia, Missouri, and shipped her to his farm after the race," trainer Wally Dollase said. "He thought she had done enough and planned to retire her before a breeding to Giant's Causeway next year. He apparently changed his mind and contacted me in September after the filly had been there a month. He decided to put her back in training and try to reach the \$1-million mark this year and next." Bare Necessities has earned \$715,281 to date.
