FULL CUP FOR FALBRAV?

The globetrotting **Falbrav (Ire)** (Fairy King) will be favored to conclude his career on a high note in today's G1 Hong Kong Cup before heading off to stud in Japan. Hero of last year's G1 Japan Cup, the bay was honored with a Cartier Award as top older horse for a European campaign which included victories in the G1 Coral-

Eclipse S., the G1 Juddmonte International and the G1 Queen Elizabeth II S. In his most recent start, Falbrav came up a head short when third in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf Oct. 25 at Santa Anita. But this certainly is no walkover for Falbrav. He'll have to deny fellow British shipper **Rakti (GB)** (Polish Precedent), the

G1 Champion S. victor; **Eishin Preston** (Green Dancer), the well-travelled Japanese representative; defending champion **Precision (Fr)** (Anabaa); and local star **Elegant Fashion (Aus)** (Danewin {Aus}), who captured the G1-HK Hong Kong Derby in March and is coming off a victory in the G2-HK International Cup Trial over course and distance Nov. 15.

THE BIG GORILLA OF BUENOS AIRES

Brazilian invader **Gorylla (Brz)** (New Colony), let go at 16-1, triumphed over his more heralded rivals to win the G1 Gran Premio Internacional Carlos Pellegrini at Hipodromo San Isidro yesterday in Buenos Aires, Argentina. The consistent six-year-old hadn't been out of the money in four starts this campaign, winning the G2 GP Antonio da Silva Prado Oct. 5 before finishing third in the G1 GP ABCPCC-Matias Machline Oct. 25. Both of those starts, contested at Sao Paulo's Cidade Jardim racecourse, came over today's 2400-meter distance. An objection against the winner by the runner-up, **Lancettier (Arg)** (Numerous), was not allowed by the stewards.

Thunder Blitz made the most of a nine-pound advantage from favored Evening Attire to post his first victory since April. Hero of the 2001 GIII Flamingo S. and later fourth in the GI Kentucky Derby when conditioned by Joe Orseno, the grey was transferred to Bobby Frankel for 2003. He triumphed by six lengths in an allowance over the Aqueduct main track Apr. 12, but couldn't break through the next condition level in four starts from July to October at Belmont and Saratoga. Following another barn change to Richard Dutrow, Jr., Thunder Blitz just failed to reel in the free-running Presidentialaffair in the GIII Stuyvesant H. Nov. 11 over the Big A main track, missing by a neck. Never far from the front in this contest, the Stronach colorbearer got the jump on his rivals turning for home and became brave on the lead en route to a clear victory. "It wasn't anything that I did," said Dutrow. "I talk to Bobby every couple of days and I follow his instructions. The Stronachs and Bobby left him here with me hoping he'd like the inner track, and obviously he does."

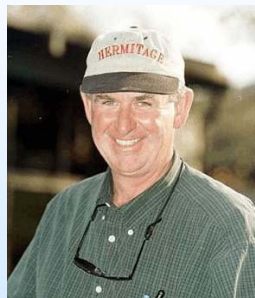

Barbara O'Brien took Philly Park's Steve Van Buren H. Sept. 1, then turned in a second-place finish over this course in the U Can Do It H. Oct. 4. When the consistent filly was stretched to 1 1/16 miles for her latest try, the restricted Elmer Heubeck Distaff H. at Calder Nov. 15, she threw in a rare clunker and finished seventh. Cut back in distance here, she sat right off the early leader, rallied on the far turn and drew off to post a comfortable victory despite having some issues prior to the race. "She reared up and flipped back while she was being saddled on the dirt path leading up to the paddock," explained winning trainer Harry Benson. "She's as bad and goofy as they come, although she stands in the stall and trains just lovely, but as soon as you put that bridle on her, she just has an aversion to it. The two times she's been really bad, though, she has won. We'll keep her sprinting."

 Impulse purchase Second of June became a stakes winner for the Cesare family by turning the tables on Grade I winner Silver Wagon. After winning his debut here at Calder Aug. 9, the dark bay ran sixth in the one-mile Seacliff S. Aug. 30, but rebounded to be the runner-up by 3/4 of a length in the Foolish Pleasure S. Sept. 20 and followed that up with an allowance victory Nov. 3. Breaking alertly, the Florida-bred had a stalking trip before moving quickly to the front with a three-wide move on the far turn. Jockey Cornelio Velasquez gave him a tap and Second of June responded, drawing off to win by five. "The only reason I bought him was he was born on my birthday [June 2], no other reason," admitted winning trainer Bill Cesare. "He was a good-looking horse but crooked legged, but that doesn't keep him from being a runner." Cesare indicated that his charge would target Gulfstream's main races for three-year-olds this winter. As for Silver Wagon, off since his triumph in the G1 Hopeful S. Aug. 30, the grey came up a bit short over the testing track at Calder. "He got extremely tired," explained jockey Jerry Bailey. Defending champion **Olympic Express** returned from his summer vacation to run up the track in a pair of 1000-meter contests won by Silent Witness, the strong favorite in the Sprint earlier on the card. He will have to improve on those outings to deny a tough trio of Japanese invaders in **Admire Max**, **Lohengrin** and **Telegnosis**. The latter pair displayed very good form when sent to France in late summer: Lohengrin missed by a half length in the G1 Prix du Moulin Sept. 7, while Telegnosis ran a close third, beaten a length, by subsequent Breeders' Mile heroine Six Perfections (Fr) in the G1 Prix Jacques le Marois Aug. 17. The lightly raced Admire Max, runner-up to Agnes Digital in the G1 Yasuda Kinen to start the year, is coming off a very good third, beaten 1 1/4 lengths, in the G1-Jpn Sprinters S. Oct. 5.

Warrsan, a half brother to 1996 and 1997 Hong Kong Vase winner Luso (GB), has had an outstanding five-year-old season, with three wins and just one off-the-board finish from his eight trips to the post. A homebred for Saeed Manana, the bay defeated Highest (Ire) by a half length to register his first Group 1 success in the Coronation Cup June 6, but has been winless in four starts since, including a third-place effort behind 2001 Vase runner-up Ekraar and **Maktub** in the Oct. 19 G1 Gran Premio del Jockey Club in Milan. He blew out 400 meters on the turf in :23.5 Friday morning and breaks from the inside gate. "Barrier one suits us," said trainer Clive Brittain, who also conditioned Luso. "He can go forward, he can drop in. The horse is well and his trainer is fit as a trout and twice as slippery." The bay comes in off a close fourth in the G1 Prix de l'Abbaye, where he had **The Trader** and **The Tatling** just ahead of him. He will be better suited by faster ground today.

Fellow jockey David Nuesch, who was aboard the ill-fated Skidoo, was able to walk into the ambulance under his own power and appeared to escape serious injury.
