LION'S SHARE OF THE ATTENTION

Unbeaten **Lion Heart** (Tale of the Cat), set to go postward at odds-on in today's GI Hollywood Futurity, could garner support for an Eclipse Award as the nation's top two-year-old colt if he can capture this contest. Following a solid winning performance in his Oct. 24 career debut, the chestnut dominated his rivals in

the GIII Hollywood Prevue S. Nov. 15, winning by six lengths while posting a 103 Beyer Speed Figure. He ran seven furlongs in 1:20 3/5 that day, clipping a tick off the stakes record set nine years ago by Afternoon Deelites, whose career is eerily similar to that of Lion Heart. Afternoon Deelites, a debut winner in October,

followed up his Prevue score with a six-length Futurity success while equalling the stakes record of 1:40 3/5. Can Lion Heart also handle the two-turn question? "If he stays a mile and a sixteenth, he should be two-year-old of the year," asserted trainer Patrick Biancone. "If he runs like he did in the Prevue, he should get the championship. This generation needs a real leader." **Saint Afleet** (Northern Afleet) will get another crack at Lion Heart. Following a troubled ninth to the favorite in their Oct. 24 debut, the Florida-bred broke his maiden Nov. 16 and followed that up with an optional-claiming win Dec. 7. His owner, Ron Waranch, is unbeaten with three starters at the current Hollywood meet. Longshot **Quiet Cash** (Real Quiet) is from the first crop of the '98 Hollywood Futurity hero. "He looks like Real Quiet, but he's proven himself more on turf," trainer Bob Baffert said of the colt who broke his maiden on Hollywood grass course Nov. 26. "The field was coming up short, and I know he can get the distance."

Moscow Burning has been nearly unstoppable since switching to the turf, winning four of her five starts and missing by a half-length in the other. The versatile three-year-old will get a class test today, but she defeated open allowance foes in a sprint down the hill at Santa Anita Oct. 25 before handling her elders in the Cal Cup Distaff H. over 10 furlongs Nov. 8. Trainer Bobby Frankel will send out an entry for owner Ed Gann, **Betty's Wish** and **Personal Legend**. The former is riding a four-race winning streak in New York, including the GIII Pebbles H. Oct. 13, and will venture West for the first time. Personal Legend had run into traffic problems in several stakes events, but captured a local allowance at 2-5 Nov. 15 and should continue to improve.

NATIONAL CURRENCY TO BE SOLD South African sprint star **National Currency (SAf)** (National Assembly), runner-up to undefeated Silent Witness (Aus) in the G1 Hong Kong Sprint Dec. 14, is on the verge of being sold to Hong Kong property tycoon Robert Ng Chee Siong, according to the *South China Morning Post*. The deal is reportedly worth HK\$10 million (nearly \$1.3 million) and has already been concluded, pending a veterinary inspection, according to Hong Kong Jockey Club Director of Racing Winfried Engelbrecht-Bresges. "It's wonderful to see Hong Kong owners, perhaps inspired by the success of our horses in international races, prepared to invest such significant sums on quality horses," Engelbrecht-Bresges told the *Post*. National Currency, who flew to Dubai following his Hong Kong effort, will race in the G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen at Nad al Sheba Mar. 27 and could make an appearance at Royal Ascot in June. Ng would be part of the ownership for those races before National Currency returns to Hong Kong to continue his career. Ng is no stranger to private purchases, having spent \$1 million to acquire Daliapour (Ire) shortly before he went on to win the 2000 renewal of the G1 Hong Kong Vase.

OLD DEUTERONOMY IN THE NEW WORLD The two-year-old colt **Old Deuteronomy** (Storm Cat), who had campaigned in Europe for owner Mrs. John Magnier and trainer Aidan O'Brien, has been sold for an undisclosed purchase price to a new racing partnership and will be trained by Niall O'Callaghan. The deal was brokered by Andy Smith of Havana Horse (UK). According to Smith, the colt from the family of leading sire Rainbow Quest is currently in quarantine at Belmont and is scheduled to be entered in a six-furlong overnight stakes race at Aqueduct Dec. 26. After breaking his maiden first out at Newmarket in May, Old Deuteronomy posted seconds in both the G1 Phoenix S. to vaunted stablemate One Cool Cat and the G2 Richmond S. In his two most recent starts, he ran fourth in the G1 Prix Morny at Deauville Aug. 31 and seventh, beaten 3 1/4 lengths, in the G1 Middle Park S. Oct. 3. "He is by Storm Cat, out of a Seeking the Gold mare, so he could turn out to be anything," said Smith. "He has already done enough to become a stallion, so anything he does in the future is a bonus."

Man From Wicklow Back for McKnight?

Man From Wicklow (Turkoman), who hasn't raced since April, could make it back to defend his title in next Saturday's Gill W.L. McKnight H., according to owner/trainer Rick Violette Jr. "It's a lot to ask to go a mile and a half off that kind of layoff," acknowledged Violette. "He's doing great and he'll give his best the first time back, but I don't want to knock him out for another three months. The alternative would be to wait for the Sunshine Millions at a mile and an eighth at Gulfstream [Jan. 24]." Following his win in the McKnight a year ago, the six-year-old captured the GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. prior to finishing second in both the GII Pan American H. and the GIII Elkhorn H. at Keeneland Apr. 23. "We stopped on him after the race at Keeneland when he showed some signs he might be straining XYZ ligaments," Violette explained. "That's in an area [behind the knee] you have to be careful with. He's been too good to us not to give him all the time it takes."



Mazella, swift and talented 2-year-old filly of 2003 from Mazel Trick's first crop, got to the front early, was never threatened and drew away to win by three in 1:09 4/5 over a top field of maidens at Hollywood December 14.

Trainer Rick Violette is pointing his Derby hopeful, **Read the Footnotes** (Smoke Glacken), towards Gulfstream's major three-year-old events. The two-year-old has captured the GIII Nashua S. and the GII Remsen S. in succession. "I gave him a couple of weeks off, but now he's jogging," said Violette. "There's only so much time. He'll go into serious training the first of the year, and maybe make the Fountain of Youth [GII, Gulfstream, Feb. 14]." A \$320,000 purchase at Fasig-Tipton's Timonium sale last spring, the bay is a son of champion sprinter Smoke Glacken, but gets a healthy dose of stamina on the bottom side from broodmare sire Al Nasr (Fr) and from *Vaguely Noble, the sire of his second dam.

SATURN MAKES HONG KONG DEBUT

Saturn (Ire) (Marju {Ire}) makes his Hong Kong debut in this afternoon's Pok Oi Cup H., a Class 1 event over 1000 meters at Sha Tin Racecourse. Bred by Alan Dargan and purchased for Ir£100,000 at the 2001 Goffs Orby sale, the three-year-old gave an excellent account of himself in a pair of Classics earlier this spring, finishing fifth and fourth in the G1 English and Irish 2000 Guineas, respectively. A midpack seventh in the seven-furlong G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot June 18, he proved he could handle a distance of ground when a short-head second to Kalabar (GB) in the G2 Prix Guillaume d'Ornano over 10 panels at Deauville Aug. 15. Previously owned by Highclere Thoroughbred Racing, the gelding was sold in early September. He will race in the colors of Alan Li and is trained by Ivan Allan in the SAR. Saturn, who barrier-ried :59.8 Wednesday, has a long-term goal of the HK-G1 Hong Kong Derby in March.

JOCKEYS QUIT HONG KONG

The Hong Kong Jockey Club's Licensing Committee has agreed to release jockeys Jamie Spencer, Steve Drowne, Martin Dwyer and Weichong Marwing from their respective riding contracts. Spencer told the Club that since accepting his contract to ride he has been appointed as the retained rider of Aidan O'Brien in Ireland next season. Although he decided to honour his commitment to ride in Hong Kong, Spencer was unaware of the considerable preparation that has to be undertaken, including the task of relocating from England to Ireland. Drowne, Dwyer and Marwing all cited personal reasons for wishing to be released and will fulfil riding arrangements for the final time at today's meeting at Sha Tin. As an interim measure, the Jockey Club have granted a licence to Victoria-based Australian Kerrin McEvoy for the period Dec. 27 through Feb. 2.
