L.A. FASHION Everest Stables' **Island Fashion** (Petionville) staked her claim for an Eclipse Award with a breathless victory in the GI La Brea S. at Santa Anita yesterday afternoon. That win, accomplished in 1:21 4/5 for seven furlongs, accompanies her trophy in the 10-furlong GI Alabama S. at Saratoga in August and a 3/4-length loss to older fillies on the turf in the GI Matricarch S. at Hollywood a month ago. "She is a super filly," said winning rider Kent Desormeaux. "She grilled a nice bunch of horses today. I expect her to come back strong." After drawing the outside, Island Fashion and Desormeaux had no choice but to chase the leaders early, tackling East Coast shipper **Randaroo** (Gold Case) through a half in :45.51. Island Fashion had her mind on running and really opened up when asked for more by Desormeaux, striding home clear by six lengths. "I had no idea how much speed she was going to have," Desormeaux explained. "I left the gate very aggressively and wanted to see where I could put her. At the quarter pole I let up on her and she finished easily. She was that good today, an absolute armchair ride."

VOLGA SAILS HOME IN LA PREVOYANTE Joe Allen's **Volga (Ire)** (Caerleon) concluded her most successful campaign to date with an authoritative score in the GII La Prevoyante H. yesterday at Calder. The five-year-old opened the year with a victory in the GIII Matchmaker H. Aug. 17 before losing her next two.

Switched to Kieran McLaughlin, she annexed the GI E.P. Taylor S. Oct. 19 and was the runner-up to **Spice Island** (Tabasco Cat) in the GII Long Island H. Nov. 15. The half sister to Hong Kong heroine Vallee Enchantee (Ire) settled into a ground-saving position not far from the front and was in prime striking position turning for home. Jockey Richie Migliore pressed the button and Volga responded, taking command and striding home impressively. So what's the next step? "She's a Grade I winner turning six and you would naturally consider breeding her, but I haven't made that decision yet," said Allen. "We'll give it some more consideration whether to breed her or race another year." Spice Island clipped heels and fell on the far turn, but neither she nor jockey Cornelio Velasquez was hurt. **Chart. p3**

ALL BALTO STAR, ALL THE TIME In a familiar story, **Balto Star** (Glitterman) found himself alone on the lead and swept to another victory in yesterday's GII W.L. McKnight H. at Calder. The five-year-old captured the GI United Nations H. in July, but couldn't work out

favorable pace scenarios in his next four, winding up ninth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf to complete that sequence. He rebounded to wire the GII Red Smith H. at Aqueduct Nov. 22 and was the 2-1 favorite to mirror that effort. With the scratch of fellow pacesetter **Gran Cesare (Arg)** (Roar), Balto Star cruised along on the front end early, but picked up the pace markedly thereafter, covering his final quarter in :23 4/5. "I tried to slow it down the first part of the race," said winning rider John Velazquez. "He gets brave...when he gets loose on the lead like that. When we turned for home...it was too late [for anybody else]." **Chart. p3**

In Her Own Fashion... Island Fashion has had an eclectic three-year-old campaign, to say the least. After running fourth in her debut in the Arizona Oaks at Turf Paradise Feb. 1, the grey missed by a nose in a local maiden going 6 1/2 furlongs Mar. 5, then shipped to Sunland Park and graduated in the WinStar Oaks Mar. 29. That effort saw her take on the best of her generation in the GI Kentucky Oaks, but she weakened to be seventh and was given some time off. In her final start for Nick Canani, she rolled home by 6 1/2 lengths in the GIII Delaware Oaks July 19, then was turned over to Barclay Tagg, who sent her out to a six-length romp in the \$750,000 GI Alabama S. Aug. 16. Finishing behind her that day were division heavyweights Bird Town, Spoken Fur and Awesome Humor. But things went south for Island Fashion thereafter as she rounded out her New York campaign with a fourth in the GI Gazelle H. and a sixth in the GI Beldame H. Returning to California to the barn of Marcelo Polanco, the rangy filly rallied five wide from way out of it to be a close fourth in her turf debut, missing by just 3/4 of a length to winner and Eclipse hopeful Heat Haze (GB) in the GI Matriarch Nov. 30. The \$150,000 winner's share of the La Brea purse took Island Fashion's career bankroll over \$1 million, and marks the first Grade I win for Polanco as a trainer. "The filly was awesome," said the 43-year-old Chilean native. "If she's OK, we'll plan to go in the La Canada [GII, Feb. 14]." Island Fashion carries the black and red colors of Everest Stables, the nom de course of Jeff Nielson. The Minnesota native also raced Island Fashion's sire Petionville, who captured the GII Ohio Derby, GIII Louisiana Derby and GIII La Jolla H. as a three-year-old in 1995. Petionville stands at Crestwood Farm in Lexington, Kentucky. His stud fee is \$10,000.

Where's the Luv? The 6-5 favorite **Elloluv** (Gilded Time) never factored in this 10-horse contest, finishing a disinterested sixth after racing in tight quarters approaching the turn. "She was not herself today," said jockey Corey Nakatani. "She was a little dull. I don't know if she's getting sick, or what."

Despite a solid record of 3-2-1-0 over the Calder main track, Predawn Raid was overlooked at the windows, but disproved his doubters with another daylight victory over this surface. The grey romped by 16 1/2 lengths in an off-the-turf maiden here last November and followed that up with a pair of decent efforts at Gulfstream, but found himself sidelined for six months. After a seventh on the Calder turf Oct. 6, he won a \$16,000 optional claimer by 6 1/2 lengths on the main track Nov. 3, then ran eighth in an allowance over the turf last out Nov. 28. Trying graded competition here, the longshot was allowed an uncontested early lead, set fractions of :24 and :49 1/5 and increased his advantage to the wire while under a hand ride. "To tell you the truth, I tried to talk Brian [owner/breeder Burns] out of running in this spot," admitted winning trainer Ben Stutts, Jr. "I'm conservative by nature and had a 'two other than' allowance picked out. [But] Brian said go for it. I'm 65 and this is the biggest race I've ever won. We'll see what's next. He'd be real tough in a 'three other than.'" Predawn Raid is a half brother to 2002 GII Knickerbocker H. winner Dawn of the Condor.

Symboli Kris S., who defeated **Tap Dance City** by a half length in this event last year, is back for a title defense and could crack the \$8-million mark in career earnings with a repeat score. The four-year-old, making just his fourth start of the year this afternoon, was fifth in the Jpn-G1 Takarazuka Kinen off a six-month absence June 29 before registering an unprecedented second straight success in the Jpn-G1 Tenno Sho Nov. 2. The dark bay comes into this off a distant third-place finish behind Tap Dance City in the Nov. 30 G1 Japan Cup. Three-year-old **That's The Plenty** bested **Lincoln** by three-parts of a length in the Jpn-G1 Japanese St Leger Oct. 26 before finishing runner-up in the Japan Cup. **Active Bio** took the G2-Jpn Copa Republica Argentina over this distance Nov. 9 and was fifth in the Japan Cup, beaten just over two lengths for third at 122-1.

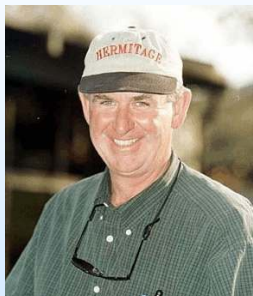

Redattore, still going strong at age eight, could be making his final racetrack appearance this afternoon. The bay has had yet another successful campaign this year, winning California's two most important races over a mile, the GI Frank E. Kilroe H. over this course in March and the GI Shoemaker Breeders' Cup Mile across town in May. However, he is equally effective up to nine furlongs and comes into this effort off a 3/4-length victory in the 8 1/2-furlong GII Citation H. at Hollywood Nov. 29. Were it not for a disqualification, **Denied** would be perfect in five starts on the turf. Demoted from a win at Del Mar Aug. 18, the bay gelding was second in the Hinds Pomona Invitational H. at the Fairplex Sept. 28 before taking a one-mile test over this grass course Oct. 29. **Trial By Jury**, a half brother to successful California turfer Worldly Ways (GB), has not missed the trifecta in six turf efforts and defeated **Maranilla** by a half length over track and trip Nov. 7.

FASLIYEV EQUALS END SWEEP'S RECORD

Freshman sire **Fasliyev** (Nureyev), who stands at Ireland's Coolmore Stud, equalled a Northern Hemisphere record of 34 two-year-old winners, which had been set by End Sweep in 1998. Fasliyev's record-equalling winner was Cupola (GB), who broke his maiden Friday at Jebel Ali in the United Arab Emirates. Now six, Fasliyev was Europe's champion two-year-old of 1999, when he went unbeaten in five starts before sustaining an injury. Among his top runners in 2003 are unbeaten
