Icantgoforthat (In Excess {Ire}), who started the year with a front-running win in the 5 1/2-furlong Survive S. on the dirt at Santa Anita, was blanked in her next 10 appearances, but turned the campaign around in her 2003 finale. On the lead as soon as the gates opened, the Cal-bred bay set serious fractions and still had enough left to take yesterday's GIII Monrovia H. by a nose over 1-2 **Polygreen (Fr)** (Green Tune). "[Polygreen] did get in front of me [in the stretch], but my horse was all heart," jockey Tyler Baze said. "She just laid it down and got there." The four-year-old has come along way since her days in the claiming ranks. Despite being held winless in 10 straight, she did manage to hit the board five times, including a second to Heat Haze in the GIII Las Cienagas H. in April and a third in the GIII Sen. K. Maddy H. in October, and was coming off a fourth in the Cal Cup Distaff H. over this course and distance Nov. 8. "I claimer her for \$50,000 and she's just done unbelievable," trainer Steve Knapp, celebrating his first graded-stakes win, said. "We plan to run next in the Sunshine Millions [Filly and Mare Sprint, Jan. 24]."

"He's the kind of horse that goes along with the program as far as us giving him a little break. I was afraid he'd get so strong and tough that it would be impossible for us to back down on him, but it's worked out pretty well. He

just kind of maintains his normal level of intensity without going overboard. I think he's going to get a lot from this rest. We've got a big campaign for next year, so I think this will be a good springboard."

Azeri Jogs at Santa Anita

Horse of the Year **Azeri** (Jade Hunter) arrived at trainer D. Wayne Lukas' Santa Anita barn Sunday and the Hall of Famer sent her out for a light jog Monday morning. According to Lukas, the five-year-old may try for a repeat win in the GI Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn Park and appears likely to face colts later on in the year.

Next Start May be on the Dirt for Redattore

According to trainer Richard Mandella, turf specialist **Redattore (Brz)** (Roi Normand) could make his next start on the dirt in the GII San Antonio H. Jan. 31. The Brazilian-bred proved that the dirt is not problem when he won the nine-furlong event in 2002. "He can go either way, but the main goal would be the [GII Frank E. Kilroe Mile on the turf Mar. 6]," Mandella said.

Adminniestrator Takes Another Shot in SM Turf

Adminniestrator (Incinderator) will attempt to defend his title in the Sunshine Millions Turf, which will be held at Santa Anita Park Jan. 24. According to trainer Paddy Gallagher, the roan will get one more race before he tries for a repeat win in the nine-furlong event.

Back in the mid-nineties, Arthur Appleton had good cause to become an admirer of Halo's sons. Appleton's homebred Jolie's Halo retired to his Bridlewood Farm in Florida and sired the Florida Derby winner Hal's Hope, who was then sold to Japan for a reported \$5 million after his fourth season in 1996.

Perhaps one of the considerations in deciding to sell Jolie's Halo was the fact that Appleton was campaigning another good son of Halo, this time in partnership with trainer Happy Alter. This colt, Halo's Image, didn't possess ability of the magnitude which brought Jolie's Halo three Grade I victories, but he was pretty good nonetheless, as he demonstrated throughout a demanding three-year-old season in 1994. From 10 starts that year, Halo's Image was consistent enough to reach the first three in nine stakes races. What's more, he was talented enough to win four of them, including the Spectacular Bid Breeders' Cup S. over six furlongs and the Calder Derby and GIII Tropical Park H. over a mile and an eighth.

Making the Most of Limited Opportunities..

Although Halo's Image didn't race as frequently in subsequent seasons he continued to do well, notably taking the Thanksgiving Day H. at four and then nosing out Wekiva Springs at level weights to land the GIII Broward H. at five. The Broward win proved to be the last of Halo's Image's lengthy career and came just over two years before he covered his first mares at the age of seven at a fee of only \$3,500 at Bridlewood.

The fact that Halo's Image's fee for 2004 will be twice his original price indicates that he has been making the most of his somewhat limited opportunities. His second crop, numbering only 45 foals, is headed by Southern Image, an Appleton-bred who improved his record to three wins from four starts when he accounted for a strong field for the GI Malibu S.

There could be more graded winners to come from Halo's Image's third crop, which has already been ably represented by Sir Oscar, who completed a clean sweep of the Florida Stallion Series. Sir Oscar later improved his record to six wins from as many starts with his victory in the Jack Price Juvenile S. in November. On the same day as the Jack Price, another of Halo's Image's two-year-old sons, Cooperation, had the unenviable task of trying to match strides with Lion Heart in the GIII Hollywood Prevue S., but finished an honorable second.

Cooperation had topped the OBS August Sale when he changed hands for \$200,000 as a yearling and Southern Image had also sold very well for a son of an inexpensive stallion, his price of \$300,000 being the second-best at Ocala's March Select Sale of two-year-olds.

Southern Image's purchaser, Michael Machowsky, said at the time:

"He's immature, but he is a very good walker, very loose. He looks like a horse that wants to run a mile; he's definitely a two-turn horse. We'll give him a little time; we won't rush into anything. I would like to shoot for Del Mar with him."

Presumably Southern Image proved to be more immature than even Machowsky expected, because the 2002 Del Mar meeting went by without him, and he made it to the races only at the very end of his juvenile season. Although he has continued to test Machowsky's patience, Southern Image is now a Grade I winner over seven furlongs.

Southern Image may be a son of an inexpensive stallion, but there is nothing at all cheap about the bottom half of his pedigree.

His dam, the unraced Pleasant Dixie, represents the potent partnership that Dixieland Band has enjoyed with mares by Pleasant Colony and by Pleasant Colony's sire His Majesty. The 19 foals out of Pleasant Colony mares include the Grade II winner Bowman's Band and the Grade I-placed Dixie Pearl, while His Majesty mares number the Grade II winners Devoted Brass and Mutaahab and the Grade III scorer Stark South among their four stakes winners by Dixieland Band.

Pleasant Jolie, the second dam of Southern Image, was something of a late developer, gaining her stakes wins at around a mile at the ages of four and five and she was graded-placed at five and six.

As you might guess from Pleasant Jolie's name, she is a half sister to the previously mentioned Jolie's Halo. This means that Southern Image's pedigree includes both parents of Jolie's Halo, a horse who stayed well enough to win the Gulfstream Park H. over a mile and a quarter. As the sires of Southern Image's first two dams were respectively Graded winners at up to 1 1/8 miles and 1 1/4 miles, there is the intriguing prospect that Southern Image is going to be even more effective when he returns to two turns.

There's also a chance that Halo's Image could develop into an unexpected flag-bearer for the Halo branch of the Hail to Reason male line--a branch whose future in America had appeared to depend largely on Saint Ballado's stallion sons and on More Than Ready, a son of Southern Halo.

Payment Dispute Forces Cancellation at Philly Park:

Philadelphia Park was forced to cancel its 10-race card Monday after jockeys refused to participate in the days events because of an ongoing dispute involving the track's payment schedule. The local jockeys, who operate as independent contractors, are upset with the delay in payment which track officials blame on a longer turn around time for drug test results. "We race from Friday to Tuesday and the riders are paid the following Monday," Ray Lopez, agent for Philadelphia Park's leading rider Stewart Elliot told *Thoroughbred Times* Monday. "But recently, when that Monday comes along, [the riders] are paid for Friday and Saturday and the track will hold Sunday, Monday and Tuesday. That's not right. For the smaller jockeys, the ones that don't win a lot, the one's living from paycheck to paycheck, this puts a hurting on them." Monday's cancellation occurred just minutes before the first race, but the facility remained open for simulcasting. "To my knowledge there are no negotiations," Philadelphia Park Chief Executive Officer Hal Handel told *Thoroughbred Times*. "The jockeys aren't our employees. [Tuesday] we'll take a look at it, see who is willing to ride and make a decision. We don't want another situation like today when we had horses in the paddock and no riders."

ITALIAN RACING HIT BY STRIKE THREAT

Racing in Italy will, in all likelihood, be affected by a strike that is set to commence Jan. 1. All sections of the industry have joined forces to halt racing after UNIRE, Italy's racing authority, announced that prize-money levels will remain at the same level as 2003, but for the month of January only. Betting turnover, on which Italian purses are based, rose by eight percent this year, but various meetings to discuss the current situation have been cancelled. The next meeting is scheduled for Jan. 13, where Stefano Berardelli will represent the racing categories in discussions with UNIRE.
