If the race stays on the grass, **Epicentre** (Kris S.) will be on of the favorites for the GII San Gabriel H. at Santa Anita this afternoon. But trainer Bobby Frankel has a back-up plan if the heavy rains that have hit the Los Angeles area lately force the stakes to the main track. Frankel has also entered **Lundy's Liability (Brz)** (Candy Stripes) for the nine-furlong test. The South American-bred is a perfect two-for-two on the turf, winning a maiden race and a Group 3 event while racing in South Africa. Shipped to Dubai after his first two starts and switched to the dirt, the bay picked up a couple of checks before adding a win in the Mar. 27 G2 UAE Derby to his resume. Lundy's Liability was back on the road after that success, reappearing with a victory in the Oct. 2 GII Goodwood Breeders' Cup H. at Santa Anita. Last time out, the veteran traveller headed to Churchill Downs to finish a tiring sixth in the Nov. 26 GII Clark H. Stablemate Epicentre finished first in the 2003 GI Hollywood Turf Cup, only to be DQ'ed and placed third for causing interference in the stretch. The Juddmonte homebred has won two of his four starts this term, taking an optional claimer over the San Gabriel trip in February and adding a victory in the GIII Elkhorn S. at Keeneland Apr. 23, but he has not been out since finishing eighth in the June 5 GI Manhattan H. at Belmont. Who will Frankel send to the starting gate today? "I don't even want to think about it," Frankel told *Daily Racing Form*.

BIDS ROLL IN FOR RED CROSS

It is the start of a holiday weekend, but horsemen have been quick to respond to yesterday's announcement that Coolmore is donating a nomination to every one of their stallions to aid the International Red Cross in their efforts to help the victims of the Indian Ocean disaster. Offers have already reached or topped the 2005 live foal fees for several Coolmore stallions. Peter Reynolds of Ballymacoll Stud in Ireland raised the bidding on Golan (Ire) to €25,000, which is €15,000 over his fee for next season. John Deer of Fawley Stud in Britain matched the stud fees on Montjeu (Ire) (€45,000) and Johannesburg (€30,000), while Eddie O'Leary of Lynn Lodge Stud in Ireland has come in with an offer of €20,000 for One Cool Cat, who will stand for €17,500 next season. Japan Bloodstock also provided one of the highlights on the opening day of bidding, going to €10,000, his 2005 fee, for Statue of Liberty. "The auction got off to a great start despite it being New Year's Eve," said Coolmore Stud Manager Christy Grassick. "We have already received many calls from throughout the world, and our lines will remain open despite the holiday period. The Red Cross are doing superb work in very difficult conditions--so please call us." The next bidding update will be in Tuesday's *TDN*. Bidding closes at 5 p.m. EST on Jan. 11, opening day of the Keeneland January Sale. A complete list of the Coolmore stallion nominations on offer is on page 4.

"It is not easy to put racing into perspective, as we are constantly aware of the dreadful situation around the Indian Ocean," said Cheltenham MD Edward Gillespie, adding added, "£50 is an amount that changes hands on a raceday with very little thought, and yet it can provide a new home for one of the tens of thousands that have lost theirs in Indonesia, Thailand and Sri Lanka." Yorkshire tracks Catterick [today] and Wetherby [Monday] will follow suit, also donating £1 per paying customer. "This is our way of trying to help those affected by this tragedy," spokesperson Graham Orange told *PA Sport*. "We hope, with the big holiday crowds, that the people of Yorkshire can register their help through racing." In addition, Bookmaker VCbet is pledging a minimum £150,000 to the appeal fund by donating £1 for every bet placed with the firm over the next week.

Donating Down Under...

The Australian Thoroughbred Racing Industry is also ready to join the effort, setting aside Wednesday, Jan. 26, Australia Day, as a national fundraising race day. The plan has the support of the Australian Trainers Association, Australian Jockeys Association and Thoroughbred Racehorse Owners Association. "The Australian Thoroughbred racing industry will be harnessing the generosity of its race clubs, participants and commercial partners to donate to the thousands of victims of this natural disaster," said Australian Racing Board Chairman Andrew Ramsden. The country's race clubs will donate a percentage of the gate to the fund, and the industry's commercial partners are expected to make major contributions as well.

Though heavy rains forced the Monrovia to be contested on the main track and caused six entries to scratch, Resplendency skipped over the sticky surface to post her initial stakes victory. The bay broke her maiden in her third career start over track and trip last October, but didn't see action again until Del Mar, where she captured her Aug. 1 return by five lengths in an allowance. After a second in the Torrey Pines S. Sept. 4, Resplendency was second in a Hollywood allowance Nov. 11 and found herself equipped with blinkers for this scratch-filled contest. The Lewis colorbearer broke alertly and was a half-length back after a quarter in :21.59, but came through along the inside to put her head in front. She clipped off splits of :44.32 and 1:08.84 and got to the wire safely ahead of the charging Puxa Saco.

The unheralded Expect an Angel, last at the first call, came charging in the stretch to capture her stakes debut. Locally based, the Florida-bred had returned from a four-month break to capture a \$10,000 claimer Sept. 11, then didn't start again until Nov. 5. The bay clipped heels and fell in that optional claimer, but emerged unscathed and captured a optional claimer Dec. 19. By far the longest shot on the board here, Expect an Angel settled into stride and caboosed the field on the backstretch before angling four wide on the turn. She caught pacesetter Alix M in the final furlong and drew off to win with authority. "I thought I knew something [about trying her in an ambitious spot]," said winning trainer Bobby Hale. "If I didn't try her, I would never know. Fortunately, I didn't have to answer to another owner. She's a house horse. She had some problems, but she had responded to therapy. I took a shot. It's a poker game after all. That other race [when she fell] was like a tag football game. I'm in no hurry with her. I didn't nominate [early] for the Sunshine Millions, but I can still get her in it."
