EQUIBASE RELEASES YEAR-END STATS

According to the Equibase statistics released yesterday, John Velazquez ended Jerry Bailey's three-year reign atop the North American jockey standings (by earnings) after racking up a total of \$22,248,661 in purses in 2004. Velazquez won with 335 of his 1,327 mounts last season for an average of 25 percent. Edgar Prado was second on the riders' list with \$18,342,106. He was followed by Victor Espinoza (\$15,933,757) and Stewart Elliott (\$14,533,061); Bailey rounded out the top five with earnings of \$14,503,844. Todd Pletcher, Velazquez' number one client, won the trainer's title with \$17,511,923. Pletcher also scored at a 25-percent clip, winning 240 races from 948 starts. Steve Asmussen (\$14,004,202), John Servis (\$8,922,686), Bob Baffert (\$7,627,913) and Richard Dutrow Jr. (\$7,576,986) completed the top five.

For the second consecutive year, it was Michael Gill who led all North American owners by earnings. Gill's runners earned \$10,835,561 after winning 487 of 2,885 starts, an average of 16.8 percent. Stronach Stables was second at \$7,193,867, Ken and Sarah Ramsey finished third in the standings with \$5,855,964, Sam-Son Farms was fourth (\$4,830,939) and Eugene and Laura Melnyk were fifth (\$4,447,689).

As in years past, Canadian purses were counted as equal to those in the U.S., but The Jockey Club and Equibase have finished the computer modifications necessary to convert Canadian earnings to U.S. dollars, and those conversions will be used for all purses won beginning Jan. 1, 2005.

TRULY BLESSED

The field was reduced to six and the rating dropped to a Grade III when Santa Anita's San Gabriel H. was moved to the main track yesterday, but the switch suited **Truly a Judge** (Judge TC) just fine. The veteran gelding dueled **Forty Suertudo** (Arg) (Roar) through six furlongs in 1:10.36, put that rival away, then turned back the challenge of **Star Cross** (Arg) (Southern Halo) for his second consecutive graded score. Claimed for \$20,000 in 2001, the dark bay posted six wins, six seconds and seven thirds for his current connections while playing the come-from-behind game, but he has been unbeatable since his rebirth as a speed horse three starts back. Truly a Judge went gate to wire to win an optional claimer at Hollywood Park by 6 1/2 lengths Nov. 18, made it two in a row with a front-running tally in the Dec. 11 GIII Native Diver H. and came through as the odds-on choice to complete the hat trick here. "You put him on the lead and he's tough to get by," trainer David Bernstein said. "He's got quarter crack problems and everything else, but when he runs, he really lays 'em down." Dusted while racing against \$25,000 claimers on the main track at Calder Oct. 22, Lord Robyn was switched to the grass to face \$35,000 claiming company Nov. 12 and responded with a front-running two-length tally. The Florida-bred made it two-for-two on the turf with a neck victory in a first-level allowance Dec. 4 and was looking to make it three in a row in his stakes debut. The gray once again went right to the lead and clicked off solid splits. He opened up on the field three furlongs from home and was never threatened, cruising to a comfortable success. "He was a little immature early in the meet, but I always liked him," trainer David Fawkes said. "I had him all along, but the Lieblongs and Top Line Racing purchased him privately from [breeder] Marilyn McMaster after he broke his maiden in his second start." As for what's next, Fawkes said, "He loves the turf, obviously. That will be his future for now at least. We'll look at the three-year-old turf stakes at Gulfstream."
