AN ARRESTING WIN IN HAL'S HOPE

Ken and Sarah Ramsey had an outstanding 2004 with the likes of Roses in May and Kitten's Joy in their barn, and the couple started the new year off the right way yesterday when **Badge of Silver** (Silver Deputy) dug deep to stave off **Dynever** (Dynaformer) in the GIII Hal's Hope H. at Gulfstream. The five-year-old had shown brilliance early on with trainer Ronny Werner, but injuries hampered the colt's development and he spent extended time on the sidelines. Reappearing in Bobby Frankel's barn last year, the dark bay came off an eight-month break to be runner-up in a Belmont allowance Oct. 16, then ran a big second in GI Cigar Mile H. at Aqueduct Nov. 27. The crowd's pick here against a talented field, Badge of Silver rated off the pace of the highly regarded **Commentator** (Distorted Humor), overhauled that one turning the corner, then responded to Jerry Bailey's whip to hold on in the dying strides. **Click for the brisset.com chart.** For a video replay, click [here](#).

ANOTHER DAY, ANOTHER DANEHILL After a bullish 2004 sale season culminated in a record-shattering Inglis Easter sale last April, it was perhaps inevitable that the next major sale would seem subdued by comparison. And until Saturday night, Magic Millions

had been solid without being spectacular, despite the much-touted final Danehills bolstering proceedings. However, New Zealand-based agent Rob McAnulty sparked off a lively third session when he determinedly outlasted Queensland trainer Dale Sutton--also underbidder on Friday's A\$700,000 Danehill

topper--to secure lot 516 for a sale-topping A\$850,000. The colt was just one of seven Danehill youngsters offered by Coolmore on behalf of Magic Millions, which bought the mares with Southern Hemisphere-time foals in utero. An outstanding looker, the bay is from the Irish River (Fr) mare Riverjev, dam of six winners, including Deauville GSW Shigeru Summit (GB) (Be My Chief) and MSW Okabango (GB) (Unfuwain). McAnulty, who purchased stakes winner Danbird (Aus) (Danehill) for a Magic Millions record A\$1.1 million in 2002, said connections had yet to decide on a trainer. "He will start off here and we will see what he does," said McAnulty. "He had style, just what we look for in a Danehill, and they are not making any more, you've got to get them now. I was out of petrol. We are just happy to get him." Action continued to be very solid yesterday, with the sale aggregate pushed to A\$36,431,500. The average at A\$110,734 and a clearance rate of 82.3 percent. The sale continues Sunday with Lots 541-700 to be sold beginning at 11 a.m. local time. Session five and six will take place on Tuesday and Wednesday.

Congrats rewarded the decision of owners Claiborne Farm and Adele B. Dilschneider to move the horse to the West Coast, capturing his first graded victory for new trainer Richard Mandella. The bay won the Apr. 30 Alysheba S. at Churchill for conditioner Shug McGaughey, ran a solid third in the GII Washington Park H. two starts later, then disappointed when sixth in the Aug. 22 GII Saratoga Breeders' Cup H. Shipped cross-country, Congrats made an inauspicious debut in the GIII Native Diver S. at Hollywood Dec. 11, finishing sixth, but was all business this time. The bay shadowed pacesetter Excessivepleasure (In Excess {Ire}) through three-quarters, then unleashed an impressive turn of foot to splash clear of his four rivals. Saratoga County has been durable if not consistent over the past year, but put it all together yesterday to notch the rallying victory over Limehouse. Trained by

George Weaver, Saratoga County won the GIII Gotham S. last March at Aqueduct, but went on an eight-race dry spell that included fourths in the GIII Withers S., GII Riva Ridge Breeders' Cup H. and GII Jerome H. A pair of seconds in allowance events at Belmont and

Keeneland in October signaled

the colt was getting back on track and he earned a snazzy 108 Beyer in an open-lengths trouncing of Churchill allowance foes Nov. 27. This time, the bay found himself last of 10 at the first call as Shake You Down (Montbrook) led a tightly packed front rank through a half in :44.43. Jockey Javier Castellano got to work leaving the backstretch and Saratoga County responded by rocketing past several foes on the turn, then stormed to the lead in upper stretch. Limehouse, making his first start since finishing sixth in the June 12 GII Ohio Derby, came calling late, but couldn't cut into the winner's advantage. "Coming off that last race, we changed our tactics a little bit," said Weaver. "We've been giving him sharp works in the morning and that seems to have helped." It's a beautiful day in the neighborhood. That's what trainer Michael Machowsky must've been thinking yesterday when, after making a savvy move and supplementing Fencelineneighbor to the San Gorgonio earlier in the week, he watched his filly run off with the off-the-turf event. The complexion of the race changed completely with the surface switch--gone were graded stakes winners Megahertz (GB) (Pivotal {GB}) and Theater R.N. (Theatrical {Ire})--and the crowd responded in kind by making Fencelineneighbor the chalk vs. just four rivals. The dark bay was off a bit slowly, but quickly got into gear and rushed up to set a sensible pace. Asked for her run nearing the quarter pole, she began to inch away from the stalking Uraib and kept that one at bay under intermittent urging. "I supplemented her Tuesday [for \$3,000]," explained Machowsky. "I didn't even have her nominated. I called Mr. [John] Amerman [owner] and said, 'Hey, you know what? I think we better supplement this filly to the stakes. We'll spend \$3,000 and if they run it on the grass we'll scratch and wait for the Sunshine Millions [Distaff].' She ran fourth in the [Sunshine Millions F&M] turf race last year, but she's gotten so much better on the dirt, I think. Why ship?"

Ticker Tape, an Eclipse Award candi-
 date in the female turf division on the
 strength of wins in the GI American
 Invitational Oaks and GI Queen Eliza-
 beth II S., was being offered by current
 owners Jim Ford, Jack Sweesy and
 Deron Pearson. Haisfield indicated the
 sale was not completed when one of
 two contingencies of the purchase was
 not fulfilled. Haisfield said that his wife, Audrey, was to
 travel to California and inspect the four-year-old **Ticker**
Tape, but was unable to due so when inclement
 weather prevented the filly from working. A second
 contingency--a veterinarian inspection--was met with
 satisfaction, said Haisfield. Ford told the *Blood-Horse* he
 would continue to field offers for **Ticker Tape**, but was-
 n't too upset that the sale didn't go through. "The good
 thing about the sale was I would have some money,
 but I wouldn't have a good horse," he said.

NOMINATION DONATION FOR RED CROSS WORK IN INDIAN OCEAN

To assist with the alleviation of the suffering and the crisis faced by the survivors of the tidal waves that affected 10 countries surrounding the Indian Ocean this week, the Coolmore stallion owners are donating a nomination to every one of their Flat and National Hunt stallions, including Sadler's Wells in Ireland, Fusaichi Pegasus in the USA and Encosta de Lago in Australia. The total fund will be given to the International Red Cross to assist its work with those devastated communities. Beginning Friday, Dec. 31, Ashford Stud in Kentucky and Coolmore Stud in Ireland will accept bids for nominations to each of their stallions while Coolmore Australia will do so for its one permanent resident, Encosta de Lago. Bidding will close at 5 p.m. local time on Tuesday, Jan. 11, during the Keeneland January Sale. The highest bids and the names of the bidders for each stallion will be published daily in the Thoroughbred Daily News and the final charitable purchasers will be released to all major racing and breeding publications. In order to respond to the urgent needs of the Red Cross and their international partners, payment will be required immediately. These nominations will therefore be on a no-guarantee basis, but will include a "right of return" in 2006 for mares barren in 2005. Richard Henry, a spokesman for Coolmore, said, "Everybody has been so affected by this unprecedented human disaster that Coolmore, its stallion owners and staff wanted to do something to help. It will also provide a way in which breeders internationally can contribute to the excellent work of the Red Cross. Supplying a nomination to every stallion across the board offers the widest possible involvement. Coolmore welcomes the participation of other stud farms or syndicates to add stallion nominations to the auction for this charitable effort. Coolmore and the TDN will be willing to assist them in handling the details in any way possible."

NEW SYNDICATE MANAGER, STUD FEE FOR MR. GREELEY

The syndicate for **Mr. Greeley** (Gone West--Long Legend, by Reviewer) has appointed Bill Betz as its new manager. With the appointment, it was also announced that the stud fee for the 13-year-old stallion would be reduced from \$50,000 to \$35,000 live foal, due Nov. 1, for the 2005 breeding season. Breeders who have already signed contracts for '05 will, of course, be entitled to the reduced fee. "I am very excited to be assuming the responsibilities of syndicate manager," Betz said. "I have been associated with the horse since his retirement. Mr. Greeley, I feel, has a very bright future. His weanlings that sold in November were a spectacular group. In the last few years, he has covered the best books of mares he has ever had. The produce of those mares will be two-year-olds in 2005, 2006 and 2007." In 2003, Mr. Greeley was bred to 28 mares that had already produced graded stakes winners and 45 mares that had already produced stakes winners. His 15 weanlings that sold at Keeneland in November averaged \$133,400, his best average ever. Mr. Greeley will continue to stand at Spendthrift Farm in Lexington in 2005.



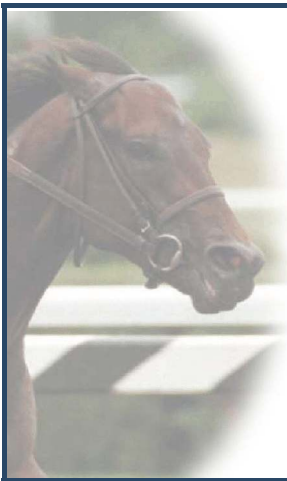

AQUEDUCT CANCELS The card was called off with a minute to post for the fourth race at Aqueduct yesterday afternoon. Citing poor track conditions, officials decided to cancel the remainder of the program. The scheduled feature, the \$75,000 Count Fleet S., will be re-opened to the original nominees and run next Saturday, Jan. 15. The Big A is expected to be back in action this afternoon, with first post at 12:30 p.m.

VALENZUELA CLEARED TO RIDE The California Horse Racing Board voted 7-0 Friday to adopt the ruling of an administrative law judge and grant jockey Pat Valenzuela's appeal of the suspension he was handed last summer. Valenzuela was banned by the CHRB for the balance of 2004 after failing to fulfill the terms of his conditional license. But Judge H. Stuart Waxman ruled that, while the terms of the license required Valenzuela to submit to hair follicle testing, the rider was suspended for failing to submit samples for hair strand testing after shaving his entire body. Hair follicle and hair strand testing are two distinctly different procedures. The 42-year-old, whose career has been plagued by suspensions and substance abuse problems, has applied for a new license and his application is being reviewed by the CHRB. CHRB Executive Director Ingrid Fermin, who did not attend Friday's meeting, was asked to speed up the process. Fermin has requested that Deputy Attorney General Derry Knight consult on a contract that will outline the terms of Valenzuela's new conditional license.

GISW BONAPAW RE-RETIRED Grade I stakes winner **Bonapaw** (Sabona--Pawlova, by Nijinsky II), who was brought back to the track last November after having been retired 11 months prior, has raced his last race, owner Dennis Richard told the *Daily Racing Form*. "I'm not going to embarrass him or embarrass myself anymore," he said after the nine-year-old gelding finished last of nine in a grassy Fair Grounds optional claimer Jan. 9. "He had a breathing problem that made him keep stopping." Bonapaw, winner of the GI Vosburgh S. in 2002 in addition to 11 other added-money events, concludes his career with 18 wins in 48 starts and over \$1.1 million in earnings.

Winning co-owner John Singleton celebrated in typical fashion by buying beer for patrons at the Gold Coast races.
