**STORM BIRD MARE TOPS DAY 4 AT KEENELAND**

An eight-year-old daughter of recently deceased stallion Storm Bird led the way with a \$290,000 final bid during Keeneland's fourth session of the January Horses of All Ages Sale in Lexington yesterday. Consigned by Eaton Sales, agent, **Andrea Gail**, who was purchased by Briggs and Cromartie Bloodstock Agency, is out of the unraced mare Jeanie's Gift (by Gulch). Believed to be in foal to Roar, hip 1367 has already produced three foals, including graded stakes winner Areyoutalkintome (Smokester). The four-year-old gelding proved solid against Cal-bred foes last year, but bumped his game up a notch this term when he came home a 1 3/4-length winner in his 2005 debut in the Gill El Conejo H. at Santa Anita Jan. 2. The 15-year-old mare Jeanie's Gift has also produced a graded stakes winner in Elaborate, victorious in the Gill Triple Bend Breeders' Invitational H. and she hails from the family of GISW Smart Angle. With two more sessions to go, Keeneland closed out the fourth day with gross receipts of \$50,730,800, already topping last year's \$49,344,900 reeled in during the five-day event held in 2004. The sale continues today at 10 a.m.

**Living Up to Expectations...**

John Adger, bidding on behalf of Robert and Janice McNair's Stonerside Stables, went to a \$200,000 to acquire the young mare **Lost Expectations** (Valid Expectations). "We were trying to look for about three young mares that were very precocious and good two-year-olds," Adger explained. "I watched this filly run and she's got a lot of ability and she was very early maturing." The dark bay, third in the 2001 Gill Schuylerville S. at Saratoga, was consigned by Gainesway, agent, which bought Lost Expectations from owner Raymond Dweck for \$65,000 at the 2003 January Sale. She produced a colt from the first crop of Gainesway stallion Orientate in 2004 and sold in foal to Sunday Break (Jpn). Adger indicated that yesterday's purchase will be bred this year to Congaree, as will seven-year-old Silver Jorden (GB) (Imp Society), which they purchased for \$120,000 from the Indian Creek consignment on Tuesday. Stonerside was also the successful bidder on Mike's Wildcat, going to \$190,000 for the daughter of Forest Wildcat. She was also consigned by Gainesway, agent. Adger was not certain who that five-year-old mare would be bred to.

**Mitchell Plays in Prime Time...**

It's a long way from Saskatchewan to Lexington, but that is exactly where owner Rob Mitchell found himself yesterday, signing the ticket on hip [1227](#). Consigned by Elliott Walden Stables LLC, **Prime Time T. V.** (Deputy Minister) was knocked down for a final bid of \$185,000 to the Western Canada resident. The three-year-old colt, a half brother to champion Countess Diana, had made a pair of starts since the catalogue, finishing a good fifth in his Nov. 21 debut at Churchill Downs prior to graduating in 1:09 1/5 in his most recent start at Turfway Park Dec. 26. "Obviously I liked the pedigree all the way through," said Mitchell, who also campaigns four-year-old Shanghied (A.P. Indy), a stakes-winning half brother to Midway Road. "The stallion is proven, the dam is proven and he's a big, strong horse. He's sound and he's race ready. That was the horse we really wanted." In addition to Shanghied, who might make a few starts in Kentucky this winter, Mitchell is looking forward to racing two-year-old Victorious Laurie, a Giant's Causeway half sister to champion Victory Gallop which was purchased for \$200,000 at last year's Keeneland September sale.

**Mizzen Mast Colt Looks Fast...**

A colt from the first crop of Juddmonte Farms' Mizzen Mast (Cozzene) proved popular yesterday in the ring, attracting a final bid of \$105,000. Consigned by Paramount Sales, agent, the Apr. 28 foal is a son of Salini (Woodman) and hails from an Allen Paulson family which includes GSW Stylish and MGSP Tangazi. Pinhooker Peter O'Callaghan signed the ticket on behalf of Bloodstock Services. "He's just a stylish looking horse by a nice young sire," O'Callaghan commented. "He was expensive, but hopefully we'll get lucky." He indicated that the colt will be prepared for the Keeneland September sale later this year.

### Funny Cide Eyes Mid-Meet Return:

Sackatoga Stable's **Funny Cide** (Distorted Humor), who was given a rest following a disappointing 10th-place finish in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic Oct. 30, is currently in light training and will likely return to the races in the Mar. 5 GII Gulfstream Park H. "If he doesn't make that race, we'll point instead for the race on Apr. 2--the [GIII] Skip Away H.," said trainer Barclay Tagg. Funny Cide's Breeders' Cup effort came on the heels of a rock-solid 2004 campaign that included a resurgent victory in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup in early October. "He didn't miss any dances last year, and he didn't miss any the year before that," said Tagg. "He doesn't owe anybody anything and that's why he's getting a rest."

### Roses in May to Donn; Kitten's Joy to Resume Training:

Trainer Dale Romans confirmed yesterday that GI Breeders' Cup Classic runner-up **Roses in May** (Devil His Due) will make his seasonal debut in the GI Donn H. at Gulfstream Park Feb. 5. The five-year-old has been working regularly at Palm Meadows in recent weeks, recording a mile breeze at the training center in 1:38 flat Tuesday. "He worked good," said Romans. "We got just what we wanted. Everything is on schedule for the Donn." Romans also said that Sarah and Ken Ramsey's turf star **Kitten's Joy** (El Prado {Ire}), second in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, will return to training this weekend. "Kitten's Joy will be here on the 16th [Sunday]," he said, "and will start back in training right after." Winner of last year's GI Secretariat S. and GI Turf Classic Invitational, Kitten's Joy is an Eclipse Award finalist in the Turf division.

**BC Foal Nominations for 2004 Soar:**

According to Breeders' Cup Limited officials yesterday, a record 15,850 foals were nominated to the Breeders' Cup program in 2004. The 15,850 foals by Breeders' Cup, European Breeders' Fund and Common Fund nominated stallions tops the old mark of 15,786 foals nominated in 2000. The results do not include Southern Hemisphere foals, which have an Apr. 15 deadline. "We are delighted with this year's record breaking nomination totals, and our steady increases since the MRLS [Mare Reproductive Loss Syndrome] incident," said D.G. Van Clief Jr, president of Breeders' Cup Ltd. "We greatly appreciate the continued support of our nominators, whose funding of our programs is an integral part of the global effort to grow our industry." Foal nominators paid a one-time fee of \$500 per foal by Oct. 15, 2004, making their foals eligible to the BC program for their entire racing careers. For the first time, foals that were not nominated by the October deadline could also be nominated by Dec. 15 for a one-time fee of \$1500.
