A GRAND OPENER IN DUBAI

Grand Emporium (SAf) (National Assembly) got the second Dubai International Racing Carnival off on a high note for South Africa, coming from just off the pace to register a 1 3/4-length victory in G3 Sheikh Maktoum Challenge Round 1 at Nad al Sheba yesterday. One of a string of 23 horses sent to Dubai by trainer Mike de Kock, the bay gelding was a force against his generation last summer in his native country, winning the G1 Triple Crown S. in March and the G1 Daily News 2000 Guineas in June. He was making his first start since finishing seventh in the G1 July H. at Greyville. Tucked in just behind the early speed in fourth, Grand Emporium was temporarily short of room at the 400-meter mark, but was shifted out and finished willingly to win going away. SUNSHINE MILLIONS ENTRIES INCREASE This year's third renewal of the Sunshine Millions, to be run Jan. 29 at Gulfstream Park and Santa Anita, attracted a total of 144 pre-entries--up more than 10 percent

from last year's figure. The event pits Florida-breds against California-breds in eight races worth \$3.6 million. "This event has really taken off in its third year," said Doug Burge, executive vice president and general manager of the California Thoroughbred Breeders' Association. "The overall nominations were up significantly over last year and just looking

at the quality of the pre-entries, I think the races should be very competitive." The pre-entries include 74 Florida-breds and 70 California-breds. Among the most notable entries in the Classic, which will be run this year at Gulfstream, are graded stakes winners **Midas Eyes** (Touch Gold) and **Supah Blitz** (Mecke). The races will be televised nationally on NBC from 4-7 p.m. ET.

TETON FOREST SET TO BEGIN STUD DUTIES

Graded stakes winner **Teton Forest** (Forestry--Tomorrow's Child, by Al Nasr {Fr}) has fully recovered from the fractured ankle that caused his retirement from racing last October and is expected to begin his stud career this coming breeding season at Spendthrift Farm in Lexington, Kentucky. The four-year-old, second in the Gil Riva Ridge Breeders' Cup S. in June, ended his racing career with a six-length victory in the Sept. 18 Gil Jerome H. After that race, he suffered a condylar fracture of the right ankle during training. Owned by Wayne Hughes, Teton Forest will stand his first season for a fee of \$5,000 and is available for inspection at Spendthrift.

DISCLAIMED TOPS OBS FINALE Disclaimed (Affirmed), a 14-year-old mare in foal to Yes It's True, brought \$100,000 to top yesterday's final session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's Winter Mixed Sale in Ocala, Florida. The bay mare ([hip 1127](#)), out of graded stakes winner Golden Horde (Czaravich), was consigned by Dean and Peggy Johnson's Johnson Hollow Farm, as agent, and was purchased by Second Wind Racing, LLC. She is the dam of stakes placed Call Fiorello (Caller I.D.). During the two open sessions of the four-day auction, OBS sold 311 horses for \$1,764,800. The average rose 18 percent from a year ago to \$5,675, while the median increased 28 percent to \$3,200. *(Cumulative stats cont. p4)*

Dominguez to Receive Issac Murphy Award:

Maryland-based jockey Ramon Dominguez is the winner of the 2004 Isaac Murphy Award, given annually to the rider who registers the highest winning percentage (minimum 500 mounts) during the year. The 28-year-old is only the second recipient of the award in its 10-year history after Northern California's Russell Baze dominated its first nine years. In 2004, Dominguez won 383 races from 1,353 mounts for a winning percentage of 28.31, according to statistics compiled by *Daily Racing Form*. Baze finished in second place, with 321 victories from 1,182 mounts (27.16 percent). The highlight of the year for the Venezuela native was his first-ever mounts in the Breeders' Cup, highlighted by his win aboard Better Talk Now in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf for trainer Graham Motion. He was also third in the Sprint on My Cousin Matt and fifth in the Juvenile Fillies astride Dance Away Capote. The Isaac Murphy Award is named in honor of the legendary 19th Century black jockey who won with 44 percent of his career mounts.

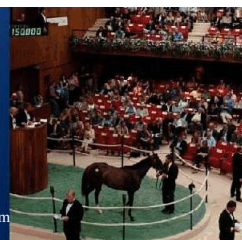
