FLEET FOOTED IN THE PALOS VERDES

Much of the pre-race hype surrounded graded stakes winner **McCann's Mojave** (Memo {Chi}), but it was 7-1 shot **Saint Fleet** (Northern Fleet) who galloped away

with the lion's share of the purse in Sunday's GII Palos Verdes H. at Santa Anita Park. Up close to sharp opening fractions, the Jeff Mullins trainee allowed 6-1 chance **Hombre Rapido** (Falstaff) to get the jump on him a furlong out, but fought back courageously and regained the advantage

at the eighth pole. With a head of steam, the bay battled his game eight-year-old rival in the final sixteenth and held on to post a 3/4-length victory, with another eight-year-old gelding, **Bluesthstandard** (American Standard), rallying to take the show spot. "It was a tough race," said winning rider Patrick Valenzuela. "There were some old, tough veterans. My horse ran a hard race and we got lucky. Jeff [Mullins] did a great job with him." A head winner for trainer Craig Dollase in his 2004 debut in the restricted Sunshine Millions Dash over this track and trip last January, Saint Fleet had to settle for fourth, his sole attempt on the turf, in the 6 1/2-furlong GIII Baldwin S. Feb. 28. A head winner first time out for Mullins in a \$100,000 optional claimer at Hollywood Park Nov. 7, the colt made a mild bid and finished fourth in the Oakland H. at Golden Gates Dec. 11. "He hit an off track at Golden Gate," said Mullins, explaining the colt's lackluster performance. "He was training good for this, though." Mullins indicated that Saint Fleet may make his next appearance in the seven-furlong GII San Carlos H. Feb. 26. GSW McCann's Mojave, sent off the 8-5 favorite, was never in the hunt and faded to finish last of eight.

WHILLY WIRES SAN MARCOS

Italian expatriate **Whilly (Ire)** (Sri Pekan), tucked away since a 3/4-length victory in the mile Sir Beaufort H. over this course Dec. 26, marked his 2005 return with a game win in Saturday's 10-furlong GII San Marcos H.

at Santa Anita. Sent off the third choice behind trainer Bobby Frankel's Southern Hemisphere import **License To Run (Brz)** (Exile King) the Irish-bred broke wide, but recovered quickly to take an early lead. On top while setting solid opening fractions, the bay drifted out in the final

furlong, but had enough left in reserve to hold off **Pup-peteer (GB)** (Singspiel {Ire}) with **T.H. Approval** (With Approval) further back in third. "That wasn't my plan [to go to the lead], but [trainer] Doug [O'Neill] said, 'If he happens to be on the lead, don't worry, just let him run,'" said rider Felipe Martinez, who was winning his first graded stakes. "I was hoping I would have something left. Now I really believe in him because when I asked him, he just took off again." Favored License To Run never figured yesterday, coming home sixth. A conditions winner in Italy last year, Whilly finished third in his U.S. debut in the GIII Cinema Breeders' Cup H. last June before spending the rest of the summer on the sidelines. In his second start back, he won the restricted Bien Bien H. over a mile at Hollywood Nov. 6 before closing to finish fourth in the 1 1/4-mile GI Hollywood Derby Nov. 28. "We've been dreaming of going to Dubai, so if he comes out of this good and they invite us, I think we're heading to the Middle East [Dubai World Cup Day Mar. 26]," said O'Neill. "But he'll probably run somewhere in between...[in the 1 1/2-miles GII San Luis Obispo H. Feb. 19]...the horse acts like the longer the better." (San Marcos chart p2)

Only six others decided to try the newly crowned world champion turf sprinter, and, as always, they were running for second money as Silent Witness turned in a brilliant performance to remain undefeated. Well away from the stalls, the five-year-old raced prominently, but Christophe Soumillon was intent on the lead with Able Prince (Aus) (Hurricane Sky {Aus}) and cut over to lead on the rails. Silent Witness went up after that one from the outside with a quarter mile to run as stablemate Country Music emerged from the back to draw within three-parts of a length at the eighth pole. But Silent Witness always had his measure, drawing off to win going away. "Able Prince crossed him a bit sharply early and we touched heels with him but as soon as he saw daylight he just went on with it," commented winning jockey Felix Coetzee. BAZE PASSES SHOEMAKER ON WINS LIST

Russell Baze passed the legendary Bill Shoemaker to take over second place on the all-time win list for jockeys when he rode his 8,834th winner at Golden Gate Fields on Saturday. Shoemaker retired in 1990 with 8,833 wins. Laffit Pincay, Jr., who retired in 2003, leads the list with 9,530 victories. Baze's milestone victory came aboard 6-5 favorite Hollow Memories in Saturday's seventh race. It was the 46-year-old Canadian's fourth win on the card. "Now that it's official, I'm glad it's over," admitted Baze, who began his riding career in 1974. "I don't really think about it, but when I do, it's like, 'Holy mackerel, that's a lot of wins.'" Elected to the Hall of Fame in 1999, Baze has led the nation's jockeys by numbers of wins seven times and won the Isaac Murphy Award for the jockey with the highest winning percentage nine consecutive times, from 1995 through 2003.

Pampered Princess refused to be overtaken by barnmate Adobe Gold as favored Isola Piu Bella came up empty down the lane. Pampered Princess finished first or second in seven of her 11 starts in 2004, including a trio of minor stakes wins. She couldn't hold on late in the Stage Door Betty H. at Calder on New Year's Day, rounding out the exacta, but came out on top this time with a gritty performance. The five-year-old daughter of Indian Charlie set pressured :23.66 and :47.73 fractions and looked to be in trouble as Isola Piu Bella slipped through on the rail turning for home. Digging back in, however, Pampered Princess put away the crowd's choice and was all out as Adobe Gold put forth a strong late challenge. "When I saw [Isola Piu Bella], I thought I was running for second--believe me," admitted winning trainer Marty Wolfson. "She is what she is; when she gets to the front she's really hard to beat, but the other filly [Adobe Gold] is starting to come around. I don't know what's next for them, but I don't want to keep them together."
