SECOND SEASON

Today's \$1-million Ocala Breeders' Sales Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream marks a second chance at the big time for **Second of June** (Louis Quatorze). A year ago, the bay had kicked off his three-year-old season with a rousing victory in the GIII Holy Bull S., earning a Beyer Speed Figure of 111, and posted a 113 when falling a neck short to Read the Footnotes in the GII Fountain of Youth S. But a condylar fracture sustained during that race kept the handsome colt on the sidelines for months, and he returned to run second by a neck in an optional claimer at Calder Dec. 27. "This is not an easy race, and I hope he's tight enough having had just one start since last winter," trainer Bill Cesare told *Daily Racing Form*. "His mile work over the track since that race was great, and I expect he'll improve off his last. I'm just hoping he runs well." The Grade I-winning sprinter **Midas Eyes** (Touch Gold) might be disadvantaged by post 11 in this attempt to ration his speed for nine furlongs. In his lone previous try at this distance, the Florida-bred ran a close fourth, beaten 1 1/2 lengths, in last year's GII Strub S. He has not run since missing by a neck in the GI DeFrancis Memorial Dash Nov. 20.

The \$300,000 Sunshine Millions F/M Sprint at Gulfstream features the return of **Bear Fan** (Pine Bluff), who equalled the track record at Belmont in winning the GII Vagrancy H. by nine lengths June 5. A troubled third in last year's F/M Sprint, the California-bred hasn't raced since her runner-up effort in the GII Princess Rooney H. at Calder July 10. "I decided to give her a break after the race at Calder," explained trainer Wesley Ward. Ward is hoping for better luck in this year's F/M Sprint. "She should have won the race by 10 lengths, her trip was so bad," he said. "I know trainers tell you that all the time, but watch the replay and you'll see what I mean." **Field, p3.**

SUN SHINES ON DISTAFFERS

The \$500,000 Barretts/CTBA Sunshine Millions Distaff at Santa Anita will field a flurry of California-bred graded stakes winners. **House of Fortune** (Free House), an impressive winner of the GII Fantasy S. and the GII Hollywood BC Oaks, hasn't been out since finishing seventh in the GI Overbrook Spinster S. Oct. 10. The dark bay reportedly suffered from an ulcer, but has been training well in recent weeks. She'll have to face the lightly raced **Dream of Summer** (Siberian Summer), who outbattled **Yearly Report** (General Meeting) in the Cal Cup Matron H. over track and trip Oct. 16. **Field, p2.**

With seven wins from his 11 trips to the post, **Tyson** starts South Africa's most prestigious race as the 128-pound highweight. The four-year-old gelding, a convincing 4 1/4-length winner of the G1 Summer Cup Nov. 27, disappointed in his latest, finishing eighth to **Winter Solstice** in the 1600-meter G1 Queen's Plate at this left-handed track Jan. 5. Nonetheless, trainer Stuart Pettigrew is full of confidence. "No excuses, he's fit and sound," the conditioner told *SAHorseracing.com*. "No other horse can beat him; he is the best in the field, only the course can beat him." Past winners of this event include Wolf Power (SAf), Horse Chestnut (SAf) and last year's hero Yard-Arm (SAf), now stabled in Dubai with Mike de Kock.

SULAMANI TOPS CANADIAN RANKINGS

Sulamani (Ire) (Hernando {Fr}) topped the 2004 Canadian Thoroughbred Ratings compiled by the Canadian Jockey Club, according to the *Blood-Horse*. All horses that raced in Canadian stakes races last year are eligible and are rated by their best performance anywhere in the world. Sulamani earned a rating of 123 for his win in the G1 Juddmonte International. His win in the GI Canadian International was rated the best performance in Canada with a rating of 121.
