## MUSIQUE TO MY EARS

A moderate claimer just eight months ago, **Musique Toujours** (Musique d'Enfer) looked like a million bucks as he held on to win the \$1,000,000 Sunshine Millions Classic at Gulfstream Park yesterday afternoon. The 70-1 shot shocked the crowd, leading nearly every step to beat GIII Discovery H. hero **Zakocity** (Precocity) by a neck. The win couldn't have come at a better time for co-owner Richard Glassman. "I retired from the car business," he said. "I used to be a sales manager, but I've been out of work for a year...I'm trying to become a Los Angeles police officer." The Classic gave Team California its third of eight Sunshine Million events, but it wasn't enough as Team Florida once again came out the victor, 44 point to 28. The Sunshine State has yet to be beaten in three Sunshine Millions. *Sunshine Millions Classic cont. p2*

He couldn't hang on after cutting out the fractions in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf, but **Star Over the Bay** (Cozzene) had it all over the competition in yesterday's \$500,000 Sunshine Millions Turf at Santa Anita. A legless eighth going a mile and a half in the World Thoroughbred Championships, the speedy gray gelding went right to the front in the nine-furlong SM Turf and was resolute to the wire, fending off the determined challenge of 2-1 favorite **A to the Z** (Benchmark) for a half-length score. ## ALL HEART

Last year, **Valentine Dancer** (In Excess {Ire}) held off **Moscow Burning** (Moscow Ballet) to take the \$500,000 Sunshine Millions F/M Turf by 3/4 of a length. An 8-1 chance to repeat, she once again faced a challenge in deep stretch, this time turning back **Marwood** (Marlin) for the neck victory. You don't often get 12-1 on a Bobby Frankel-trained stakes runner, but those were the odds on **Sweet Lips** (Kris S.) in the \$500,000 Sunshine Millions Distaff S. at Santa Anita yesterday. The four-year-old filly belied her odds, rebounding from a ninth-place finish behind **Alphabet Kisses** (Alphabet Soup) in the GI La Brea S. to earn her first stakes victory by 1 1/2 lengths over 39-1

Climbing the Ladder...**

Musique Toujours was halted after finishing second against \$40,000 claiming company at Hollywood in November of 2003. He picked up his first win for his new owners in his 2004 debut, taking an optional claimer over fellow Cal-breds Jan. 24, but was off the board in his next two starts and returned to the claiming ranks. The bay gelding responded to the drop with a three-length score for a \$50,000 tag at Hollywood in May, but there were no takers. He followed up with a second-place effort in the July 17 Claiming Crown Jewel S. at Canterbury, but had not been out since rallying from far back to be third in an open allowance test at Del Mar Aug. 29.

**There's Always a Chance...**

Making his stakes debut in the Classic, Musique Toujours was given little chance by the Gulfstream handicappers. But new jockey Jorge Chavez sent the underdog right to the front and turned back all challenges, digging in gamely to light up the tote board with a \$142.20 mutuel. "I talked to the trainer this morning and he just told me to...be sure to put him in the game and try and sit one or two lengths back," Chavez said. "But he warmed up so good and I could see he was going to be able to make the lead. It was easy and comfortable, so I just let him go. I was trying to save what I could for the end and then I saw the other horse coming...and I just started yelling, 'please, please just give me a little more!'" While the winner had a little left in the tank, 2-1 favorite **Midas Eyes** (Touch Gold), wide throughout, faded after making a middle move to be ninth.

**Unsung Hero...**

The sire of Musique Toujours, **Musique d'Enfer** (Stop the Music--Chiffon, by \*Nijinsky II) had just 31 foals from his nine crops to race, including two from his final crop, which are two-year-olds of 2005. A winner of just three races and \$47,343 in 36 starts over five seasons, he stood at KingsWay Farm in Temecula, California. Musique Toujours is his first stakes horse.

Star Over the Bay could have been claimed for \$35,000 during the 2003 Saratoga meet and was in for \$62,500 last March, but it wasn't until May that Mike Mitchell reached in and took the Florida-bred for \$80,000 after a four-length score at Hollywood. Beaten a neck in the June 19 Dallas Turf Cup H. in his first try under new management, the veteran came back to lead gate to wire in three straight--the July 18 GII Sunset H., Aug. 29 GII Del Mar H. and Oct. 3 GI Clement L. Hirsch S. He faltered over a very soft turf on Breeders' Cup Day, but was back at his best here. Star Over the Bay led them along through a half in :46.86 and six furlongs in 1:10.84. It looked like A to the Z had him measured at the top of the lane, but the gritty gray kept finding more and held on to the wire. "With the rain yesterday, I was a little concerned about the track--he doesn't like a soft track," jockey Tyler Baze said. "But he's got so much heart, this horse." The winner could go next in the Feb. 13 GII San Luis Obispo H.

Valentine Dancer had started just three times since her win in last year's Sunshine Millions F/M Turf and had been off the board in two of those three races. Fourth in the Feb. 14 GII La Canada on the dirt and sixth in the Apr. 24 Fran's Valentine S. on the turf, she was then sidelined for nearly nine months.

**Mommy Dearest...**

Explaining the extended absence, owner Al Kirkwood said, "She got a little tired and we sent her home to get some rest. We had some weanlings on the farm and she got annoyed by them. We told her to go back and win the Sunshine Millions or she was going to be called 'Mommy.'" Valentine Dancer took those words to heart. The five-year-old made her return in the Jan. 14 Paseana H. over the Santa Anita dirt and finished a solid second after setting the pace. Back on the grass in her second start back, she shadowed moderate splits and strode to the front as they raced around the far turn. The bay had two lengths on the field at the eighth pole, but saw that lead dwindle as the first six horses hit the wire four necks and a head apart. With the win, she ran her earnings to more than \$900,000. "We're hoping she can be our first homebred millionaire," Kirkwood said. "She's close."

**Money Burner...**

Moscow Burning (Moscow Ballet) was sent off the 13-10 chalk after running fourth, beaten less than a length, against the boys in the Dec. 4 GI Hollywood Turf Cup. The crowd's choice bumped with Marwood as they came into the stretch, then finished well, but had to settle for fifth in that tight finish.

Sweet Lips broke her maiden on the lawn at Santa Anita last April, but was switched to the dirt after running fourth in a Hollywood allowance test in May. The chestnut filly proceeded to reel off four straight

main-track tallies, capping off the accomplishment with a rallying allowance win at Hollywood Nov. 21. She showed little in the Dec. 27 GI La Brea S., but came back to life with the addition of blinkers in the Sunshine Millions Distaff. After trailing the field for a half, she angled outside in her quest for running room at the top of the lane, then changed course and

set sail up the rail, driving to the front late before edging clear. "I think [the blinkers] made the difference," said Humberto Ascanio, assistant to Bobby Frankel. "[Jockey Rene Douglas] worked her one time after her last race and said she was a different filly." Added Douglas, "I knew she was doing good, and Bobby and I were really confident that she was going to run big. There was no game plan--we were just going to have patience and make sure we didn't get stopped once she made her move." MGSW Yearly Report (General Meeting), the 4-5 chalk off her 9 1/4-length score in the Oct. 29 Stonerside S. at Lone Star Park, showed little and finished sixth. "I never had any horse at any time," jockey Jerry Bailey said. "She just had no energy at all, completely flat."

**WHAT MADE IT GREAT**

Aidan O'Brien had always insisted that Hawk Wing was capable of great things but the horse had never proved him right. Second in the 2,000 Guineas, Derby, Irish Champion Stakes and Queen Elizabeth II Stakes at three, Hawk Wing had lost much of his lustre by the time he made his seasonal reappearance in the Lockinge, but what he did at Newbury was scarcely credible. Making all up the centre of the track, the impossibly handsome horse with the Hollywood looks ran his rivals ragged, powering clear to win by an enormous margin and producing a performance that earned comparisons with the likes of Brigadier Gerard and El Gran Senor...

Red Warrior surprised this Sunshine Millions Sprint field in a race marred by the breakdown of Green Team (Huddle Up). The chestnut concluded his three-year-old season with a ninth in the Cal Cup Classic and was sidelined for 10 months thereafter. He ran unplaced in a pair of turf starts, including a seventh to A to the Z in the Cal Cup Mile Oct. 16, but bounced back to take an off-the-turf sprint at Hollywood Dec. 11. In his most recent outing, he was the runner-up in a 6 1/2-furlong optional claimer Jan. 8. Red Warrior, the second longest shot on the board here, was last at the first call. But the pacesetting Green Team (Huddle Up) broke down on the turn, causing severe traffic problems behind him, and Red Warrior took to the outside. He found clear sailing and outfinished Full Moon Madness for his first career stakes victory. Green Team suffered a fractured left front sesamoid and had to be euthanized. Bang (Ballistic Billy) bled and was eased.

On the board in all nine previous starts, the lightly raced Alix M was second after setting the pace in the Nov. 13 Elmer Heubeck Distaff H. going 1 1/16 miles at Calder. She dropped back to 6 1/2 furlongs and captured the Dec. 13 Connie's Magic S., then tried her luck against graded company for the first time and just missed, vying for the lead in the Dec. 31 GIII Chaposa Springs H. before weakening late to fill the runner-up spot. The crowd's second choice behind MGSW Bear Fan on Sunshine Millions Day, she tracked the pace from third through a half in :45.26. Bear Fan took over as they raced out of the turn, but Alix M went after her, making contact as she joined the favorite at the eighth pole before driving away to a decisive score. As for what's next, trainer Ronald Spatz said, "Maybe I'll give her a break now." Bear Fan, who capped a four-race winning streak with a nine-length victory in the June 5 GII Vagrancy H. at Belmont, was making her first start since a second in the July 10 GII Princess Rooney H. at Calder. "We just got a good old-fashioned ass-whupping," trainer Wesley Ward admitted.

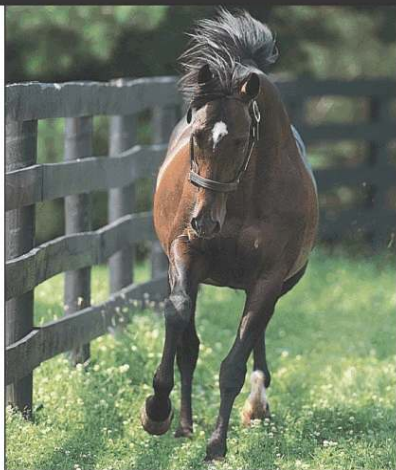

Now trained by Richard Mandella, who excelled with such South American stars as Gentlemen (Arg), Sandpit (Brz) and Siphon (Brz), Salt Champ has been working bullets, including a seven-furlong move in 1:24 3/5 just 10 days ago. She blew out with a half in :46 2/5 on Jan. 25 and gets Lasix for her first appearance in nearly 10 months. **Tamweel** has been knocking on the door vs. Grade I foes. The chestnut won Arlington's Aug. 13 Mariah's Storm S., then finished second to Adoration in the Sept. 4 GIII Arlington Matron and to Azeri in the Oct. 10 GI Overbrook Spinster S. A 9-1 shot on Breeders' Cup Day, she set a pressured pace and held on to be fourth, just three lengths behind champion Ashado. **Stakes Previews cont. p9**

**NZB PREMIER SALE KICKS OFF TODAY**

The focus of the Australasian sales industry now switches to Karaka, where 558 yearlings will go under the hammer at the three-day New Zealand Bloodstock's Premier Sale starting Monday. The Southern Hemisphere season began at Magic Millions on a solid, if somewhat contained, note, and Karaka is likely to follow suit ahead of the Inglis Easter sale. The Karaka sale posted decidedly bullish results last January, in line with all the Australasian majors, with a 17-percent average increase to NZ\$111,955.

**Regally Bred Filly Withdrawn**

Cambridge Stud has withdrawn Lot 363, a Zabeel (NZ) filly out of Group 1 winner Diamond Lover (Aus), according to a statement on the stud's website. The filly's full brother Don Eduardo (NZ) brought NZ\$3.6 million when he topped this sale in 2000. "There's no doubt she's a lovely filly," said Cambridge Stud owner Sir Patrick Hogan, "but she is not without conformational faults in her forelegs. [We] decided to enter her for the sale in July. If she had shown enough improvement...we would have been happy for her to go to the sales. It is my opinion that she is a filly who will need to be given time to mature. Obviously, there has been intense interest in this filly, and we felt that we owed it to potential buyers and the sales company to make a decision." The filly's dam is one of five Group 1 winners produced by \*Eight Carat.

**Dominant Danehill...**

The late Danehill, who accounted for the top three lots last year, is represented by 12 fillies and eight colts. At Magic Millions in January, Danehill's 14 yearlings averaged A\$475,357. NZB principals Peter and Philip Vela, via Pencarrow Stud, will consign the largest number of Danehill yearlings with nine on offer. Their draft includes Lot 68, a colt out of Paint Me a Dream (Deputy Minister), a half sister to Honour and Glory from the family of Ogygian. The fact that the number of Danehill offspring is dwindling has piqued international attention. "The Danehills have certainly sparked interest from Northern Hemisphere buyers," said NZB Marketing Manager Peter Vela. "We have them coming in from all corners of the globe." The sales topper in 2004 was a NZ\$1.1 million Danehill colt purchased by David Ellis' Te Akau Stud. Now named Darci Brahma (Aus), he makes his debut at Avondale today.

**Montjeu Mania**

Champion Montjeu (Ire), off to a very promising start at stud, will be represented by 62 yearlings at the Premier Sale. The bay's first runners in the Northern Hemisphere include unbeaten Group 1 winner Motivator (GB). At last year's Premier Sale, his 51 youngsters averaged NZ\$130,657. "The feedback from trainers in

"He didn't think anyone could outrun us. Scott's done a great job with him and he's gotten a lot better in his last two starts." Don Six marked Lake's third winner on the card.
