The marquee event of Gulfstream's six graded stakes today is the GI Donn H., and even though only six have been entered, the \$500,000 contest will feature a clash between **Roses in May** (Devil His Due) and **Saint Liam** (Saint Ballado). Both runners provoked exceptional efforts from eventual Horse of the Year Ghostzapper last year and will be looking to build on their 2004 successes. Roses in May, who hasn't raced since his runner-up effort in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic, is seeking to use the Donn as a springboard to the G1 Dubai World Cup Mar. 26. "It's hard to call a prestigious Grade I a prep for another race," trainer

Dale Romans told *Daily Racing Form*. "But then again, when you're running for \$500,000 and the next one is \$6 million, I guess maybe you could." Romans appeared confident in his charge's readiness. "I think he's going to run real well, and we're coming in...to win," he added. Saint Liam, who gave Ghostzapper fits in the GI Woodward S., has been off since defeating **Seek Gold** (Touch Gold) in the GII Clark H. Nov. 26. Also in the Donn is **Eddington** (Unbridled), who seemed to be his generation's bridesmaid with placings in the Preakness, Travers and Wood Memorial. But he broke through on the grass in the GIII Calder Derby in October and made an eye-catching local appearance Jan. 16, winning an allowance over track and trip by 8 3/4 lengths while earning a 109 Beyer.

**HANG TEN**

A field of 10 four-year-olds, featuring the West Coast-East Coast confrontation between **Rock Hard Ten** (Kris S.) and **Love of Money** (Not for Love), will go postward in today's GII Strub S. at Santa Anita. Love of Money, who turned in a tour-de-force in the GII Pennsylvania Derby on Labor Day, faltered as the favorite in the GI Jockey Club Gold Cup Oct. 2 and was given some time off.

Plane problems forced him to skip the GI Malibu S. at Santa Anita Dec. 26, but the Maryland-bred has been training brilliantly since. Rock Hard Ten rallied to take the Malibu and will once again have Gary Stevens in the irons. In four starts together, their only loss has been a distant second in the GI Preakness S. **Good Reward** (Storm Cat), who shipped out in November to surprise the GI Hollywood Derby, has trainer Shug McGaughey hoping lightning can strike twice, even though the bay hasn't raced on dirt since 2003. "Without any good options in Florida [on turf], I thought it would be a good option on the dirt," McGaughey told *Daily Racing Form*. "If he performs well, it would open some doors and enhance his value as a stud." **Strub, p2**

**EYES ON THE PRIZE**

The 2005 three-year-old scene begins to heat up this weekend with some of the division's big names making appearances. Gulfstream will host the GII Hutcheson S. and the GIII Holy Bull S., while Santa Anita will contest the Sham S. The Phipps homebred **Defer** (Danzig), hero of the GIII Laurel Futurity, will square off with GI Champagne S. hero **Proud Accolade** (Yes It's True) in the Hutcheson. The Holy Bull will feature the ascendant **High Fly** (Atticus), towering victor of the Aventura S. Jan. 8. In the Sham, **Going Wild** (Golden Missile) will attempt to stretch his speed against the likes of **Giacomo** (Holy Bull).

**Proud Accolade**, who looked like an Eclipse candidate after getting the better of Afleet Alex in the GI Champagne S. last October, will try to rebound after ending his juvenile campaign with two straight off-the-board efforts. A lackluster sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, the dark bay added blinkers for the Dec. 18 GI Hollywood Futurity, but tired after pressing the pace to be fifth. He sheds the hood this afternoon. **Park Avenue Ball** has not been out since running fifth in the Champagne, but showed plenty of promise in his first four starts. The Jersey-bred captured the July 31 Tyro S. at Monmouth Park in his second start and just missed in the Aug. 28 GIII Sapling S., finishing second by 3/4 of a length to Evil Minister. The chestnut colt turned the tables on that rival in his penultimate start of the year, taking the one-mile GII Futurity S. at Belmont Park in September, and has been working sharply for his sophomore debut. **Defer** ran into Rockport Harbor in his stakes debut and had to settle for second in the Nov. 2 GIII Nashua S., but came right back to take his two-turn bow, the Nov. 20 GIII Laurel Futurity. The bay drops back in distance for his first start of 2005, but trainer Shug McGaughey hopes to use the Hutcheson as a stepping stone to the Triple Crown trail. "The Hutcheson is the kind of springboard we're looking for toward the Fountain of Youth, the Florida Derby and, hopefully, the Kentucky Derby," McGaughey said. "Bringing him back at 7 1/2 furlongs sets him up nicely. This race this weekend isn't do or die. I'd like to see him win, but we just want to see him run well."

**Sis City** makes her first start since a front-running score in the Nov. 27 GII Demoiselle S. Claimed for \$50,000 after breaking her maiden by a nose at Saratoga, the bay made her debut under new management in the Sept. 12 Mongo Queen S. at Monmouth and won by 16 lengths. She followed that effort with a third in the GI Frizette S. and a fourth at 20-1 in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies in October before a dominating performance in the Demoiselle.

"She's coming up to the race really well," trainer Rick Dutrow Jr. told *Daily Racing Form*. "It's the first time she's had proper spacing between her races since we claimed her." The speedy filly could be alone on the lead early, but she will have company in the stretch. **Dance Away Capote** is one rival who will be around at the finish. The \$45,000 OBSMAR purchase rallied for a 12-length score in the Sept. 25 Irish Sonnet S. at Delaware Park and closed from last to be fourth, beaten less than a length, in the Oct. 8 GII Alcibiades S. at Keeneland. She has not been out since hitting traffic in the BC Juvenile Fillies and running fifth. **In the Gold** was third in the Alcibiades, but earned a break after fading to fifth in the Nov. 27 GII Golden Rod S. at Churchill. The chestnut made her return in a one-mile Gulfstream allowance test and sailed home a length and a half in front of **Jill Robin L.**

**SAMURAI PULLED OFF DERBY TRAIL** The highly touted **Fusaichi Samurai** (Fusaichi Pegasus), one of the

winter-book favorites for the Kentucky Derby, has been injured and is off the Triple Crown trail, according to trainer Neil Drysdale. "After his last work [six furlongs in 1:15.20 at Hollywood Park Jan. 21], he came out of it stiff in his left hind leg and pulled a muscle," Drysdale said.

"After talking with Mr. Sekiguchi [owner], it was decided not to continue at this time. This precludes us from the Triple Crown." The world-record \$4.5-million FTFEB two-year-old purchase hasn't raced since his impressive maiden win at Hollywood Dec. 11.

**MADCAP ESCAPADE TWO WEEKS AWAY** **Madcap Escapade** (Hennessy) is scheduled to make her long-awaited return to the races in the GII Shirley Jones H. at Gulfstream Park Feb. 19.

The bay was brilliant at three, rattling off victories in the Old Hat S. at Gulfstream and the GI Ashland S. at Keeneland. Her unbeaten record came to an end when she was the runner-up to Ashado in the GI Kentucky Oaks Apr. 30, and she exited that race with a hairline fracture of her hip.

"The injury wasn't really as bad as it sounds," explained trainer Frank Brothers. "The main thing she needed was time. She got two months in the barn and two months turned out. Once we had her re-scanned, she's progressed just as we hoped. She's feeling good and moving good." The Shirley Jones is run over seven furlongs, a distance easily negotiated by the swift filly. "I do think we need to find a way to control her speed," Brothers added. "But she also won a Grade I around two turns and that's got to say something. I feel she's got the talent to be a good middle-distance type." Brothers hasn't mapped out a specific campaign yet. "There's never any gimmies in this game," he said. "We'll see how these next two weeks of training turn out. Just as long as she doesn't stub her toe."

**THE MIG CLIMBS TO 4000** Jockey Richie Migliore picked up the 4,000th winner of his career at Aqueduct yesterday, guiding Benjamin Baby to victory in the seventh race. He becomes the 18th active rider to reach that plateau, and the 43rd overall. "You're riding with this every day and it is inevitable that it is going to happen, but you put a number on it and it becomes something you want badly--and I wanted it badly," Migliore said. "I'm proud of the achievement." He added, "I'm real fortunate to ride for good people--you don't get to 4,000 wins without a lot of help along the way." The 40-year-old reinsman earned his first win at the Meadowlands in 1980. He went on to take the Eclipse Award as the top apprentice in 1981, and was the leading rider in New York that season as well. He led the New York standings again in 1985, but suffered a broken neck in a horrific spill at Belmont Park three years later, an injury that nearly ended his career and was later featured on the TV show "Rescue 911." He was back in the saddle six months later, but missed another six months after breaking his arm in July of 1999. A native of Long Island, Migliore has piloted such top runners as Eclipse heroine Hidden Lake and Grade I winners Catinca, Eternal Prince, Lady Shirl, Miss Linda (Arg), Richter Scale, Tactile, Tenski, Wild Again and Win. As for the future, he said, "I think 5,000 is a realistic goal and something I would like to shoot for next."

**Glittering Card at Gulfstream:**

In addition to the six graded stakes on today's racecard, Gulfstream will also contest several interesting maiden and allowance races. Chief among the latter is the second race, a NW1X at seven furlongs for three-year-olds. **Survivalist** (Danzig) has drawn post seven for this 2005 bow. Gene doping involves modifying an individual's genetic makeup in order to improve athletic ability, a practice banned by the World Anti-Doping Agency and The Jockey Club in Britain.

**KING HESPERUS SET FOR DEBUT**

**King Hesperus** (Kingmambo), formerly trained in Ireland by Aidan O'Brien, makes his Hong Kong debut in a Class 2 event over 1400 meters today at Sha Tin. The bay colt made three starts as a juvenile, finishing first past the post in his racetrack debut only to be demoted to second by disqualification. The two-length winner of the Listed Rochestown S. in his next start, the \$330,000 KEESEP yearling purchase was sidelined for 14 months with a foot injury following a third in the G3 Superlative S in July 2003. The son of SW & GSP Victorica (Exbourne) returned to be fourth in the Listed Solonaway S. in his only other racetrack appearance last September. Now four, King Hesperus is owned by Hong Kong Jockey Club Chairman Ronald Arculli, who also campaigns last year's G1 Queen Elizabeth Cup winner River Dancer, another acquisition in recent years from the O'Brien yard.

**NZB SELECT SALE CONCLUDES** The second and final session of New Zealand Bloodstock's Select Sale, held in Karaka yesterday, saw 86 lots bring an aggregate of NZ\$5,302,000 for an average of NZ\$61,651. Overall, 342 yearlings were sold for NZ\$11,539,000 during the two-day auction. The average was NZ\$33,740, up 11 percent from 2004. The median of NZ\$30,000 realized an increase of 15 percent from last year. The clearance rate was 73.4 percent, down from 79 percent a year ago. The leading Select Sale buyer was Graeme Rogerson, who purchased 15 lots for a total of NZ\$682,500, while the leading consignor was Windsor Park Stud, which sold 24 yearlings for a total of NZ\$1,001,500. The third and final section of NZB's National Yearling Sales is the Festival Sale, set for Feb. 6-7.

**VICTORIA LIFTS BAN ON TRAINING PARTNERSHIPS** Training partnerships, which have been commonplace in New Zealand for the past 10 years but banned in Australia, will be introduced in Victoria on a 12-month trial basis, Racing Victoria chief steward Des Gleeson said Friday. But his New South Wales counterpart Ray Murrhly has gone on record against the partnerships because they could enable individuals to duck the consequences of any breach of racing rules. Murrhly said if one trainer was suspended or disqualified, the training operation could continue unaffected in the partner's name. Leading trainers with significant interstate operations rely on foremen. "Many trainers are relying more and more heavily on assistant trainers and forepersons to take responsibility for the management of their stables," Gleeson said. "Our licensing arrangements and rules should reflect this reality." He added that training partnerships encourage older trainers to take on junior partners, lifting the opportunities for young people in the industry.

**SIR RUPERT CLARKE DEAD** Long-time Victoria Amateur Turf Club committeeman Sir Rupert Clarke died Friday morning in Melbourne following a prolonged illness. Sir Rupert served on the VATC Committee from 1951 to 1991, becoming chairman of the club in 1972, a position he held for 16 years before vacating the post in 1988. He also served on the board of the TAB and as chairman of the trustees of the Caulfield Racecourse Reserve. Melbourne Racing Club Chairman John Dillon said, "Sir Rupert is without doubt the most outstanding and influential administrator in our Club's history and through his many achievements leaves a lasting legacy for Victorian racing in general. He will be sadly missed, but remembered fondly as one of the great gentlemen of the turf." The major grandstand at Caulfield was named for Sir Rupert, and there is already a stakes race bearing his name.

Included in The Jockey Club's functions were licensing, allotment of racing dates, appointment of officials and the interpretation and enforcement of racing rules.

**February 7, 1969...** Jockey **Diane Crump** became the first woman rider in America to compete in a pari-mutuel race, finishing 10th aboard 48-1 shot Bridle 'n Bit in the seventh race at Hialeah.

**February 7, 1996...** A racing oddity occurred at **Oaklawn Park** when the winners of seven consecutive races started from the number one post position.
