### I LOVE A "PARADE"

How can you not love a mare that has been on the board in 13 of 18 career starts, with a pair of Grade I wins to her credit? **Star Parade (Arg)** (Parade Marshal) earned her first victory at the highest level when taking last year's GI Santa Maria H., and she will be back at Santa Anita this afternoon to defend her title. The dark bay made her first five starts of 2004 in Grade I company, following her Santa Maria score with a second in the Mar. 14 Santa Margarita H. The Gary Tanaka colorbearer finished third in the Apple Blossom H. at Oaklawn in April, but was awarded second after a formal protest saw Wild Spirit (Chi) demoted for interference in the stretch. Third in the May 9 Vanity H. in her next outing, Star Parade returned to the winner's circle after a 3 1/2-length tally in the July 11 Milady Breeders' Cup H., but she has not been out since running fourth in the Aug. 8 GII Clement L. Hirsch H. at Del Mar. **Miss Loren (Arg)** (Numerous), on the other hand, has been racing steadily since winning the Hirsch at odds of 34-1. Now seven, the dark bay was a distant third in the Sept. 19 GI Ruffian H. at Belmont and a close-up second in the Oct. 3 GII Lady's Secret Breeders' Cup H. Fourth in her next two tries, she comes off a 4 1/2-length triumph over this track and trip in the Jan. 14 Paseana H.

### "LISA" SHARP IN LAS VIRGENES

**Sharp Lisa** (Dixieland Band) was sent off the 3-5 favorite in yesterday's GI Las Virgenes S. at Santa Anita and lived up to her name, fighting past a game **Memorette** (Memo {Chi}) to win it by 3/4 of a length. It was the highlight of an up-and-down day for Corey Nakatani, who was tossed from his mount in the sixth race, but brushed himself off to honor the call aboard Sharp Lisa. "Any time you get a bruise, you're a little worried about your health, obviously, but I'll be the first one to tell you--if I was hurt, I wouldn't be riding," he said. *Las Virgenes cont. p2*

Sharp Lisa started her career at Calder, taking her first start by an eye-catching 6 1/2 lengths Sept. 12. She changed hands after that outing and made her debut for trainer Doug O'Neill in the Oct. 8 GII Alcibiades S. at Keeneland, where she battled to a gallant second-place finish, a head behind Runway Model. The chestnut was given a short break after running sixth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, returning to be second in the Dec. 19 GI Hollywood Starlet S. She opened 2005 with a win in the Jan. 17 GII Santa Ynez S. and was odds-on to remain unbeaten on the year. After breaking a bit awkwardly, the WinStar-bred filly was rated in second as Charming Colleen set the pace. Sharp Lisa fought her way ahead of that rival in the stretch, then was herself passed by Memorette, but dug down deep to regain the lead at the wire. "She kind of reminds me of Serena's Song," Corey Nakatani said. "She puts her head on the ground and gives you everything she's got. She's got nothing but heart." Tarlow stole the show yesterday, taking them from gate to wire to post an impressive triumph. The dark bay filly first earned attention when attracting a final bid of \$275,000 as a KEESEP yearling. She broke her maiden in her very first start at two and came right back to finish second to champion Halfbridled in the GII Oak Leaf S. A stumbling start cost her any chance in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, where she finished ninth, and she disappeared after that effort. Tarlow tired in her comeback race, running fifth in a Hollywood allowance test July 14, but improved to be second at Del Mar Aug. 20 before taking another break. The time off apparently did her a world of good, as she returned to win a Hollywood allowance Nov. 5 before finishing second behind Alphabet Kisses in an optional claimer Dec. 3. Taking on graded foes in her latest, she led all the way to the final furlong before giving way late to be third in the Jan. 16 GII El Encino S. The 9-2 third choice in this five-horse field, the Moss colorbearer once again went right to the front, cruised along through a half in :46.82 and six furlongs in 1:10.55, and easily held Sweet Lips at bay to the wire. It looked like Scipion could be any kind after flying from last to first to capture his debut at Saratoga Aug. 14, but the dark bay colt failed to make good on that promise in his next three starts. Sent off the even-money favorite in the GIII MGD Cradle S. at River Downs, he was close to the pace early, but couldn't mount a late drive and ran third. The Payson homebred was even more disappointing in the Oct. 9 GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland, weakening to be eighth, and was given the rest of the year off. Scipion made his sophomore bow in a Santa Anita allowance test Jan. 14 and was the beaten favorite once again, running third at 6-5, and was let go at 10-1 with the return to stakes company. Resorting to the tactics that served him so well in his maiden voyage, the three-year-old was lengths behind the next-to-last horse after the opening half and had just one horse beat after six furlongs. He wheeled widest of all as they raced into the stretch and picked off the competition one by one to gain the lead in the final yards and edge clear. "He lost a lot of ground around the turn, had to make up a lot of ground and won with something in reserve. He's a colt with a lot of potential and he handles himself very professionally," Gary Stevens said. As for what's ahead, trainer Patrick Biancone said, "He is a horse we think can go a mile and a half, a mile and a quarter, but you can't rush him." [Click for the brisnet.com chart.](#)

Summerly couldn't get close after being steadied in her career opener at Saratoga Aug. 1, finishing eighth, but came back after a short break to win by 14 lengths in her two-turn debut at Keeneland Oct. 6. The chestnut filly was sent off at 11-1 in the Nov. 27 GII Golden Rod S. at Churchill Downs, but belied her odds to finish third behind **Runway Model** after cutting out the early pace. Bet down to 2-5 in her most recent outing, the Winchell runner dominated once again, cruising to a 9 3/4-length victory in an optional claimer over this track and distance Jan. 17. She was a well-backed 3-2 favorite stepping up off that race. A tracking second as **Cee's Irish (Cee's Tizzy)** set the early fractions, she took over after six furlongs and opened up on the field late to win handily. "After her last race, we felt she was capable [of winning this time]," trainer Steve Asmussen said. "We'll try to prepare her for the Fair Grounds Oaks [GII, Mar. 12]." There were many who doubted the timer when Mr. Light was clocked in a world record 1:31.41 for a mile on the grass as he crossed the finish line first in an allowance at Gulfstream Park Jan. 3. But a review of the race determined the time was correct, and Mr. Light proved the performance was no fluke with this late-running tally. The chestnut horse tried graded company twice with little success last year, finishing seventh in the GII Bernard Baruch H. at Saratoga in July and ending the year with a fifth-place effort behind Host in the Oct. 30 GII Knickerbocker H. at Aqueduct, both at nine furlongs. But, dropped back to a mile for his 2005 opener, he stormed home a 2 3/4 winner over Icy Atlantic and was given another chance at the graded level. Mr. Light was tucked in along the rail in fourth as Host set a pressured pace. Snowdrops ended 2003 with a win in the Pago Hop S. at Fair Grounds in December and, after a vacation, came out running in 2004 as well. She reeled off victories in allowance races at Keeneland Apr. 21 and at Belmont May 21 before capping the streak with a half-length tally in the June 20 Politely S. at Monmouth Park. Raced exclusively in stakes company since, the gray was a troubled second in the Aug. 11 De La Rose S. at Saratoga, a rallying fourth in the Oct. 31 GIII Athenia H. at Belmont, a fast-closing second in the Dec. 4 GIII My Charmer H. at Calder and last time out managed to run third after a rough trip in the Jan. 9 Marshua's River S. at Gulfstream. The second choice to start another streak here, Snowdrops settled just off the leaders while saving ground early, angled outside for running room in the stretch and caught pacesetter Angela's Love at the wire. "She wasn't very lucky [last time]," trainer Christophe Clement said. "She got boxed in...so the plan was to keep her closer to the pace today. We can do that now. **TRIBUTES POUR IN FOR JOHN GAINES**

In a statement released yesterday, D.G. Van Clief, Jr., the commissioner and CEO of the National Thoroughbred Racing Association and president of Breeders' Cup Limited, added his voice to the tributes being paid to the late John R. Gaines. Gaines died Friday afternoon. "John Gaines was a most amazing man," said Van Clief. "He was a family man, an intellectual, a philanthropist, an activist, a visionary and a leader. He had an immense intellectual curiosity and capacity for learning which made him, among other things, an expert in fields as diverse as art, literature, architecture, genetics, farming and politics. John also was a great market timer. He knew when to buy or sell, and that included launching his own ideas.

"Above all, he was a believer in the power of ideas. In addition to being the father of the Breeders' Cup, he'll be remembered as the founder of the Kentucky Horse Park, and the founder of the National Thoroughbred Association, which served as the catalyst in the formation of the NTRA. Locally, he'll also be remembered for his contribution to the creation of the new University of Kentucky Library and, most recently, for his instrumental role in the founding of the Kentucky Equine Educational Project, which, like so many of his contributions, is likely to be an important influence for years to come and, like the Breeders' Cup, will undoubtedly be emulated widely."

Olin Gentry, who helped Gaines form John R. Gaines Thoroughbreds in 1992, is now partnered with Gaines' son Thomas and his daughter Gloria in Gaines-Gentry Thoroughbreds. Gentry told *The Blood-Horse*, "He was very imaginative. He didn't limit his view of his own personal business by status quo boundaries. There was nothing that he viewed necessarily as impossible. He was never afraid to explore new things. I think he was one of the few, if not the only, man in the business who had the vision and determination to create and see through the development of industry causes."

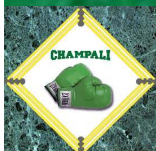
