**STONERSIDE PURCHASES PART OF SIS CITY**

For the second time in the span of a week, Stonerside Stable has purchased controlling interest in a promising young three-year-old.

The Kentucky-based operation, owned by Janice and Robert McNair, acquired a majority share in **Sis City** (Slew City Slew) from the partnership of Sanford Goldfarb, New York Yankees skipper Joe Torre, Michael Dubb and Ira Davis, who had haltered the filly for \$50,000 out of a Saratoga maiden last August. Four starts after the claim, she won the Nov. 27 GII Demoiselle S. by daylight. A

dominating 16-length winner in her seasonal debut, the GII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream Feb. 5, Sis City will remain in the barn of trainer Richard Dutrow, Jr. The bay will carry Stonerside's green and white colors. Last week, Stonerside bought a majority interest in Whirlaway S. winner **Sort it Out** (Out of Place), a three-year-old colt now with conditioner Bob Baffert.

**DESERT WOLF**

**Wolf Whistle (SAf)** (Badger Land) came from off the pace to take Thursday's G3 Al Rashidiya at Nad al Sheba and give trainer Michael de Kock his second consecutive winner of the \$200,000 event. Partnered by Weichong Marwing, who had two additional winners on the card, Wolf Whistle settled near the back early, made progress to take command 400 meters out and dug deep the final strides to eke out the victory over

**Shakis (Ire)** (Machiavellian). **Membership** (Belong to Me), ridden by Richard Hughes, came on late to round out the show spot. "That was a great performance from Wolf Whistle," said de Kock, who also saddled 2004 Al Rashidiya winner Right Approach. "He loves to get into a scrap and he generally puts his head down in the right place." According to de Kock, the gelding will head to the GI Dubai Duty Free Mar. 26. The winner of the 2003 G1 Summer Cup in his native land, the chestnut also scored in the G2 Elevation S. and the G2 Colorado King S. in South Africa.

**DOROTHY SCHARBAUER DIES** Dorothy Turner Scharbauer, who co-owned dual Classic winner and Horse of the Year Alysheba, died early Wednesday morning following a bout with pancreatic cancer. She was 73 years old. Scharbauer was born Mar. 9, 1931, in Midland County, Texas and she and her husband, Clarence, were prominent Quarter Horse owners before moving into Thoroughbreds in 1984. She bought Alysheba for \$500,000 at the 1985 Keeneland July sale from breeder Preston Madden. Scharbauer and her daughter, Pamela, raced Alysheba, who overcame a bad stumble in the stretch of the Kentucky Derby to post a 3/4-length victory over Bet Twice. He would go on to defeat that rival again in the Preakness, but turned in a disappointing fourth-place effort in the Belmont. The loss cost Alysheba a \$5-million Triple Crown bonus, as well as a \$1-million bonus to the horse that amassed the most points in the Triple Crown races. Alysheba was named champion three-year-old of 1987, but missed out on Horse of the Year when he finished second in the GI Breeders' Cup Classic. He atoned for that defeat by winning the 1988 Classic en route to being named Horse of the Year. Graveside services are scheduled for tomorrow at 3 p.m. in Midland County's Fairview Cemetery. A memorial service will be held Saturday at 4 p.m. in Midland's First Presbyterian Church, 800 W. Texas Ave.

**Eddington Pointed Toward Gulfstream Park H.:**

Last year's GI Preakness S. and GI Travers S. third-place finisher **Eddington** (Unbridled), who completed the trifecta once again in the Feb. 5 GI Donn H., is set to return in the Mar. 5 GII Gulfstream Park H. Trainer Mark Hennig isn't concerned with the race's 1 3/16th-mile distance--a half furlong farther than the Donn. "An extra 1/16th isn't going to hurt him one bit, that's for sure," said Hennig. "We just need to see what we do here this weekend [in terms of training] with the weather, but I'm certainly pointing him for that race."

**Sun King Hopes to Shine Saturday:**

Trainer Nick Zito has picked a one-mile allowance race at Gulfstream Saturday for the three-year-old debut of **Sun King** (Charismatic), a good third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. Very much a talked-about horse since running behind Proud Accolade and Afleet Alex in the GI Champagne S. in early October, Sun King was only a length adrift of Wilko in the Juvenile before being given a freshening. "He's really doing well, and I just hope he gets a good race first time out and go from there," said Zito to the *Blood-Horse*. "It's a good race for him to start back in. I'm a traditionalist, and this is the old way. He looks great and has put on a lot of muscle over the winter. I don't think he'll let us down. If he improves, as most of our horses usually do, we'll be OK." The race, the 10th on Saturday's card and the second of two divisions, has also attracted the well-bred **Survivalist** (Danzig) and **Monarch Lane** (Maria's Mon), an impressive maiden winner from Todd Pletcher's barn. *Gulfstream Report cont. p2*
