SITTING "CHILE"

Chilean champion **Isola Piu Bella (Chi)** (Rich Man's Gold) stalked pacesetter **Pampered Princess** (Indian Charlie) and favored **Daydreaming** (A.P. Indy) until the top of the stretch, then swept to the lead and opened up impressively to take yesterday's GIII Sabin H. at Gulfstream by 2 1/2 lengths. The bay ended her

homestand with three straight daylight wins over Group 1 company, besting the boys by seven lengths in the Chilean St. Leger before posting an 8 1/4-length triumph in her South American swan song, the Clasico Haras de Chile, in December of 2003. Shelved for all of 2004, Isola Piu Bella made her U.S. debut in the Jan. 23 Banshee Breeze S. and weakened late to be third behind Pampered Princess. She turned the tables with the tightener under her girth. "Last time, she was coming off that long layoff and I got stuck making a premature move down on the inside," jockey John Velazquez said. "This time [the trip] was perfect and she was much, much more ready for this race." The winner goes next in the Mar. 26 GII Rampart H. [Click for the brisnet.com chart.](http://www.brisnet.com)

Up Through the Ranks...

Sixth in the San Carlos in 2002, **Hasty Kris** found himself facing \$50,000 claimers in 2003, but rose back through the ranks to return to stakes competition, taking the Kenny Noe by a head in his final start that year. He picked up checks in every outing last season, posting a four-length tally in an optional claimer at Santa Anita in October before ending the campaign with third-place finishes in an optional event at Hollywood in November and in his Noe title defense Dec. 18. The 7-10 chalk in his '05 opener vs. optional claimers at Santa Anita Jan. 20, the Florida-bred posted a decisive four-length win and was the 7-2 second choice with the return to a graded stakes. Longshot **Sinister G** (Matty G) cut out the early fractions as Hasty Kris settled at the rail in third. **Perfect Moon** (Malibu Moon) drove to the front as they wheeled out of the turn, but Hasty Kris fought his way through from the inside and was all out to hold off the late charge of Harvard Avenue. "When I got through, I knew I was going to be tough because I had a lot of horse left," Rene Douglas said. "I didn't whip out my whip until the sixteenth pole. It was a hell of a race." Hasty Kris goes next in the Apr. 3 GII Potrero Grande Breeders' Cup H.

The Beaten Favorite Once Again...

Filling the role of beaten favorite for the third straight race, 9-10 **Mass Media** (Touch Gold) loomed a danger on the outside at the top of the lane, getting to within a head of the lead, but faded in the final furlong and finished sixth. "I had perfect striking position, but the winner got through on the inside and we just couldn't outfinish them," jockey Pat Valenzuela said.

He inspired no confidence in the bettors, going off at 25-1, but South Australian insurgent Undoubtedly notched a businesslike win at Caulfield yesterday. He follows in the hoofsteps of his sire, who captured the Blue Diamond in 1999. Undoubtedly had won admirers when he saluted in the Listed Queen Adelaide S. in January, but caused his supporters concern when racing greenly while finishing fifth behind Perfectly Ready in the Feb. 12 G3 Blue Diamond Prelude. The colt still appeared inexperienced here, but, adding blinkers for this Group 1 test, seized the race when the field straightened for home to win by an emphatic 2 1/4-lengths from front-runner Seidnazar. "He's the best horse I've ever had and one of the best I've ever seen," insisted trainer Mark Kavanagh, celebrating his first Group 1 victory in Melbourne. Kavanagh had purchased Undoubtedly for A\$190,000 from the 2004 Magic Millions Adelaide Yearling Sale. He will send the two-year-old on to the Mar. 19 G1 Golden Slipper S. in Sydney. "All going well, he'll be in it," he said.

Jockey Glen Boss enjoyed a memorable day, first riding Fastnet Rock (Aus) to victory in the G1 Oakleigh Plate, then catching a plane north to partner Jymcarew here for trainer Bob Thomsen. Jymcarew, named after a character in a Banjo Patterson ballad and owned by an influential group called the Banjo Club that includes Reg Inglis and former AJC chairman Bob Charley, was slow away and dawdled at the tail of the field before accelerating on the turn. Eremein looked to have the race in his keeping, but Jymcarew attacked close to the line to score by a mere half neck. "This is a very exciting horse and he's a real Derby chance," said Thomsen.

The strongly made colt was allowed plenty of time to find his feet midfield as Segments looked to pull off the upset at 150-1. But, brought to task by jockey Glen Boss, Fastnet Rock applied himself in the waning yards to win by a long neck. The winner of the G1 Lightning S. in his first start of the season, where he beat pin-up filly Alinghi (Aus), he will now look to run his record down Flemington's daunting straight to a perfect four-for-four in the Mar. 12 G1 Newmarket H.

With a win today, undefeated **Silent Witness (Aus)** (El Moxie) will surpass the HK\$40-million mark in career earnings and will rack up consecutive victory number 15. He picked up his 14th score in the Jan. 23 Bauhinia Sprint Trophy. **Cape of Good Hope (GB)** (Inchinar {GB}), runner-up on International Day, returns fresh off a win in the G1 Australia S. last Saturday, while **Natural Blitz (Aus)** (Maroof), third after cutting out the fractions in the Hong Kong Sprint, is "probably 90 percent fit" for his first run since, trainer Danny Shum told *South China Morning Post*.

EDDERY TO RECEIVE OBE

Pat Eddery is to be awarded an honorary Order of the British Empire (OBE) in recognition of his "services to horse racing." The former 11-time champion jockey, whose honor roll includes three wins in the Epsom Derby, at least one success in every British Classic, four renewals of the Prix de l'Arc de Triomphe and a win in the Breeders' Cup Mile, retired at the end of the 2003 flat season having totaled over 4,600 winners. His association with legendary trainers Peter Walwyn, Vincent O'Brien, Guy Harwood and Henry Cecil meant that he partnered some of the great horses of the last four decades, including Dancing Brave, Grundy (Ire), El Gran Senor, Golden Fleece and Bosra Sham. Eddery, who currently manages the Pat Eddery Racing Syndicate, will receive his award in London next month from Tessa Jowell, Secretary of State for Culture, Media and Sport. "This is a great honour," he told *PA Sport*. "I have had a marvellous career and been lucky to have ridden so many good horses for so many wonderful owners and trainers. This is the icing on the cake."
