A PRINCE AMONG HORSES

Good enough to beat champion Kitten's Joy by a head in the GIII Jefferson Cup S. at Churchill Downs last June, **Prince Arch** (Arch) proved himself a Grade I winner yesterday, hanging on gamely to beat **Gigli** (Brz) (Clackson {Brz}) by a nose in the Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. "He knows where the wire is," jockey Brice Blanc said. Making his first start since Saratoga, Prince Arch broke the Gulfstream Park course record that had been set by Honey Ryder just 60 minutes earlier, getting the 11 furlongs in 2:11.44. The bay also gave owner Raymond H. Cottrell Sr. his first-ever Grade I score. "He's the most loyal client I've ever had," said trainer Ken McPeck, who has handled horses for Cottrell for 15 years. "He believed in me before anyone else." **Gulfstream Park BC H. cont. p2**

HOW SWEET IT IS

Honey Ryder (Lasting Approval) caught **Briviesca** (GB) (Peintre Celebre) in the final stride to pick up her first graded-stakes win in the GIII The Very One H. at Gulfstream Park yesterday afternoon. The four-year-old filly had come close in the past, finishing third by 1 1/4 lengths in the 2004 GIII Herecomesthebride S. at Gulfstream, rallying to be a close-up third in the Dec. 18 GII La Prevoyante H. at Calder and most recently finishing fourth, beaten 1 1/2 lengths, in the Feb. 12 GIII Suwanee River H. The final time for the race was, for a short time, a course record 2:11.71, more than a full second faster than the mark set by Host in the Jan. 30 GIII Mac Diarmida H., but a tick slower than Prince Arch was clocked an hour later. **The Very One H. cont. p2**

Six Months to the Day...

It had been six months since **Prince Arch** last faced the starter, posting a head tally over **Mustanfar** (Unbridled) in the Sept. 6 GIII Saranac H. Explaining the extended layoff, Ken McPeck said, "There was nothing seriously wrong with him, we just decided to back off on him for awhile so he could be a good older horse." Off at 7-1 in his return, the modest \$37,000 KEESEP yearling tracked the pace from the inside, moved to the outside for the final drive and just held on over **Gigli**.

Mask Hysteria...

It was an unusual scene in the winner's circle, as owner Raymond Cottrell Sr. and company posed wearing Mardi Gras masks. "Mr. Cottrell's daughter was in New Orleans...and picked up all these masks and they all decided to wear them," said McPeck, who sported one himself as he posed by **Prince Arch's** tail.

"Mr. Cottrell told me he wasn't going to Dubai if everyone didn't wear these masks, and the race in Dubai is \$2 million and I'd like to go." The colt goes next in the Mar. 26 G1 Dubai Sheema Classic.

Riding the Rail to Victory...

Honey Ryder was tucked in behind the leaders while saving ground early. The gray was in tight quarters as they entered the far turn, but managed to fight her way through, then swung wide for the drive and ran down **Briviesca** at the line. "I wanted to save ground and hold my position as long as I could," winning jockey John Velazquez said. "The only time she ever wanted to back out of there was leaving the half-mile [pole], but she hung tough." The winner will point for the Apr. 2 GII Orchid H. Flying High After Fountain of Youth...

Trainer Nick Zito reported yesterday that GII Fountain of Youth S. winner **High Fly** (Atticus) came out of the race in good order and will likely head to the Apr. 2 GI Florida Derby. "That's the next logical spot for High Fly, but you never know how things are going to work out," said Zito, who was saddling the colt for the first time. "We'll talk with the owners and make a decision." Zito has a

quartet of Triple Crown candidates in the barn. Also possible for a tilt at the Triple are Sam F. Davis S. winner **Andromeda's Hero** (Fusaichi Pegasus); GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile third **Sun King** (Charismatic), who captured a Gulfstream allowance in his sophomore bow Feb. 26; and **Noble Causeway** (Giant's Causeway), an allowance winner on the Fountain undercard. "We hope we can keep it going, but things can change," said the Brooklyn native. "You can't boast about tomorrow. You saw what happened last year." Zito had a trio of Derby candidates in 2004--Eurosilver, The Cliff's Edge and Birdstone--but the former was forced to skip the race and the other two were off the board. Birdstone went on the thwart **Smarty Jones'** bid for history by taking the GI Belmont S.

Galloping Grocer Back on Track...

Sleepy Hollow S. winner **Galloping Grocer** (A. P Jet), who was forced out of Saturday's GII Fountain of

Youth S. due to a minor injury sustained Feb. 17, was back in action Sunday at Belmont Park. With jockey Mike Luzzi aboard, the gelding worked five furlongs in a bullet 1:00 3/5. "He galloped out six furlongs in 1:14 and I caught him going the last quarter mile in :23 3/5," said trainer Dominick Schettino. "He did it in hand." Owned by Robert Rosenthal and Bernice Waldbaum, the New York-bred finished fourth in his only start this term, the Feb. 12 Whirlaway S. "We're pointing toward the [Mar. 19] Gotham S. now," confirmed Schettino. "I'm not thrilled about backing him up to one turn after he ran two turns in his first start of the year, but we really don't have a choice."

California Dreamin'...

The next step on the California road to the Kentucky Derby is the Mar. 19 GII San Felipe S. **Don't Get Mad** (Stephen Got Even), runner-up in the Feb. 13 GII San Vicente S., prepped for the 1 1/16-mile test Friday, going six furlongs in 1:14. "He went the last quarter in :24," said trainer Ron Ellis, who also conditions champion Declan's Moon. "The track was a little deep...but when you ask him to run, he kicks it in." Also possible for the San Felipe is **Roman Ruler** (Fusaichi Pegasus), who has not been out since running fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile. But trainer Bob Baffert said yesterday that San Vicente hero **Fusaichi Rock Star** (Wild Wonder) will miss the race. "He got sick on me, but it's nothing major," Baffert said. Pointing for the San Felipe, **Consolidator** (Storm Cat) went six furlongs in 1:12.60 yesterday at Santa Anita. **Texcess** (In Excess {Ire}), who could go in the San Vicente, Gotham or Mar. 26 GII Lane's End S., went five-eighths in 1:00.20 at Hollywood. The Cal-bred was runner-up in the Feb. 12 San Mateo Mile last time out.

On to the Santa Anita Derby...

Trainer Ron Ellis said yesterday that **Declan's Moon** (Malibu Moon) exited his win in Saturday's GIII Santa Catalina S. in fine fettle. "He came out good, ate everything and all systems are go [for the Apr. 9 GI Santa Anita Derby]," Ellis said.

Spanish Chestnut (Horse Chestnut {SAf}), third in the Santa Catalina, will go for the rematch in the Santa Anita Derby. "We'll follow the program," trainer Patrick Biancone said. "He came out of the race very good and we're very pleased by his effort. It's a long way from the cup to the lips, but we should be in good shape on the right day."

...and the Louisiana Derby...

Patrick Biancone's other Triple Threat, **Scipion** (A.P. Indy), worked a mile at Santa Anita yesterday, going in 1:41 under jockey Gary Stevens. "He looked good," Biancone said. "Gary was happy with him." The winner of the Feb. 12 GIII Risen Star S. at Fair Grounds, the dark bay goes next in the Mar. 12 GII Louisiana Derby. He ships to Cajun country Thursday.

CONGRATS TO DUBAI? Trainer Richard Mandella said yesterday that he might send GI Santa Anita H. runner-up **Congrats** (A.P. Indy) to Nad Al Sheba for the Mar. 26 G1 Dubai World Cup. The bay was 1 3/4 lengths behind stablemate **Rock Hard Ten** (Kris S.) in the Big 'Cap. "They came back in great shape," said Mandella. "Rock Hard Ten is a little light. He's gone through a lot this meet and he's a little lighter than I'd like, so I'm going to give him a little rest. Congrats is the opposite. He's a big, heavy horse and a good doer and I'm giving serious thought to taking him right on to Dubai."

A winner of three races, the Ogden Phipps homebred placed in Aqueduct's 1995 Gill Discovery H. From five crops of racing age, Hunting Hard has sired 59 winners, including Bog Hunter, a three-time stakes winner and earner of \$225,167.

Fogelsonger Released from Trauma Unit Following Spill:

Ryan Fogelsonger, who sustained injuries in a spill at Laurel Park Saturday, was released from the Shock Trauma Unit at the University of Maryland Medical Center in Baltimore Sunday. Lucky Valid, who finished second in the second race of the day, fell just past the wire, dropping the 2002 Eclipse Award-winning apprentice on his head. The 23-year-old was released after X-rays came back negative, but suffered a strained neck. "When I arrived [at the hospital], he was sitting up, alert and smiling," said Kevin Witte, Fogelsonger's agent. "He looked nothing like he did three hours earlier. He is obviously very sore, but we dodged another bullet." The rider currently ranks fourth at Laurel's current winter meet standings with 28 victories.

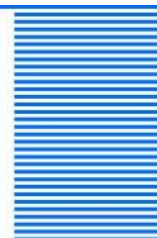
