Garrett Gomez, currently sixth in the Santa Anita jockey standings, takes the reins for the first time aboard **Personal Legend**. But the 37-year-old veteran does not intend on watching any of her previous races, nor does he plan on speaking with Alex Solis, who has ridden the mare in the past. "I'll just talk to [trainer] Bobby [Frankel] and do what he wants me to do," Gomez said. "He'll tell me what to do with the horse and most of the time, whatever he tells you they can do, usually they can do." Alinghi has since gone on to overwhelm her own sex in the G1 Robert Sangster S. Feb. 23. She is in receipt of seven pounds from the favorite in Saturday's race.

to be run Sat., Apr. 9, are Eclipse Award winning two-year-old filly **Sweet Catomine** (Storm Cat), who won the GIII Santa Ysabel S. in her lone start this year and goes next in this weekend's GI Santa Anita Oaks; **Sharp Lisa** (Dixieland Band), winner of the GI

Las Virgenes S. and second in Keeneland's GII Darley Alcibiades S. last fall; **Runway Model** (Petionville), the Alcibiades victress who was a troubled third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies; **Summerly** (Summer Squall), the GIII Silverbulletday S. winner who will face Runway Model in this weekend's GII Fair Grounds Oaks; and **Sis City** (Slew City Slew), runaway winner of the GII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream Feb. 5. Nominees

to the Toyota Blue Grass, scheduled for Sat., Apr. 16, are headed by **Declan's Moon** (Malibu Moon), undefeated in his five career starts, and **Wilko** (Awesome Again), who upset the field in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile last October. Sweet Catomine also holds a Blue Grass entry,

Trainer Todd Pletcher has nominated 16 horses to the \$750,000 event, including GI Champagne S. and GII Hutcheson S. victor **Proud Accolade** (Yes It's True) and **Bandini** (Fusaichi Pegasus), runner-up in the Fountain of Youth. Over the years, 18 horses have used the Blue Grass as a steppingstone to success in the Kentucky Derby, most recently Thunder Gulch in 1995.

**SALT CHAMP RETIRED** Salt Champ (Arg) (Salt Lake), the winner in her U.S. debut of the GI Santa Monica H. Jan. 30, has been retired from racing after suffering what trainer Richard Mandella described to *Daily Racing Form* as a "strained tendon." The five-year-old mare was a star in her native country, winning four of her seven starts, including a trio of Group 1 events. She was also second as a two-year-old in the G1 Estrellas Juvenile Fillies. In the Santa Monica, Salt Champ lingered at the back of the pack beneath Gary Stevens before unleashing a powerful stretch run which carried her past defending race champion Island Fashion. Mandella said the mare could make it back to the races, but taking into account her age and accomplishments, "she's done enough," he said. Salt Champ retires with five wins from eight starts and earnings of \$217,541.

**Gygistar Passes Richter Scale for Allowance:**

Edward P. Evans' **Gygistar** (Prospectors Gamble) is classy enough to try tomorrow's GII Richter Scale Breeders' Cup Sprint Championship, but has instead been entered by trainer Mark Hennig for a one-mile allowance test this afternoon. "When you enter an allowance race at Gulfstream, you never know who's going to turn up," Hennig said. "But I'm comfortable with the spot I'm in." Now six, Gygistar took last year's GIII Westchester H. at today's distance. He makes his first start since finishing fifth in the Charles Hadry H. at Pimlico Nov. 20. Also in the field is **Coach Jimi Lee** (Roar). Second to Lion Tamer in last year's Richter Scale, the five-year-old attempts to regroup from a pair of subpar efforts, including a 12th as the favorite in the Jan. 29 Super S. at Tampa Bay Downs.

**Mustanfar to Miss Pan Am:**

Shadwell Stable's **Mustanfar** (Unbridled), third by a half-length in the GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. last Saturday, will not return for the Apr. 2 GII Pan American H., trainer Kiaran McLaughlin said yesterday. "He came back great, but Sunday's race might have been a little too quick back for him [following Mustanfar's Feb. 10 allowance victory]," the conditioner explained. "To come back in the Pan Am would be a little too quick once again." The runner-up in the GIII Tampa Bay Derby last year, the chestnut colt made a successful switch to the turf late last fall, winning the GIII Sycamore Breeders' Cup S. at Keeneland before finishing fifth in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf.
