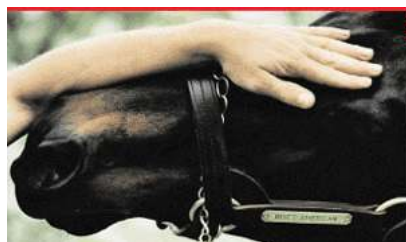

**SUN KING SHINES; ROCKY START FOR HARBOR**

Taking his record for the year to two-for-two, **Sun King** (Charismatic) led from gate to wire to win the GIII Tampa Bay Derby yesterday. But things did not go so smoothly for previously unbeaten **Rockport Harbor** (Unbridled's Song). Off at 8-5 in his three-year-old bow, the GIII Rebel S. at Oaklawn, the gray stumbled at the start and had to rush up to take the lead. He was in front nearly every step, but was caught in the final jump by 9-2 shot **Greater Good** (Intidab). **A Horse With a Future...**

**Consolidator** earned himself a trip to the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at Lone Star Park with a handy score in the Oct. 9 GI Breeders' Futurity at Keeneland. The \$1.25 million KEESEP yearling acquitted himself well that afternoon, finishing a respectable fourth after getting bumped at the 3/16 pole. He made his first start of the new year in the San Vicente, but weakened late to run off the board. Wayne Lukas blamed himself for the subpar performance. "I just did a poor job the first time," Lukas said. "I think I overestimated his ability. These are good three-year-olds and I was a little bit light on him. I probably pampered him a little bit, but...I tried to correct it and I asked him to do a little bit more [before the San Felipe]. His work tab was a lot more serious and I schooled him." The extra effort did the job. Bob and Beverly Lewis' runner toyed with his rivals yesterday, winning as much the best. The final time of 1:40.11 easily bested the old stakes record of 1:41 1/5 set by Pole Position in 1979. **Giacomo** held off **Don't Get Mad** for second, and will go next in the Apr. 9 GI Santa Anita Derby.

**Rome Wasn't Built in a Day...**

Making his first start since finishing fifth as the 2-1 chalk in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile, **Roman Ruler** (Fusaichi Pegasus) was sent off the 3-1 chalk here. He was in tight quarters while on the bit early, raced four wide down the backstretch and gave way late. He was eased in the final yards.

His perfect record didn't look in danger at the top of the lane, but Rockport Harbor suffered the first defeat of his career when Greater Good got up to take the Rebel in the very last jump. Rockport Harbor battled foot problems as he prepped for his seasonal debut and trainer John Servis had warned he might not be 100 percent for his first start since his victory in the Nov. 27 GI Remsen S. The colt's chances were further compromised when he bobbed at the break, but he was soon sailing along on a clear lead. He had 2 1/2

lengths on the field after six furlongs and was still 1 1/2 lengths in front at midstretch, but Greater Good came flying to catch him at the wire. It was the fifth score in the last six starts for Greater Good, who ended 2004 with a win in the Nov. 27 GI Kentucky Jockey Club S. and made it two in a row in the Feb. 19 South-west S. Survivalist signaled his readiness for stakes competition with a second behind Sun King in a Gulfstream allowance Feb. 26. The Phipps homebred closed his two-race juvenile campaign with an 8 1/2-length maiden tally at Belmont Oct. 9. He finished third in an entry-level allowance at Gulfstream Feb. 5, but was moved into second via a stewards' DQ. Returning to New York here, the dark bay was allowed to settle off rapid splits, but edged closer as they dashed off the six furlongs in 1:09.22. There were four in front of him in the stretch, but he closed resolutely on the far outside. "Once we got into the lane, I let my horse drift out into the clear and he put his hand down and ran," said winning jockey Richie Migliore. Jockey Jean-Luc Samyn, aboard Naughty New Yorker, claimed foul for alleged interference on the turn, but the claim was disallowed. Sun King hit the radar with third-place finishes in the GI Champagne S. and GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile at two, and came back after a winter break to take a Feb. 26 Gulfstream allowance test by 5 3/4 lengths over Gotham hero Survivalist. Off at 1-20 to earn his first graded score here, the dark bay went right to the front from his inside post and carved out easy fractions of :48 3/5 and 1:13 2/5. It looked like he might be in trouble at the top of the lane as Forever Wild attacked on the outside and Medigating (Dolphin Street {Fr}) came at him from the rail, but Sun King found another gear and opened it up late to win handily. "He's on top compared to other horses," trainer Nick Zito said. "He has the credentials and he's a special horse. He always runs a good race." Rapid Proof rode the rail to pull off a huge upset in this \$500,000 contest. It was his first stakes victory since taking Keeneland's Hopemont S. as a two-year-old in 2002. At three, the Dolphus Morrison homebred finished second in the Forerunner S. at Keeneland and third in the GIII Jefferson Cup at Churchill. He had an indifferent season last year, winning just once in six starts, an allowance at Keeneland Oct. 27. After missing by a head in a local optional claimer on New Year's Eve, the dark bay lost by the same margin when third to America Alive in the Col. E. R. Bradley H. Jan. 15. In his most recent start, he completed the trifecta in the Fair Grounds Breeders' Cup H. Feb. 26, but was given no respect at the windows this time. Favorably drawn in sixth through three-quarters in 1:13 2/5. First or second in 11 of her 14 tries over the Tampa turf, Rizzi Girl proved the horse for the course once again here. The gray mare was racing for a tag during a trek to the northeast this summer, finishing third for a \$35,000 tag at Saratoga in July and fifth at that level in September. Stratum settled in third early, took the lead with 900 meters remaining and shrugged off all latecomers as though they were no more than bothersome flies. "He had his ears pricked all the way, he was never going to get beat," Beasley said. "He relaxed beautifully and I let him slide a little at the 400 meters. He got tired the last bit and wanted to run about, but it didn't make any difference." Fashions Afield flattened herself out in a gritty performance down the outside, while flashy chestnut Media came running on the inside with a late burst of speed.

Diminutive filly Hollow Bullet, winner of the G1 VRC Oaks last spring, combined with in-form Glen Boss to capture the first of five straight Group 1 races at Rosehill Saturday. **KENTUCKY BREEDER INCENTIVE PROGRAM**

**SIGNED INTO LAW** The bill to create a new breeder incentive program for horses in the Bluegrass State was signed into law by Gov. Ernie Fletcher Friday morning. The law will move the taxes paid on stud fees after July 1 of this year to three development funds covering all horse breeds in Kentucky. The Kentucky Thoroughbred Breeders' Incentive Fund will get 80 percent of the monies generated by the bill, which could mean as much as \$11 million to the Thoroughbred breeding industry in the state. Standardbreds will get 13 percent, with 7 percent going to a program for other breeds. The Kentucky Racing Authority will help each group devise a distribution plan for the funds. "This is a great day for Kentucky's signature industry," said Claria Horn Shadwick, the executive director of the Kentucky Equine Education Project. "Horses mean jobs and economic prosperity for our state. We thank our state leaders for recognizing the value of this industry and working with us to promote and grow it."

**Santa Anita Vet Encouraged by Test Results:**

Dr. Rick Arthur, the veterinarian in charge of Santa Anita's testing for TCO2 levels [total carbon dioxide], said he is greatly encouraged that the new testing program for "milkshaking" is working. According to Arthur, 3,628 horses have been tested during the first 59 days of the 85-day winter/spring meeting and only five have exceeded the threshold for TCO2. "The Jeff Mullins-T.J. Simers controversy has caused a distortion of the extent of the milkshaking problem," Arthur said. "The fact is our program has been very successful. I would challenge any other professional sport to produce numbers as good as ours."
