Blood-Horse

A MEGA PERFORMANCE

The diminutive **Megahertz (GB)** (Pivotal) belied her tiny stature with a monstrous turn of foot when she roared from off the pace to catch **Katdogawn (GB)** (Bahhare) in the final strides of Sunday's GII Santa Ana H. at Santa Anita. The Michael Bello-owned filly, first under the wire in this race last year, was taken down and placed seventh, and it was Katdogawn who benefitted that day, moving up from second to gain the win. This time around, the early stages of the race unfolded in similar fashion, but the result proved very different. Content to track the early pace in seventh, Megahertz swung wide on the second turn, closed on the leaders, while racing five wide, heading for home and closed like a freight train late to out game Katdogawn. "She's something else, this filly," said trainer Bobby Frankel. "It brings tears to my eyes to watch her run. She's got to be one of my favorites, you know, I mean of all horses. She's little and she just does things that amaze you all the time." (cont. p2)

HURRICANE LILAH

At the ripe old age of eight, Hobeau Farm's **Lilah** (Defrere) gave her juniors an education in a front-running tour-de-force in Sunday's GIII Hurricane Bertie H. at Gulfstream Park. Quickly to the front, the robust mare carved out solid early splits of :22.33, :44.79 and 1:08.98 and appeared poised for take-off turning for home. With graded stakes winners **Bohemian Lady** (Carson City) and **Molto Vita** (Carson City) breathing down her neck with a sixteenth left to go, the Allen Jerkens trainee kicked it up a notch and drew clear late en route to an emphatic win. **Forty Moves** (Gold Fever) rallied from off the pace to finish second, while Molto Vita held on to collect third-place money. Favored Bohemian Lady came home a tired fourth, beaten 5 3/4 lengths. "It's amazing for her to be this good at her age," said Jerkens. "I'll talk with [Hobeau's Jack Dreyfus]. We might breed her or try and run her again. We'll have to see what might be next." (cont. p2)

Trainer Tim Ritchey indicated yesterday that the colt is still under consideration for the GII Arkansas Derby Apr. 16. The three-year-old is expected to be placed on antibiotics for the next five days before resuming training.

Prince Arch Strong in Preparation for Sheema

Prince Arch (Arch) showed that the trip overseas had taken little out of him when he turned a routine four-furlong work into an extended six-furlong move at Nad al Sheba Sunday. Hanne Jorgensen, assistant to trainer Ken McPeck, wanted an easy half-mile work for the four-year-old, but Prince Arch had other things on his mind. Timed in :50.18 for the half, the colt showed no signs of tiring. "He tried to run off after the work," said Jorgensen. "It took me about six furlongs to pull him up." McPeck, who is expected to arrive in Dubai Wednesday, has another bullet ready with **Durban Thunder (Brz)** (Royal Academy), who is expected to run in the G2 UAE Derby. The colt worked 1000 meters, but no time was recorded for the move. Even without the benefit of the clock, connections remain confident that the colt is moving in the right direction. "He went fast and he came back to the barn great," said Jorgensen. "In the last week, he's turned around and he's like a new horse. He's worked twice since then and he's felt great."

Alkaadhem Confirmed for Duty Free

Trainer Marcus Tregoning announced Sunday that **Alkaadhem (GB)** (Green Desert), a 3/4-length winner over defending Duty Free champion **Right Approach (GB)** (Machiavellian) in the Mar. 5 G2 Jebel Hatta, has been confirmed for the 1777-meter event Saturday. "He shows so much speed that the nine furlongs of the Duty Free might suit him better [than the 12-furlong Sheema Classic]," said Tregoning, who sent the horse to Dubai five weeks ago. "Nad al Sheba is not everyone's track, but Alkaadhem has settled beautifully and seems to love the surface," he explained. "There ought to be plenty of pace on, which suits us, and I hope we get lucky again." The conditioner indicated that the colt may have one more work Wednesday.

Mabee H. in 2003, collected a pair of victories in graded stakes company last term--the 10-furlong GII San Gorgonio H. and the nine-furlong GII Santa Barbara H.--before a distant 11th over the yielding turf at Lone Star Park in the GI Breeders' Cup F/M Turf Oct. 30. The chestnut concluded the season with a close second to Pellegrino (Brz) in the GI Hollywood Turf Cup Dec. 4. Roman Ruler Out of Derby Picture

Trainer Bob Baffert has withdrawn **Roman Ruler** (Fusaichi Pegasus) from Kentucky Derby consideration after his last-place finish in Saturday's GII San Felipe S. "The Preakness, there might be a shot, but right now he's definitely out of the Derby," Baffert said. Roman Ruler, winner of last year's GII Norfolk S., missed training time this year with a quarter crack. "I had to run him to find out if he could make it," Baffert explained. "If he didn't run yesterday, I was going to be completely out of the picture. Roman Ruler is a good horse and I'm going to have to cut that quarter out. He needs three weeks of nothing to let it heal."

San Felipe Runners Eye Next Starts

Consolidator (Storm Cat) came out of his record-setting performance in the San Felipe in fine shape and will likely make his next start in the Apr. 16 GI Blue Grass S. at Keeneland. "I'm leaning towards my original plans of staying with the Blue Grass," said trainer D. Wayne Lukas. "I get the extra week and I like the timing of it. I'm not saying we wouldn't run [in the Apr. 9 GI Santa Anita Derby]; we could."

Don't Get Mad (Stephen Got Even), third in the San Felipe, will make his next start in either the Santa Anita Derby or in the Apr. 16 GII Arkansas Derby at Oaklawn Park. "Right now I'm leaning towards Santa Anita," said trainer Ron Ellis.

Tampa Bay Downs Shatters Record:

Tampa Bay Downs shattered records in total handle, attendance and single-race handle during its 13-race Festival Day card Saturday. Total all-source handle on the day was \$6,889,834, topping the previous mark of \$5,358,919 set Feb. 26. A new record for attendance was also set at the 79-year-old oval, with 10,246 patrons turning out, eclipsing the previous standard of 9,765 set Apr. 8, 1990. With the help of the up-and-coming Triple Crown star Sun King, the GIII Tampa Bay Derby set a single-race handle record when \$1,663,284 was wagered on the race. Sun King trained by Nick Zito, won by 3 1/4 lengths.
