MANDELLA HOPING TO DOUBLE UP CUPS

Trainer Richard Mandella captured his first G1 Dubai World Cup last year with Pleasantly Perfect, who broke from post seven. This year, he will saddle Claiborne Farm and Adele Dilschneider's **Congrats** (A.P. Indy), who has drawn the same post. "I'm happy [about the post], but at a mile and a quarter, it doesn't make much difference," Mandella explained. "I believe more in good luck and bad luck than in good draws and bad draws." Mandella compared **Congrats** to last year's hero.

"He's similar to Pleasantly Perfect," he said. "They're both healthy, strong horses who can take the travelling. He's not as established as Pleasantly Perfect was, [but] this horse is a horse I think is coming up to this level." Fellow U.S. challenger **Roses in May** (Devil His Due), who just might be dictating the pace, will break from the 12 hole. "We're not going to tip our hands on the strategy, but the horse doesn't come from the clouds," owner Ken Ramsey quipped.

SALT LAKE COLT TOPS OBS FINALE

An outstanding son of Salt Lake topped the second and final session of the Ocala Breeders' Sales Company's March selected two-year-olds in training sale when David Clark's Iron Horse Racing purchased him for \$320,000 from the consignment of Barry Eisaman's Eisaman Equine. For the day, OBS reported 135 horses sold for a gross of \$11,414,000, compared with 118 bringing \$11,535,000 in 2004. The average was \$84,548 compared with \$97,754 last year while the median was \$62,000, down from last year's figure of \$65,000. A dozen horses brought more than \$200,000, compared with 15 last year. The buy back rate was 40.5 percent with 92 horses failing to find new homes, compared with 34.8 percent last year.

Godolphin colorbearer **Grand Hombre** (Grand Slam) is now "only 50-50" to go postward after coming up with foot troubles. "Grand Hombre bruised a foot a couple of days ago, and it is touch and go whether he makes it in time," Simon Crisford, Godolphin racing manager, explained. "He finished fourth last year and we were hopeful of another solid performance, but this setback has come at a bad time."

Dettori Eager to Dish...

Jockey Frankie Dettori will have the mount aboard several fancied Godolphin runners, including Arc runner-up **Cherry Mix (Fr)** (Linamix {Fr}) in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic and unbeaten champion **Shamardal**

(Giant's Causeway) in the G2 UAE Derby. The ebullient reinsman expressed his enthusiasm for four-year-old Cherry Mix. "[He] is a class act who finished second in the Arc, and I think he has an outstanding chance," Dettori said. "We were hoping that he would be our Dubai World

Cup horse, but, unfortunately, he did not take to the sand. Back on the grass, however, you will see the real Cherry Mix, and I am looking for a big run." Shamardal, a U.S. Triple Crown nominee, will be making his three-year-old debut while trying the dirt for the first time. The bay was perfect in three turf starts last season. "You have to be cautious, because he has never run on the surface," Dettori continued. "He has been working well enough on it at Al Quoz [training center], but it is completely different at racing pace. Though he has the class, being a Dewhurst winner, we are very much going in there to test the temperature of the water."

OBS March, By the Numbers...

Overall, the two-day auction saw an increase in gross, with 323 horses selling for a March sale record \$26,399,000, compared with 245 hips selling for \$22,563,000 last year. The average was \$81,731, a decline over last year's mark of \$92,094, while the median decreased from \$60,000 in 2004 to \$55,000. Twenty-six horses brought more than \$200,000, the same amount as last year. The buy-back rate decreased from 33.4 percent in 2004 to 31.5 percent this year. "The 40-percent RNA mark today was a little disappointing, but overall I think it was a very good sale," said Tom Ventura, OBS general manager and director of sales. "There was a lot of action at all levels during the first day, but we just didn't sustain that today. This sale continues to roll along. It's just tough to compare with last year's numbers."

Tale of the Topper...

The session-topping colt, who was bred in Kentucky by John T.L. Jones Jr. and Troy Seale, was purchased by Eisaman Equine for \$155,000 at the 2004 Keeneland September yearling sale. Produced from the stakes winning What a Hoist mare Slinky Lady, the full brother to multiple stakes winner Lake Lady worked a quarter-mile in :21 3/5 March 20. David Clark, a resident of Naples, Fla., said he believed going into the sale that the muscular son of Salt Lake would be the sale topper. "His work was really good and he is a chunky kind of horse," said Clark. "I really thought he would bring a lot more." The youngster is bound for Oaklawn Park where he will be trained by Bob Holthus, who assisted Clark in choosing the horse. Holthus conditions GIII Rebel S. winner Greater Good for Lewis Lakin. Eisaman Equine also consigned the sale's top-priced horse, a son of Yes It's True, purchased by Jimmy Bell, acting on behalf of Sheikh Mohammed's Darley, for \$900,000 on the sale's opening day.



WILKO STILL TARGETING SA DERBY The GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile hero **Wilko** (Awesome Again) has come out of his fourth-place finish in last Saturday's GII San Felipe S. with a quarter crack, but is still expected to make the line-up for the GI Santa Anita Derby Apr. 9. "There was still some heat in the foot today, but we're soaking it and plan to put a patch on it in the next few days," trainer Craig Dollase explained. "Then we'll get back to the track with him. We'll know more next week." The wet weather in California forced **Scipion** (A.P. Indy) to work over a turf course labeled firm. The GIII Risen Star S. winner went seven furlongs in 1:28.40. "It was just a precaution," trainer Patrick Biancone said. Scipion is listed as probable for the Santa Anita Derby.
