SPANISH CHESTNUT HEADS THE LANE'S END

Derrick Smith's and Michael Tabor's **Spanish Chestnut** (Horse Chestnut {SAF}) has been installed the 5-2 morning-line choice in his attempt to collect his second graded stakes victory of the season in Saturday's GII Lane's End S. at Turfway Park. The chestnut, a 3/4-length winner in the GII San Rafael S. at Santa Anita Jan. 15 and third behind Declan's Moon and Going Wild in the GII Santa Catalina S. Mar. 5, has drawn the eight hole in the field of nine. Trainer Nick Zito, who is

well represented in the sophomore ranks again this season with the likes of graded stakes winners Sun King and High Fly, is represented here by **Andromeda's Hero** (Fusaichi Pegasus). The Robert LaPenta-owned colt won the Sam F. Davis S. at Tampa Feb. 26. The race has an added incentive this year with contestants competing for a variety of charitable interests. Six Northern Kentucky charities having chosen a horse to represent them, and the charity whose horse finishes first, or ahead of the other horses chosen, will receive \$10,000 from Fifth Third Bank and The Yearlings. The remaining charities will each receive \$2,000.

KITTEN'S JOY AND PRINCE ARCH TO ARC

A pair of top American turf specialists could represent team U.S.A. in France this fall in the G1 Prix de 'Arc de Triomphe at Longchamp Oct. 2, according to *Blood-Horse* Thursday. Ken and Sarah Ramsey's **Kitten's Joy** (El Prado {Ire}), who won six of eight starts last year and finished runner-up to Better Talk Now in the GI Breeders' Cup Turf at Lone Star Oct. 30, could lead the charge, while **Prince Arch** (Arch) may conclude an extended European campaign in the French jewel.

Prince Arch handed Kitten's Joy his only other defeat last term when the chestnut finished a head behind his foe in the GIII Jefferson Cup at Churchill Downs June 12. "I have a big ego," Ken Ramsey told *Blood-Horse*. "Just the fact that I could win one of Europe's premier races makes me want to run in the Arc. The prize money-that's not great, but the prestige makes me want to run there. It's three weeks before the Breeders' Cup, but I would rather accept the challenge of winning a race like the Arc than win the Breeders' Cup. We tried that last year and came in second." According to Ramsey, the colt, who is back in training and probable to make his first start back at the allowance level, is likely to prep for the Arc in Europe. Also in the hunt for glory overseas, trainer Ken McPeck said Thursday that he is considering the G1 King George VI and Queen Elizabeth Diamond S. at Newbury for Prince Arch before capping off the season with the Arc. "I don't think [a trans-Atlantic campaign] is something to be afraid of," McPeck told *Blood-Horse*. "Horses will overcome a lot of different things." Prince Arch, owned by Raymond Cottrell, prepped for a tilt at this weekend's Dubai Sheema Classic with a win the GI Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. Mar. 6.

Don't Get Mad To Santa Anita Derby

Don't Get Mad (Stephen Got Even), originally slated to contest the Arkansas Derby at Oaklawn Apr. 16, will take a shot at the Apr. 9 GI Santa Anita Derby instead, according to owner B. Wayne Hughes. "The principle reason we weren't going to run here was Declan's Moon," said Hughes, explaining the change in plans. "But because he got hurt, there was no reason not to run. We were ducking Declan's Moon, not because we didn't think Don't Get Mad could beat him, but because [Declan's Moon] is by Malibu Moon and that's my stallion in Kentucky [at Castleton Lyons]. It became a little bit of a conflict." Second to Fusaichi Rock Star in the GII San Vicente S. Feb. 13, the bay finished third behind Consolidator and Giacomo in the Mar. 19 GII San Felipe S. Don't Get Mad is likely to face juvenile filly champion Sweet Catomine in the nine-furlong Kentucky Derby prep. "I think she is a tough filly, but our horse is doing well and we think he's going to run a big race."

Papi Chullo Sharp in Florida Derby Drill

Papi Chullo (Comeonmom), who suffered a slight setback when he bruised a foot earlier this month, was back on course for the Apr. 2 GI Florida Derby with a bullet five-furlong workout Thursday morning. Under exercise rider Findlay Bishop, he covered the distance in :59 2/5 over the fast Gulfstream Park main track. "It was a very good work and he pulled up like a freight train," said owner Greg Norman. "His foot was fine. We'll change his shoes later this week and they'll be the ones he races on." The roan, who finished second to Going Wild in the nine-furlong Sham S. at Santa Anita Feb. 5, had to settle for fourth in his latest outing in the GI Fountain of Youth S. at Gulfstream Park Mar. 5. "He had glue-on shoes going into the Fountain of Youth and he got a bruise under there before we could get them off. He still managed to race with it." Trainer Salvador Gonzalez indicated that the colt will work again Tuesday ahead of his Florida Derby engagement.

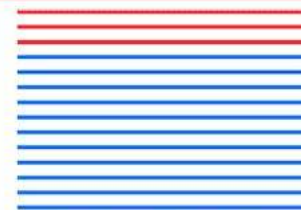

Lightly regarded in this main-track sprint, Dashboard Drummer was allowed to settle well off the pace, but responded with a strong stretch run when asked to win going away. Multiple graded stakes winner Well Fancied, making his first start in nearly a year, pressed Spooky Mulder through fractions of :22.52, :46.10 and :57.91 before outfinishing that rival for second.

Strangles Cases Declining at Churchill:

A second round of tests performed on horses quarantined at Churchill Downs' Trackside Louisville show that the number of confirmed cases of strangles has declined, and there is no evidence that the disease has spread beyond the two quarantined barns. Of the 49 horses tested, 40 were negative for strangles. Horses that had tested negative during both rounds have been moved to another quarantine barn. A third round of tests is scheduled for next week. "We are encouraged that this second round of test results indicate that the precautionary measures recommended by state agriculture officials and implemented at Trackside are having their desired effect," said Steve Sexton, president of Churchill Downs.

Morphine Case Against Baffert Dismissed:

A nearly five-year old morphine case against trainer Bob Baffert was dismissed yesterday by the California Horse Racing Board, which met in an executive session at Bay Meadows Racetrack. The case began in May 2000 when Nautical Look tested positive for morphine following a first-level allowance victory at Hollywood Park. During yesterday's testimony before the Board, Dr. B. William Bell, the official veterinarian for the CHRB, stated that the amount of the drug found in the post-race test was "pharmacologically insignificant and most likely due to environmental contamination," *The Blood-Horse* reports. Baffert's counsel Steve Schwartz presented new evidence stating that in May and June of 2000, 13 out of 95 blood samples were found to be "suspect" for opiates, an unusually high number and consistent with environmental contamination, according to Dr. Stephen Baker, chief chemist for the Louisiana Racing Commission. In rendering his decision, Administrative Law Judge Timothy S. Thomas said, "These facts and [Baffert's] success as a trainer support the conclusion he had nothing to gain and a great deal to lose by the use of a banned substance on this horse," *The Blood-Horse* reported.
