Thirteen horses had their names tossed into the hat for the 10th running of the \$6-million G1 Dubai World Cup, to be held tonight in Nad Al Sheba. Who will come out on top? Trainer Saeed bin Suroor has saddled four of the last six World Cup winners, but his 2005 hopeful **Grand Hombre** (Grand Slam) was withdrawn yesterday

after suffering a bruised foot. His defection leaves home team Godolphin without a representative in the race for the first time since its inception. American horsemen have accounted for four victories in this event as well. Can Richard Mandella take back-to-back runnings after sending out Pleasantly Per-

fect to beat Bobby Frankel's Medaglia d'Oro last year? Mandella has his hopes riding on **Congrats** (A.P. Indy) this time. Seven-for-18 lifetime, the big bay bids for his first win at the highest level after running second in the Mar. 5 GI Santa Anita H. last out. "His last race showed we're close to being there," he said. But the top seed from the States is **Roses in May** (Devil His Due). The dark bay, first or second in 11 of his 12 starts, ended last season with a second in the Oct. 30 GI Breeders' Cup Classic and opened 2005 with a runner-up finish in the Feb. 5 GI Donn H. "He has tactical speed, so he certainly has a good style for this race-track," owner Ken Ramsey said. "He's feeling great--he reared up this morning--and has a lot of life in him." **Dubai World Cup cont. p2**

Already a Grade I winner in the U.S. and a Group 1 winner in his native country, **Pico Central** (Brz) (Spend a Buck) has a chance to add another elite international event to his resume in today's G1 Dubai Golden Shaheen at six furlongs. Off since running third in the Nov. 27 GI Cigar Mile H., he missed a scheduled start in the Feb. 26 GII San Carlos H. due to foot problems, but won five of seven last year, including the GI Carter H., GI Met Mile and GI Vosburgh S. Looking to turn the tables on Mandella, Bobby Frankel brings in **Lundy's Liability (Brz)** (Candy Stripes). The five-year-old took the 2004 G2 UAE Derby in his last trip to Dubai. Jockey Pat Valenzuela, who was in the irons when the bay finished fifth in the Big 'Cap, has the mount once again. "I was on the inside the whole way [last time] and he really didn't have anywhere to go in the stretch," Valenzuela explained. "I expect him to be in contention entering the stretch [this time]."

Hitting the Jackpot?...

A \$145,000 FTFEB juvenile, **Jack Sullivan** (Belong to Me) won two of 13 starts while racing in Europe at two and three. He shipped to Dubai to start his four-year-old campaign and is two-for-three on the year, taking the Feb. 10 G3 Maktoum Challenge-Round 2 over G2 Round 3 hero **Chiquitin (Arg)** (Fitzcarraldo {Arg}), and the Mar. 5 Listed Burj Nahaar. "He loves the track, he's in superb nick and, though it is a tougher field than I had hoped, he has done us proud at the Carnival and I am sure he won't let us down," trainer Gerard Butler said.

Ready to Run ...

A length behind Attraction (GB) when second in the G1 Irish 1000 Guineas, **Alexander Goldrun (Ire)** (Gold Away {Ire}) captured the G1 Prix de l'Opera at Longchamp in October before capping 2004 with a victory in the G1 Hong Kong Cup Dec. 12. Both of those wins were at 10 furlongs, but today's shorter distance shouldn't be a problem. "It's probably just as competitive as Hong Kong," trainer Jim Bolger told *Racing Post*. "She doesn't lack pace and she is in much the same form as Hong Kong. The track is perfect and the trip is no problem."

Right Approach (GB) (Machiavellian), who dead-heated for first in last year's Duty Free, returned from an 11-month hiatus in the Mar. 5 G2 Jebel Hatta over course and distance. He finished second by 3/4 of a length to **Alkaadhem (GB)** (Green Desert) that day. **Elvstroem (Aus)** (Danehill), the Australian multi-millionaire, will test the international waters for the first time. The handsome bay had been under consideration for a campaign which would include stops in Hong Kong and Europe, but those plans are on hold due to insurance premiums on his estimated A\$15-million valuation.

Prince Looking for Coronation...

American challenger **Prince Arch** (Arch), on the board in 11 of 14 lifetime starts, got up in the final strides to take the 1 3/8-mile G1 Gulfstream Park Breeders' Cup H. in his last outing Mar. 6 for trainer Ken McPeek. "I think he's got a great chance," McPeek said of the improving four-year-old. "He's a horse who will be internationally recognized in the next couple of years. I've always thought the further he goes, the better he'll be." **Phoenix Reach** has won four of seven starts at today's 1 1/2-mile distance, including a victory in the 2003 G1 Canadian International. Post-Dubai plans call for a return trip to Hong Kong for the Apr. 24 Queen Elizabeth II, with long-term goals including the G1 Cox Plate.

The World Court...

Globe-trotting **Powerscourt** (GB) (Sadler's Wells) will become the first Aidan O'Brien-trained runner to compete in Dubai when he lines up in the G1 Dubai Sheema Classic. The five-year-old, winner of last year's G1 Tattersalls Gold Cup, has competed in six different countries and has hit the board in Group/Grade I company in four of them. Third after a troubled trip in the G1 Breeders' Cup Turf last fall, Powerscourt was a lackluster 10th in the G1 Japan Cup before a fourth-place effort in the Dec. 12 G1 Hong Kong Cup in his most recent trip to the post.

Saratoga County (Valid Expectations) bids for his fourth straight win here. The four-year-old started the streak with a Churchill allowance win in November and added a 2 1/2-length tally in the Jan. 8 GIII Mr. Prospector H. at Gulfstream. He comes off a nose score in the Feb. 21 GII General George H. at Laurel. "He's really come around in the last few months," trainer George Weaver. "He's as good as we can get him." Jockey Javier Castellano makes his Dubai debut.

Bull and Bear...

The local hopefuls are headed by **Estimraar** (Holy Bull), a seven-time winner at Nad Al Sheba. The eight-year-old beat 2004 Shaheen third **Conroy** (Gone West) in a Listed race in January, then had to settle for second behind that rival in a handicap Feb. 17. The two met again last time out, with Estimraar winning the Mar. 5 G3 Mahab Al Shimaal as Conroy tired to be 10th. The lone distaffer in the field is six-year-old **Bear Fan** (Pine Bluff), who cruised to a nine-length score in the GII Vagrancy H. last June, but has been beaten in her last three starts. The bay was second in the Jan. 29 Sunshine Millions F/M Sprint before fading to eighth as the even-money chalk in the Feb. 19 GII Barbara Fritchie H. at Laurel.

"He has a pedigree which suggests he will handle the surface and the stamina to go a mile and a quarter without any problem," Crisford added. "He is a horse who has the quality and class to compete in the Kentucky Derby if we choose that route. But he could be vulnerable on Saturday to a super fit dirt horse."

MONMOUTH LIKELY TO LOSE BREEDERS' CUP Breeders' Cup Ltd. is considering a change of venue for the 2007 Breeders' Cup. The event was awarded to New Jersey's Monmouth Park, but the

agreement was contingent on the swift resolution of an ongoing dispute between the New Jersey Racing Commission and the state's horsemen. The Commission has accused members of the New Jersey Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association with misuse of funds. The allegations included a charge that the Association's legal counsel, Dennis Drazin, overbilled for his services, but Drazin has since been cleared of that charge. But negotiations between the two sides have failed to resolve others issues, and the case will go to trial in October. However, Breeders' Cup President D.G. Van Clief told the *Asbury Park Press* Thursday that, if the dispute is not settled by Apr. 9, a new site for the 2007 Cup will be found. He added, "As I understand it, there's very little if any chance that there's a resolution in sight. Barring a resolution, we will officially commence a search for an alternate site [on Apr. 9]." Drazin has met with Breeders' Cup officials in an effort to convince them that the in-fighting in New Jersey racing should not affect Monmouth's eligibility as host of the sport's championship day. "Anyone who tells you that the New Jersey horsemen's group has anything to do with trying to prevent the Breeders' Cup from coming to New Jersey is telling you a lie," Drazin told *APP*. But Alan Foreman, the chairman and CEO of the Thoroughbred Horsemen's Association, has been adamant in his opposition to Monmouth getting the Breeders' Cup if the dispute is not resolved, and the New Jersey horsemen's group is a member of the THA. Only the New Jersey Sports and Exposition Authority, which runs Monmouth and the Meadowlands, seems to hold out hope that the matter will be settled in time to save the Breeders' Cup for the Garden State. "I've engaged in a dialogue with both the Racing Commission and the Thoroughbred horsemen, and I'm extremely optimistic that they will be able to craft a response that will not only satisfy the Breeders' Cup board, but ensure that Monmouth Park will be the host site in 2007." He continued, "I think we're going to get written assurances from the two parties," but added, "The question is, are they going to be satisfactory to the Breeders' Cup board?"

Calder Stable Area Closed:

Calder Race Course's stable area will be off limits to new arrivals for one week beginning today and continuing through Apr. 2 in an effort to prevent the spread of strangles. No horses at Calder have tested positive for strangles, but the infection's presence at Palm Meadows Training Center prompted the restrictions. "We have every reason to believe the measures taken at Palm Meadows to control the spread of the infection will be successful," said Calder Racing Secretary Bobby Umphrey. "In concert with those efforts, we believe it is both prudent and responsible to restrict access to Calder's barn area until we have received assurances from attending veterinarians that the illness has been contained. Within a week, we hope to have a better sense of the effectiveness of the quarantine measures in place at the training center." Horses currently stabled at Calder who are entered to run at Gulfstream will be allowed to come and go from Calder's stable area.

CHRB Claims Victory Over Milkshakes:

Dr. Rick Arthur, chairman of the committee overseeing testing for excess alkalizing agents at California's Thoroughbred racetracks reported to the California Horse Racing Board Thursday, saying the state has gained control of the milkshaking problem. In his presentation to the board, Arthur said only eight horses have exceeded the permitted threshold for TCO2 at Santa Anita, Golden Gate and Bay Meadows since Dec. 26. During that period, 6,099 blood samples were tested, meaning about 1/10 of 1 percent of the horses tested high. "There is no question we are winning the battle," Arthur commented. "During the first four days of the Del Mar meet last summer, 24 percent of the horses tested high." Arthur did report two recent positive tests at Bay Meadows, but added, "These two recent cases at Bay Meadows tell us that some trainers still haven't gotten the message, but we have their attention now. In Southern California, it has been five weeks since the last positive and the near misses have been dropping significantly. We are confident we have things under control. Regardless, we are going to keep testing every horse in the state until there is no problem whatsoever and the number of high tests is zero." Also during its meeting Thursday, the CHRB began the process to make the Kenneth L. Maddy Equine Analytical Laboratory at UC Davis the exclusive testing lab for California horse racing. The Maddy Laboratory currently handles one third of the equine samples in California and is one of only two labs in North America accredited by the International Organization for Standardization.
