**WARD HAS HIGH HOPES FOR FILLIES**

Trainer John Ward, who four years ago won the Kentucky Derby with Monarchos, has a trio of fillies that has him optimistic about the female counterpart to that race, the GI Kentucky Oaks May 6. Ward sent out all three--who now run in the same John Oxley colors that Monarchos did--to work Monday morning at Gulfstream. **Little Money Down** (West Acre) breezed five furlongs in 1:01 4/5, while **Miss Matched** (Formal Gold) and **Eccellenza (Chi)** (Edgy Diplomat) worked that distance in tandem. Both fillies stopped the clock in 1:00 1/5. Representing perhaps Ward's best chance for an Oaks win is Little Money Down, who was acquired privately following an

open-lengths maiden victory at Aqueduct in December. After an impressive allowance score at Gulfstream Feb. 13, she ran second, beaten a half length by Letgomyecho, in the Mar. 5 GII Forward Gal S. But Ward is also high on Eccellenza, a South American import who already has six stakes wins to her credit, two of them in Group 1 company. Eccellenza is unraced in the States. "I'd love to race Eccellenza [at Gulfstream]," said Ward, "but she won so much in South America, we'd need a non-winners of eight allowance, and they don't right many of those." Ward added, "Little Money Down and Eccellenze are being pointed for stakes at Keeneland." The third of Ward's fillies, Miss Matched, completed the exacta behind Sense of Style in the GII Spinaway S. in August, but has been off since running sixth in the GII Alcibiades S. at Keeneland Oct. 8.

**DRESSED UP WITH SOMEWHERE TO GO**

**Valentino (Fr)** (Valanour {Ire}), making his seasonal debut in yesterday's G3 Prix Edmond Blanc, got back to winning ways after an unsuccessful trip to Hong Kong. The six-year-old spent much of the last two seasons perched on the periphery of group class, but finally got it together in October when taking the G3 Prix Andre Baboin and G3 Prix Perth over course and distance. He never landed a blow when 10th in the G1 Hong Kong Mile in December and faced a stiff task under a penalty on his return here. Settled in fifth early, he produced a turn of acceleration down the outside to challenge Special Kaldoun approaching the eighth pole. Gaining the edge soon after, he was pushed out to hold that rival and provide his dam with her second piece of black type after the exploits of the Listed Prix la Camargo third Ysoldina (Fr) earlier in the afternoon. "He did not show his true form for various reasons in Hong Kong," explained his trainer Alain de Royer-Dupre. "However, that trip helped him to mature and I was quite confident before today as he had worked very well. He will return for the G2 Prix du Muguet [May 1]."

**Doncaster H.**

Consummate horseman Guy Walter was stunned when Patezza led home stablemates Court's In Session and Danni Martine to record a trifecta here. It was the first time in 139 years that a trainer has swept the top three spots in the famous Randwick mile. "I'm a bit numb at the moment," Walter said. "I couldn't imagine doing this. To win a race like the Doncaster H. is wonderful, to have the first three is something else. They are three wonderful horses, but I have to admit Patezza was the one I liked the least. I have great respect for him, but I doubted him at the mile." Walter reluctantly entered Patezza upon the insistence of owner Patrick Shanahan. The gelding, who broke a cannon bone two years ago, won the Newcastle Newmarket H. on Mar. 2 over 1400 meters and was a long neck runner-up to Court's In Session in the G1 George Ryder S. Racing fiercely in the lead, Court's In Session looked to have the race in his keeping until Patezza, sent out at 20-1, came from the rear and passed the leader in the final strides.

**LION HEART TO SHUTTLE TO AUSTRALIA**

Coolmore Australia confirmed Monday that dual Grade I winner **Lion Heart** (Tale of the Cat) will join High Chapparral on the shuttle to its Jerry's Plains base. Lion Heart won the 2003 GI Hollywood Futurity and 2004 GI Haskell Invitational, and was runner-up to Smarty Jones in the GI Kentucky Derby. Coolmore has also confirmed that **Fastnet Rock (Aus)** (Danehill), who is to campaign in England in May and June, will go to stud this spring. Coolmore will release its fees for 2005 following the Inglis Easter sale.

What more can you hope for than that a new stallion sires a Breeders' Cup winner in his first crop? Honour and Glory did exactly that in 2000, when his daughter Caressing won the Juvenile Fillies on her way to collecting an Eclipse Award.

One immediate consequence of Caressing's triumph was that Honour and Glory's fee jumped from \$17,500 in 2000 to \$40,000 for 2001 and breeders rushed to use him, sending him more than 200 mares. It therefore seemed fair to think that the 2002 crop by this GI Met Mile winner would be the one to establish his true worth.

Unfortunately, by the time this 2002 crop reached the yearling sales, Honour and Glory's second and third crops had failed to replicate the success of that first crop, which also contained Name Value (G1 Teio Sho in Japan), Put It Back (GII Riva Ridge S.), Discreet Hero (GIII Round Table S.) and a handful of other stakes winners.

In the circumstances it came as no surprise that the median price for these 2003 yearlings was only a little higher than their sire's 2001 fee, with only five of the 75 offered achieving six-figure sums. In fact, only two of Honour and Glory's yearlings made more than \$180,000, with one colt selling for \$245,000 and another for \$400,000.

That \$400,000 colt had the distinction of being a half brother to Limehouse, one of the stars of the early juvenile races in 2003, with victories to his name in the Three Chimneys Juvenile S. and the GIII Bashford Manor S. Unfortunately for his buyers, the Honour and Glory colt--Blues and Royals--didn't achieve nearly as much as Limehouse as a juvenile. Indeed, his starting

price of 33-1 in last Saturday's UAE Derby reflected the fact that he had won only one of his three starts in England last year and had finished last of four on his latest appearance. No doubt some expected Blues and Royals' role to be pacemaker to his stablemate Shamardal, an unbeaten champion who was on trial for the Kentucky Derby.

Neither of these Godolphin colts had previously raced on sand and the change in surface--plus the application of blinkers to Blues and Royals--produced a totally unpredictable result. Whereas the free-running Shamardal eventually trailed home ninth of 11, some 14 lengths behind the eighth-placed Durban Thunder, Blues and Royals romped home 12 lengths clear in this very valuable Group-2 event, booking himself a ticket to Churchill Downs in the process.

So, if all goes to plan, Blues and Royals' dam, Dixieland Blues, will have the distinction of being represented in consecutive editions of the Kentucky Derby. Limehouse performed very creditably in last year's race, moving into third place entering the stretch, only to run out of stamina when it mattered. He held onto fourth place, eight lengths behind Smarty Jones.

The question now is whether Blues and Royals will last the final furlong any better than his distinguished half brother. He showed no signs of stopping at the end of the UAE Derby and his pedigree is probably no more lacking in stamina than those of many other modern-day Kentucky Derby candidates.

Dixieland Blues' racing record doesn't supply much information, as she ran only once, when second in a sprint. However, she is bred to a very well known pattern, being one of nearly 70 animals sired by Dixieland Band from Mr. Prospector mares.

That this cross has been tried so many times is a reflection of its success. Dixieland Band has so far sired five group/graded winners from daughters of Mr. Prospector (as well as Dixie Union, whose second dam is by Mr. Prospector). Speed has been the main asset of some of these winners, such as the high-class sprinter Chimes Band, the fast French colt Didyme and the Grade III six-furlong winner Love That Jazz. However, Southern Rhythm won the GII Lexington S. over 1 1/16 miles and Jazz Club took the GIII Ben Ali S. over 1 1/8 miles. The doubt still remains about a mile and a quarter.

This doubt is all the more real when the Mr. Prospector mare in question is Blue Jean Baby. This quick-maturing filly won the Colleen S. over five and a half furlongs and the GII Sorority S. over six furlongs in the summer of 1987. Lightly raced subsequently, Blue Jean Baby gained her only other stakes success over six furlongs.

Her only stakes winner, the Ogygian filly Denim Yenem, was a very effective sprinter and Blue Jean Baby has also achieved the unusual feat of producing a sprinter to Silver Hawk. This isn't too surprising, as she was sired by a high-class sprinter from Jones Time Machine, a prolific stakes winner whose only graded success came in the Distaff H. over seven furlongs. So, if Blues and Royals is going to be ideally suited by a mile and a quarter, he will need to have inherited some stamina from the top half of his pedigree.



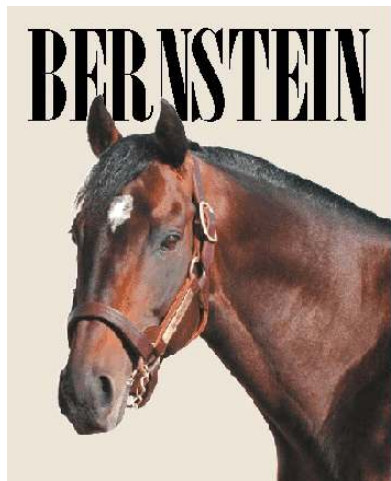

There are similarities between his sire Honour and Glory and Limehouse's sire Grand Slam, in that both possessed first-rate speed, coupled with a measure of stamina. Honour and Glory will always be best remembered as a winner of the GII King's Bishop S. and the GI Metropolitan H., but he stayed well enough to win the GII Breeders' Futurity over 1 1/16 miles as a two-year-old and to finish second in the GI Santa Anita Derby at three. It is worth remembering that his sire, the versatile Relaunch, went close to winning the GI San Luis Rey S. over a mile and a half and that his grandsires are In Reality (Florida Derby) and Al Nasr (Prix d'Ispahan).

It's in Blues and Royals' favour that Honour and Glory already has a Group 1 winner over a mile and a quarter to his credit, namely the Japanese mare Name Value, winner of the Teio Sho (G1-NAR) on dirt in 2003. So he is in with a chance of lasting the distance, but we also need confirmation that this colt is as good as his Dubai performance suggests.
