**TEN TO CROSS CAT'S PATH**

Marty and Pam Wygod's **Sweet Catomine** (Storm Cat) has been installed the 7-5 morning-line favorite for Saturday's GI Santa Anita Derby in Arcadia. Perfect in five starts since finishing second in her career debut last summer, the imposing bay will seek to become just the fourth filly in 68 years to win the race and could earn herself a spot in the field for the Kentucky Derby. "If she wins and comes out of the race right, we would seriously consider going on to Kentucky," Marty Wygod

said during yesterday's post position draw. "If there was something that interfered with her [in the Santa Anita Derby], but still ran a big race, we would still consider it." Sweet Catomine turned in her latest dominating performance Mar. 13, defeating her peers by three easy lengths in the GI Santa Anita

Oaks. Derby berths are also on the line for several of the chief protagonists, including **Don't Get Mad** (Stephen Got Even). An easy winner of his first two starts in the Midwest, the Apr. 25 foal was a hard-charging second in the GII San Vicente S. Feb. 13 and third in the GII San Rafael S. Mar. 19

**MISS LOREN RETIRED**

**Miss Loren** (Arg) (Numerous--Luminare {Arg}, by Forlitano {Arg}), the champion older mare in Argentina in 2004, has been retired from racing and will be bred to A.P. Indy. A dual Group 1 winner in her native country and placed in no fewer than 22 black-type events,

the seven-year-old mare made the first nine starts in the U.S. for Llers Corporation, winning the GII Clement L. Hirsch Memorial H. at Del Mar last August in her third American outing. The dark bay kicked off this season on a high note, winning the Jan. 14 Paseana H. prior to a nose victory in

the GI Santa Maria H. Feb. 13. Sold privately to the Mercedes Stables of Ernie and Maria Moody following that effort, she made one start in her new colors, finishing third by 3/4 of a length in the GI Santa Margarita Invitational H. at Santa Anita Mar. 12. A full sister to graded-stakes winner and track-record setter Mr. Light (Arg) and a half sister to Argentinian Group 2 winner Milano Phone (Arg) (Speakerphone), Miss Loren retires with 13 victories from 46 career starts and earnings of \$652,260.

**OUTSIDE LOOKING IN?**

While horses like GI Santa Anita Oaks heroine **Sweet Catomine** (Storm Cat), GI Florida Derby champ **High Fly** (Atticus) and G2 UAE Derby victor **Blues and Royals** (Honour and Glory) have earned their way into the field for the May 7 GI Kentucky Derby, several horses have much to play for this weekend. **Galloping Grocer** (A. P. Jet), currently 21st on the list with \$70,000 in graded-stakes earnings, will look to improve from that position when he goes postward in a competitive renewal of the \$750,000 GI Wood Memorial at Aqueduct. Saturday's GI Santa Anita Derby, also worth three-quarters of a million dollars, will be the stage for B. Wayne Hughes' **Don't Get Mad** (Stephen Got Even). He is currently 23rd with \$60,000. **Vicarage Disembarks Derby Trail in Favor of Trial...**

Dogwood Stable's **Vicarage** (Vicar), a distant sixth in last Saturday's GI Florida Derby, has been sent to Keeneland where he will prepare for his next start, most likely to come in the one-mile \$100,000 Derby Trial S. on opening day at Churchill Downs Apr. 30. "He came out of the race in good orses and he still looks good," said Dogwood President Cot Campbell. "Sometimes there is no rhyme or reason why a horse doesn't run the way you think he should. We still think he is a very good horse and we're looking forward to his future." Trained by Todd Pletcher, Vicarage was coming into the Florida Derby off a runner-up finish to **High Limit** (Maria's Mon) in the GI Louisiana Derby.

**Grocer Confirmed for Wood...**

Robert Rosenthal and Bernice Waldbaum's **Galloping Grocer** (A. P Jet) will remain in New York for this week-end's GI Wood Memorial S. instead of shipping to Chicago for the GI Illinois Derby. "He ran his best race on the outer track against Rockport Harbor going a mile and an eighth in the Remsen," explained trainer Dominick Schettino. "I talked it over with Mr. Rosenthal and we thought this was the best option. If we put him on a plane and he didn't ship well, then we'd be kicking ourselves for not staying here." In two starts this season, the New York-bred was fourth at odds-on in the Feb. 12 Whirlaway S. and was most recently third, placed second, in the GIII Gotham S.

**ALINGHI SOLD TO ARROWFIELD** Arrowfield Stud has purchased the crack Australian three-year-old filly **Alinghi (Aus)** (Encosta de Lago {Aus}) from Slade Bloodstock and will race her overseas later this year, *Australian Associated Press* reports. The deal, valued in the vicinity of A\$3 million, remains contingent on the results of blood tests, due Friday. "We are currently exploring all options for this great filly, but for the moment she will remain in the hands of trainer Lee Freedman, who has done a magnificent job with her," Arrowfield Chairman John Messara told *AAP*. "Lee Freedman and the Slade Bloodstock team had intended to campaign Alinghi overseas and we are looking at following the same route," he added. Purchased as a yearling for A\$80,000 at the 2003 Premier Yearling Sale in Melbourne, Alinghi has since gone on to win 10 races, including four Group 1 events, for earnings of nearly A\$3.5 million. Upon completion of her racing career, Messara indicated that Alinghi will be mated to Arrowfield's outstanding young stallion Redoute's Choice (Aus).

### VALID EXPECTATIONS FILLY TOPS F-T TEXAS

A filly by Valid Expectations led the way at the Fasig-Tipton Texas Two-Year-Olds in Training Sale, held Tuesday at Lone Star Park near Dallas, Texas. Danny Shifflett, manager of Lane's End Texas, signed the ticket for \$110,000. Selling as [hip 130](#) from the consignment of Leprechaun Racing, she was produced by the Dunham's Gift mare It Fits and is a half sister to the stakes-placed Hellohelloworld. "When I watched her work, she was doing it in hand, and she wasn't even asked until the last 30 yards," Shifflett said, "and she still had the fastest work for a filly at the sale." The bay posted her furlong breeze in :10 2/5. "She was so alert and responsive to the rider," Shifflett added. "I thought she was a beautiful specimen; she's very attractive and just a stunning filly." The juvenile sold as a yearling for \$35,000 at the Fasig-Tipton August Sale.

### Gate Malfunction Results in Non-Starter:

Lord Ravenal was declared a non-starter in Monday's first race at Gulfstream Park after an electrical circuit failure caused the gates to open prematurely and before Lord Ravenal was loaded. All wagers on the horse were refunded. Explaining the mechanics of gate operation, Dennis Testa, Gulfstream Park's assistant general manager and director of operations said, "The starter presses a button to shut off the electrical current, which releases the electromagnetic charge that holds the doors together. In [Monday's] race, the starter never pressed the button, but an electrical failure within the cord caused the current to be interrupted and the stall doors to open prematurely. We've replaced the cord and the gate is back in top working order."

**Knowlton, O'Connor Nominated to FNYR Board:**

Jack Knowlton and John M.B. O'Connor, two prominent New York horse owners, have been nominated to the Board of Directors of Friends of New York Racing, pending formal approval at the Board's meeting set for tomorrow. Knowlton, of Saratoga Springs, is best known as the managing partner of Sackatoga Stable, which campaigned 2003 Kentucky Derby winner Funny Cide. O'Connor, who races horses in this country and Europe, is the CEO of J.H. Whitney Investment Management LLC and also serves as a director of the Grayson-Jockey Club Research Foundation, the leading equine health research charity. "The addition of Jack Knowlton and John O'Connor to the Friends of New York Racing board will strengthen our organization in numerous ways," said FNYR President Tim Smith. "Their willingness to serve typifies the commitment of New Yorkers to preserving and improving horse racing in the state."

The price tag set a new sale record for the highest-priced filly. Notturna is the dam of eight winners and hails from the German family of G1 Oaks d'Italia winner Nagoya (Ger), so the chestnut juvenile has statistics on her side.
