ROAD TO THE DERBY?

Trainer Nick Zito will look to add another contender to his extensive list of Kentucky Derby hopefuls when the lightly raced **Bellamy Road** (Concerto) lines up in

Saturday's GI Wood Memorial S. at Aqueduct. Trained last season by Michael Dickinson, the Kinsman Stable colt won the GIII Cradle S. at River Downs in his second outing before tiring to seventh in the Oct. 9 GI Lane's End Breeders' Futurity. In his first start for Zito, Bellamy Road

annihilated a one-mile Gulfstream allowance field Mar. 12. "There's no question he's been very impressive," Zito said of the colt who could be his fourth Derby entrant. "His status hasn't gone down in our opinion at all." A strong performance in the Wood will propel Bellamy Road to Louisville, but Zito is prepared to wait for the talented colt. "If you don't wait on them, they'll make you wait a lot longer," he said.

Bellamy Road will break from post three in Saturday's eight-horse field. D. Wayne Lukas is another trainer hoping the Wood provides him with another Derby contender. **Going Wild** (Golden Missile) began his sophomore campaign with wins in the Jan. 17 San Miguel S. and the Feb. 5 Sham S. before running a gritty second to juvenile champion Declan's Moon in the Mar. 5 GII Santa Catalina S. Owned by Bob and Beverly Lewis, Going Wild will break from post five.

ASHADO RETURNS SATURDAY

The GI Apple Blossom H. has been owned in recent years by champion Azeri, but with that great mare's retirement, the next generation will get a chance to shine in Saturday's renewal at Oaklawn Park. The 1 1/16-miles race will mark the four-year-old debut of last year's champion three-year-old filly **Ashado** (Saint Ballado). The Todd Pletcher trainee, made the even-money favorite in the field of eight, has been off since cementing championship honors with a win in the GI Breeders' Cup Distaff last October. The filly will be seeking her fifth Grade I victory Saturday. The Apple Blossom field also includes Grade I winners **Star Parade** (Arg) (Parade Marshal), **Island Fashion** (Petionville) and **Island Sand** (Tabasco Cat).

SEVEN LINE UP FOR ASHLAND

A deeply talented field of seven three-year-old fillies has been entered for Saturday's GI Ashland S. at Keeneland. **Summerly** (Summer Squall), who will break from post three, beat up the competition at Fair Grounds this winter, most recently scoring a 4 3/4-length victory in the Mar. 12 GII Fair Grounds Oaks. She'll be looking for her fourth straight win in the Ashland. **Sis City** (Slew City Slew) will break from post four Saturday. The speedy filly was fourth behind Sweet Catomine in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, but returned to take the GII Demoiselle S. in her final two-year-old outing. In her lone start at three, she was an eye-popping 16-length winner of the Feb. 5 GII Davona Dale S. at Gulfstream Park. Californian invader **Sharp Lisa** (Dixieland Band), the lone Grade I winner in the field, will break from post two. The filly was sixth in the Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies, but is unbeaten in two sophomore starts, winning the Jan. 17 GII Santa Ynez and the Feb. 12 GI Las Virgenes S.

Julio Canani remains positive about Juvenile Filly champion **Sweet Catomine** (Storm Cat)'s chances against the boys in Saturday's GI Santa Anita Derby. "She ate up everything last night, she looks good, she feels good, she's happy," Canani said of the champ. Asked if the filly's two post might be a problem, Canani said, "No. I don't want to think about concerns or nothing. She's coming to the race and that's it. If I got the 15 or the one, I don't want to think about it." Trainer Jeff Mullins, seeking a record-breaking third straight Santa Anita Derby, was stoic about **Buzzards Bay** (Marco Bay)'s post 10. "I'd like to have been inside a little bit more, really, but you take what you get."

NO STAKES AT SUFFOLK IN 2005 Suffolk Downs has announced that its open stakes schedule, which includes the \$500,000 Gil Massachusetts H., has been suspended for 2005. The decision was made to preserve purses for the 117-day meet which gets underway Apr. 30. "Based on the impact that the harsh winter had on simulcast wagering and our current projections, we feel it's more prudent to maintain a healthy purse level for our

daily schedule than to run these major races this season," said Suffolk Downs Chief Operating Officer Bob O'Malley. "Our attitude this year is to do everything we can to ensure that we will be able to race next year, when we would anticipate restoring the stakes program, including the MassCap. An important goal for this year is to pursue legislation that will allow us to enhance purses and improve our ability to compete with other racing jurisdictions." Also impacted by the decision is the \$200,000 James B. Moseley Breeders' Cup H. The Massachusetts-bred stakes program will not be affected by the track's decision.
