STRIKE UP THE BAND

Bottom of the ninth, tie game, bases loaded, full count. It's a do or die situation. Such was the predicament facing Michael Tabor and Derrick Smith's **Bandini** (Fusaichi Pegasus) in yesterday's GI Toyota Blue Grass S. at Keeneland. Coming into the centerpiece of the spring meeting, the handsome bay colt had just \$60,000 in graded stakes earnings, which demanded a second-place finish at a minimum to secure a spot in the Kentucky Derby. The \$500,000 Keeneland September yearling became the latest Louisville Slugger, rallying from just off the pace to register a decisive six-length victory over GII Louisiana Derby hero **High Limit** (Maria's Mon). **Blue Grass S. cont. p2**

What toll might the recent lung infection take, which resulted in a last-place finish in the GIII Rebel S. three weeks back? Consider all the naysayers silenced. TURN BACK THE CLOCK

Clock Stopper (Gilded Time) earned his first stakes victory in the seven-furlong Perryville S. at Keeneland in October of 2003. On the board in seven of his eight stakes tries since, the chestnut finally picked up black-type win number two in the GII Commonwealth Breeders' Cup S. at the Lexington oval yesterday. A Quick Study...

Bandini was a green sixth in his Nov. 20 debut over six furlongs at Aqueduct, but made amends for that effort in his three-year-old bow, defeating subsequent GI Florida Derby runner-up Noble Causeway in a seven-furlong maiden at Gulfstream Park Jan. 6. A grandson of Hail Atlantis, the dam of Stormy Atlantic, the son of the 2000 Kentucky Derby winner showed he could play the two-turn game equally effectively, leading from gate to wire in a nine-length allowance victory Feb. 5. Tested for class in his latest effort, Bandini found himself chasing High Fly throughout the Mar. 5 GI Fountain of Youth S. The Zito trainee got first run that afternoon and looked an easy winner, but the Todd Pletcher pupil closed well in the final furlong to miss by 3/4 of a length. Bandini was to make his next stop on the Triple Crown trail in the Florida Derby, but a minor foot bruise forced a change in plans.

Welcome to the Bluegrass...

Away alertly from the outside box, Bandini settled into a stalking trip, tracking pacesetter **Spanish Chestnut** (Horse Chestnut {SAf}) and **High Limit** from a three-wide position. Poised to pounce on the frontrunners rounding the far turn, the colt responded to a strong ride from John Velazquez, struck the front once heads were turned for home and quickened nicely clear with one right-handed slap of the whip. High Limit stayed on for second while GIII Holy Bull S. winner **Closing Argument** (Successful Appeal) closed mildly to round out the trifecta. "We broke well and were very comfortable after that," the winning rider commented. "He learns from every race and this experience will teach him even more. I was more aggressive with him today. I asked him to pick it up more from the half-mile pole and after that he went right on."

Sun King, Consolidator Disappoint...

Sun King (Charismatic), atop many a Derby Top 10, was forced to endure a wide trip and could do no better than fourth, beaten nine lengths. "We didn't break bad and I had to go a little wide, but he just didn't have it today," his jockey Edgar Prado said. **Consolidator** (Storm Cat), expected to fight out the early fractions, was surprisingly taken back off the pace and never factored, finishing four lengths behind Sun King in fifth.

Afleet Alex won four-in-a-row to begin his career, including the GII Sanford S. and the GI Hopeful S. Second to Proud Accolade in the GI Champagne S., he fell just short in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile, going down by a half-length to Wilko to close the year. After passing this track's Southwest S., the bay was a surprise entrant in the Mar. 5 Mountain Valley S. and turned the six-furlong event into a procession, winning by 2 3/4 lengths, good for a 106 Beyer. The wheels came off with a sixth-place finish in the GIII Rebel S. Mar. 19, but he was later diagnosed with a lung infection. The bay trained brilliantly since being treated for that ailment and was well-backed for this final step on the road to Kentucky. Always within easy striking distance, Afleet Alex rallied four wide on the far turn, took command leaving the three-eighths pole and finished full of run. "He ran the race I knew he could run," commented trainer Tim Ritchey. "He was extremely relaxed and moved when we wanted him to." Now it's on to Churchill. T.H. Approval had gone 0-for-eight over the Santa Anita turf in the past, but broke that losing streak in this marathon event. The gray ended his sophomore season with a win over optional claimers at Hollywood Nov. 24. Racing exclusively against graded-stakes foes this year, he was third in the Jan. 22 GII San Marcos H. and in the off-the-turf GII San Luis Obispo H. before finishing fourth behind Stanley Park (Swain {Ire}) in the Mar. 27 GII San Luis Rey H. last time out. Looking to turn the tables with 14 furlongs to work with, T.H. Approval sat second while under restraint for the opening mile and a half. He took command in the stretch and held favored Exterior at bay for his first stakes success. "He may not be a John Henry [kind of] horse, but he'll definitely go the distance," winning jockey Rene Douglas said. "That's why you need this kind of race for him--you need a long one. It was a perfect trip and when I asked him to run at the quarter pole, I knew...for them to beat me, they were going to have to go to the limit." T.H. Approval goes next in the May 14 GIII Jim Murray H. at Hollywood.

Acey Deucey made the first four starts of her career in state-bred company, winning her maiden in her second start Oct. 23 before returning to run third in a Dec. 30 allowance over the inner. She cleared that condition by 3/4 of a length Jan. 29, upset the field at 24-1 in the Feb. 21 Dearly Precious S. and was coming into this off a runner-up finish in the seven-furlong GIII Cicada S. Mar. 19, a race in which jockey Diane Nelson might have mistimed her move. The second choice trying the mile for the first time, the New York-bred filly broke awkwardly and was steadied repeatedly when blocked behind horses entering and racing around the far turn. Still crying out for room at midstretch, Acey Deucey was angled out five wide and closed gamely to catch fellow Empire-bred Seeking the Ante. "[Trainer] John [Morrison] told me to wait as long as I could, and that was the hard part," Nelson commented. "When I turned for home, I said, 'Something's got to open up.' I just had to wait and get out."

Soaring Free successfully defended his title in this event and earned his owners a gold tray, a reward for their eighth graded stakes victory at Keeneland. The reigning Horse of the Year and champion turf horse in Canada, the six-year-old gelding was up the Pimlico main track in the GIII Maryland Breeders' Cup H. in May, but rattled off five wins in succession thereafter, including the GIII Play the King H. Aug. 28 followed by a 3/4-length score in the GI Atto Mile Sept. 19. Sent off at 10-1 in the GI Breeders' Cup Mile, the dark bay set the pace for the opening six furlongs before yielding late to be fourth, beaten 2 1/4 lengths. Making his first start of the year, Soaring Free showed his customary early speed chased by Pomeroy (Boundary) and Battle Won (Honour and Glory), turned for home narrowly in front and staved off a furious late rally from Mighty Beau, who missed the break by several lengths and fell just short. Indesatchel chased home the subsequent G1 Middle Park S. winner Ad Valorem when third in the Listed Blenheim S. at The Curragh in September, before the mile of the G2 Beresford S. stretched him when fourth back at that track the following month. He looked a different proposition on his return to that Kildare venue when winning the Listed Loughbrown S. with ridiculous ease last time Apr. 3 and was duly backed with confidence to follow up in this Guineas trial. Reserved in mid division off the early tempo set by Galeota, he quickened through the rain-softened ground to head that rival with 150 yards remaining before asserting for the score. "I had to go sooner than I wanted and, with the ground being tacky, it blunted his speed," jockey Jamie Spencer explained. "He's even pacier than that and he's really improved over the winter and turned himself inside out. Last year he was a nearly horse and he's there now." Indesatchel will be aimed at the G3 Jersey S. at Royal Ascot at York June 15.

Penkenna Princess opened her account in a Kempton maiden in early September before finishing third as the highweight in a nursery on the first of three visits to Newmarket within the next month. She gave her rivals another chance when tiring in the closing stages, but dug deep to deny Royal Alchemist and Martin Dwyer in a desperate finish. "She is very, very tough and I thought two out I was going to win comfortably, but first time out on sticky ground just found her out a bit," her rider explained. The Board alleged violations of CHRB Rules 1887 (a) (Trainer to Insure Condition of Horse), 1489 (c) (Grounds for Refusal of License), and 1902 (Conduct Detrimental to Horse Racing). The CHRB declined to discuss details of the investigation, citing the request of Deputy Attorney General James Ahern, who now represents the CHRB in the matter, that all questions be referred to his office. Following Sweet Catomine's fifth-place effort in the Santa Anita Derby, owners Pam and Marty Wygod had a falling out with Canani, resulting in the transfer of the filly to John Shirreff's barn.

Primarily (Lord at War {Arg})--Mostly, by *Grey Dawn II), Canada's Broodmare of the Year in 2000, died Mar. 30 at Adena Springs in Versailles, Kentucky from injuries sustained in a paddock accident, according to published reports. The 17-year-old mare was the dam of Canadian champions Primaly (Aldeed), the country's top two-year-old filly of 1997 after running third in the GI Breeders' Cup Juvenile Fillies; and Poetically (Silver Deputy), who earned the Sovereign Award for juvenile fillies in 2000. Bred by Wimborne Farm, Primarily was a \$55,000 KEESEP yearling. She won two of four starts, capturing the My Dear S. for owner Kinghaven Farms. Her second foal was graded-stakes winner Whiskey Wisdom and her fourth was Primaly. The Kentucky-bred foaled Poetically in 1998, then was sent to the Keeneland November Sale that fall, where she was purchased for \$2.2 million by Frank Stronach while in foal to Storm Cat. She produced six foals for Stronach, including a two-year-old filly by Lemon Drop Kid and a yearling filly by El Prado (Ire). Her 2005 filly by Red Bullet was placed on a nurse mare.
